ARCH'S GAL EDITH: PENNSYLVANIA'S CONNECTION TO THE 2012 TRIPLE CROWN

Champions boast pedigrees that can be traced all over the map, though they typically hail from the Bluegrass State. However, the 2012 Kentucky Derby-G1 and Preakness Stakes-G1 winner, I'll Have Another, can directly connect his roots to the fertile Thoroughbred breeding grounds of Pennsylvania through his dam, Arch's Gal Edith.

Bred by Lindsay Scott, the daughter of Arch and Force Five Gal (by Pleasant Tap) was foaled in Chester County, Pa., on Feb. 25, 2002. Arch's Gal Edith became one of the few direct crosses between Arch and Pleasant Tap.

"I like Arch a lot and I knew he would be a tough sire," says Scott. "I had the filly up until she left for the sales and she was always very good looking."

Arch's Gal Edith's early life began the same way as many others. She passed through her early training and eventually moved on to be prepped for an oncoming sale as a 2-year-old in training.

In 2004, the dark bay filly caught the eye of Harvey Clarke at the OBS April 2-Year-Olds in Training sale. Impressed by her appearance and training, Clarke purchased her for \$80,000. Shortly after the final sale, Arch's Gal Edith arrived in the barn of trainer Kiaran McLaughlin to pursue her racing career.

"She was a very nice filly. She had more speed than she did stamina," said McLaughlin on his first impressions of Arch's Gal Edith. "She was just well put together, real pretty."

A few minor injuries delayed the filly's training and the decision was made to skip running her as a 2-year-old.

On Sept. 30, 2005, more than a year after being purchased by Clarke, Arch's Gal Edith made her racing debut in a 6-furlong maiden special weight at Belmont Park.

Arch's Gal Edith set the pace and according to the chart she "dug in gamely on the rail" for a hard fought three-quarter-length victory.

"We were very excited when she won at first asking, we did not quite expect that," admitted Clarke. Her connections were no doubt pleased as well at the \$56.50 payout for the win.

Unfortunately Arch's Gal Edith's racing career would be short lived. Not long after her debut, she began to show signs of discomfort during training.

"We found out she had bone chips in her ankle," Clarke said. "It was a shame but we decided it was best to retire her to become a broodmare." Arch's Gal Edith now resides at Brookdale Farm in Versailles, Ky. Though she is several hours away from her Pennsylvania birthplace, she is passing her quality on to her foals. Of her four foals on the ground, three are racing and all are multiple winners.

Her first foal is a 2007 bay gelding by Thunder Gulch named Those Wer the Days. Also owned by Clarke and trained by McLaughlin, Those Wer the Days has won five races, with one second and one third in seven starts and earnings of \$162,860.

Rivaling his older brother's record is Arch's Gal Edith's 2008 foal When Willy Win, a chestnut gelding by West Virginia Derby-G3 winner Soto. When Willy Win's record currently stands at 15 starts with six wins, two seconds, four thirds and earnings just over the \$70.000 mark.

On April 1, 2009, Arch's Gal Edith foaled a chestnut colt by Flower Alley, a colt that would send shockwaves through the racing industry in just three short years.

"Flower Alley was a relatively new stallion at the time and he seemed to be able to carry his speed with distance," said Clarke, "The price was right and we tried it out."

Clarke made the decision early on to sell the chestnut colt, I'll Have Another, who impressed as just a normal type. "I didn't think much of him until I saw him as a 2-year-old," admitted Clarke. "I was content with where he went and I

still felt a very close connection to him while he went through his 3-year-old campaign."

I'll Have Another became Clarke's first homebred Kentucky Derby entrant. The excitement of having a horse he bred in the prestigious race was more than enough to please Clarke. "We always hope to breed the next Derby winner, but I never thought it would actually happen," he said.

While I'll Have Another suffered an injury on the eve of the Belmont Stakes-G1, after winning the Kentucky Derby and Preakness Stakes, his siblings look to bring some joy back to his connections

In 2010 Arch's Gal Edith produced Gloria S, a filly by popular sire, Tapit, that McLaughlin describes as "a really nice, good looking filly." The mare was not bred back in 2010 and sadly she lost her 2012 foal by Midnight Lute.

After a successful breeding earlier this year, Arch's Gal Edith is confirmed to be in foal for 2013 to three-time Eclipse Award winner and \$6-million earner Gio Ponti. As of now, there are no immediate plans for a second breeding between Arch's Gal Edith and Flower Alley.

One wonders what she might have achieved had her racing career lasted beyond one race, but her chestnut colt won America's greatest race and heart. As a broodmare our Pennsylvania-bred is a champion.

How the PA-Bred Fund Works

Pennsylvania's Breeding Fund Program distributes more money, on a per foal basis,

than nearly every other state-bred program now in operation. Established in 1974, the Pennsylvania Breeding Fund has grown from a disbursement of \$65,000 in its initial year of operation to over \$15 million annually.

The Pennsylvania Breeding Fund is financed by a percentage of pari-mutuel handle and slots revenues. It provides for individual award payments (breeder, owner and stallion awards), overnight races for PABreds, purse bonus supplements, and PABred stakes races.

OVERVIEW OF AWARDS AND BONUSES FOR REGISTERED PA-BREDS

- \$ Award of 30% of purse earned to Breeder for PA-sired horses (first through third)
- \$ Award of 20% of purse earned to Breeder for non PA-sired horses (first through third)
- \$ Award of 10% of purse earned to Stallion Owner (first through third)
- \$ Award of 10% of purse earned to winning Owner on selected open races
- \$ Bonus of up to 40% of purse earned to Owner on selected races (first through third)
- \$ Bonus of 25% of purse earned to Owner for PA-sired horses in PA-Bred stakes races (first through third)
