PENNSYLVANIA AND NEW YORK – A CLOSER LOOK AT BREEDING PROGRAMS

Resorts World Casino New York City opened in October 2011 after a decade of delays and is expected to bring billions of dollars to the New York racing industry. With the opening, New York state joins a growing list of Northeast and Mid-Atlantic states that have adopted or are considering new forms of gambling.

With the arrival of VLTs in New York and the anticipated increase in purses and breeder awards, Pennsylvania's Breeding Fund has been in the spotlight as horsemen are comparing the states' respective programs.

There is no dispute that New York's tracks have a leg-up on Pennsylvania when it comes to charm and tradition, but the Pennsylvania breeding program compares favorably to New York and in some aspects exceeds the potential payout for breeders and owners.

- A few key aspects of each program:
- The New York horsemen support approximately 600 state-bred restricted races with \$35 million in purses. In comparison, the Pennsylvania restricted race program is funded from the horsemen and the Breeding Fund and in 2011, the three state tracks funded more than \$10 million in restricted races, with more than 300 races.
- New York's Breeding Fund program anticipates \$17 million in revenue for 2012; Pennsylvania's Breeding Fund is expected to be \$19 million for 2012.
- Beginning January 1, 2012, registered New York-breds by New York-registered sires will receive awards equivalent to 30 percent of the purse earned for winners,

15 percent for second and third. A Pennsylvania-bred and sired horse receives 30 percent of the purse share earned for first, second or third.

- Registered New York-breds by out-ofstate or non-registered sires standing in the state will receive awards equivalent to 15 percent of the purse earned for winners, 7.5 percent for second and third. A Pennsylvania-bred, non-Pennsylvania sired horse will receive 20 percent of purse share earned for first, second or third.
- A New York-bred and sired horse is capped at \$40,000 per award, and a non-New York sired horse is capped at \$20,000. Pennsylvania-breds are capped at 1 percent of the total fund amount which puts a per-horse cap for each award closer to \$200,000. In the case of Plum Pretty, winner of the Cotillion Stakes-G2 at Parx in 2011, this proved to be an important difference. Plum Pretty's breeders received an \$86,100 Breeder Award, and the owners received a \$43,050 Owner Award. The nearly \$130,000 in total awards is considered the highest payout by any state program.
- In addition to a growing restricted race schedule, and generous breeder, stallion and owner awards, each Pennsylvania track pays an Owner Bonus for statebreds who finish first, second or third. The Owner Bonus (different from the Owner Award) is considered part of the horse's official earnings and is paid at the time of the purse and is therefore the basis

for the Breeder, Stallion and Owner Awards. Parx pays a 40 percent bonus, Penn National pays 20 percent and Presque Isle Downs pays 30 percent. A state-bred winner at Parx in a \$40,000 race, for example, will receive an additional \$9,600 to be added to the \$24,000 winner's share. The \$33,600 is the basis for any subsequent Awards.

Overall, Pennsylvania offers a balanced and competitive program with the potential for substantial financial awards and bonuses for horsemen. For additional information on the Pennsylvania Breeding Program, please contact the PHBA office at (610) 444-1050.

than nearly every other state-bred program now in operation. Established in 1974, the

- **\$** Award of 10% of purse earned to winning Owner on selected open races
- \$ Bonus of up to 40% of purse earned to Owner on selected races (first through third)
- \$ Bonus of 25% of purse earned to Owner for PA-sired horses in PA-Bred stakes races (first through third)

Pennsylvania Breeding Fund has grown from a disbursement of \$65,000 in its initial year of operation to over \$15 million annually.

The Pennsylvania Breeding Fund is financed by a percentage of pari-mutuel handle and slots revenues. It provides for individual award payments (breeder, owner and stallion awards), overnight races for PA-Breds, purse bonus supplements, and PA-Bred stakes races.
