Pennsylvania's Day at the Races Preview

The Thoroughbred industry in the Keystone State will be celebrating the fruits of its labors on Saturday, Sept. 2 when the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association presents its annual Pennsylvania's Day at the Races at Parx Racing.

A card primarily devoted to Pennsylvania-breds will be on tap, highlighted by five \$100,000 state-bred stakes races:

- Banjo Picker Sprint Stakes, for 3-year-olds and up at 6 furlongs
- Roanoke Stakes, for 3-year-olds and up at 1 $\frac{1}{16}$ miles
- Marshall Jenney Stakes, for 3-year-olds and up, 5 furlongs on turf
- Dr. Teresa Garofalo Memorial Stakes, 3-year-olds and up, fillies and mares, 6 furlongs
- Mrs. Penny Stakes, 3-year-old fillies and mares, 1 $\frac{1}{16}$ miles on turf

Not only is the afternoon a chance for owners, breeders and trainers to watch their Pennsylvania-breds compete, but it's also an opportunity to meet old friends and make new ones, as well as enjoy a luncheon buffet in the grandstand.

"Pennsylvania's Day at the Races is a day we always look forward to," said Bob Hutt, who heads Uptowncharlybrown Stud LLC, formerly Fantasy Lane Stable. Uptowncharlybrown Stud is a limited partnership syndicate founded in 1999 that has grown to more than 50 horses, 25 different partnerships, and over 400 partners. "It gives us a chance to reflect on what we think is the best state-bred program in the country.

We at Uptowncharlybrown Stud have committed tremendous resources believing in this wonderful opportunity. We have been richly supported by the wonderful folks at the PHBA, who have been there for us every step of the way. We encourage all that are even thinking of getting into the breeding game to consider Pennsylvania first and foremost. If so, they'll be richly rewarded."

Hutt also stands the young sire Uptowncharlybrown at Diamond B Farm in Mohrsville, which is owned by Glenn and Becky Brok. The stallion, who already has \$100,000+ earner Midtowncharlybrown in his first small crop, stands for \$1,500 live foal. Hutt is offering one of the best stallion deals in the Mid-Atlantic region—breeders pay no stud fee until the foal wins a race.

Trainer John Servis is known for running his Pennsylvania-breds on Pennsylvania's Day at the Races, many of which have been sired by Smarty Jones, the dual classic winner that he trained for Roy and Patricia Chapman.

"It's the least we can do for owners and breeders who continue to support the Pennsylvania-bred industry," said Servis, in talking about Pennsylvania's Day at the Races. "It's a big day for Pennsylvania-breds, and an exciting day for the industry. All of my owners like to attend, even if they don't have horses running that afternoon."

Servis said he has a few of his PA-breds in mind to run in the PA-bred stakes, including the gelding The Man, who has been a perfect four-for-

four this year at Parx Racing and could be a candidate for the Banjo Picker Sprint.

"These PA-bred stakes seem to come up tougher and tougher every year," said Servis.

Trainer Robert E. "Butch" Reid, who is based at Parx Racing, has had great success with Pennsylvania-breds the past few years. He's especially fond of the progeny of the stallion Weigelia, who stands at Chip and Barbara Wheeler's WynOaks Farm in Delta, and may run a few on Pennsylvania's Day at the Races.

"It's a very good day—I really enjoy it," said Reid. "It's an opportunity to see other owners, trainers and breeders, and the PHBA always does a nice job putting it together. We've always got horses that we enter on the program, as my barn is more than half filled with Pennsylvania-breds."

Reid has three full sisters sired by Weigelia out of the Disco Rico mare Katarica Disco—Fat Kat, Disco Rose, and Pink Princess. Together, they have earned nearly \$1.2 million; Reid recently unveiled their 2-year-old full

brother, Smooth B, in a maiden special weight at Parx June 26.

"We've invested heavily in that family, because they can all run," said Reid. Katarica Disco has a yearling Weigelia filly at WynOaks, who no doubt should be following in her older sisters' hoofprints in the next few years.

Reid said that Disco Rose, who is graded stakes-placed, is very likely to run on Pennsylvania's Day at the Races.

Dr. Jerry Kolybabiuk owns Freedom Acres in Moorestown, N.J., with his wife, Maria. He foals his mares in Pennsylvania because of the lucrative state breeding and racing program—which pays more than \$30 million in Pennsylvania-bred awards, purses and bonuses—said that he tries to attend Pennsylvania's Day at the Races each year.

"I think it's fantastic," said Kolybabiuk, a retired general surgeon who built Freedom Acres from the ground up and has been turning out talented runners since the 1980s. "I look forward to the day, and it's a lot of

fun. Instead of 10 stakes, like some other state-bred days have, there's five stakes that usually have big fields, plus the maiden special weights and allowances on the card. It's a chance to show up with a horse you've bred, win some breeder awards, and have others take notice of your horse. It's always been a success."

Kolybabiuk is the owner and breeder of multiple stakes winner and graded stakes-placed Disco Chick, who has earned nearly \$700,000 over five seasons of racing. She is a daughter of Jump Start, Pennsylvania's leading stallion, who stands at Northview PA in Peach Bottom, out of Disco Flirt, by Disco Rico. Kolybabiuk is also the owner/breeder of Yeah Rocky, Disco Flirt's half-brother by Silver Train, who has earned nearly \$200,000.

"Yeah Rocky is blossoming," said Kolybabiuk. "He just missed being stakes placed at Presque Isle Downs [fourth in Karl Boyes Memorial Stakes June 19]. Hopefully we'll have some fun with him on Pennsylvania's Day at the Races."
