—PHBA'S FOCUS ON—

PENNSLVANIA'S NORTHVIEW STALLION STATION

Nestled in scenic Peach Bottom, Pa., Northview PA has quickly become one of the Mid-Atlantic's leading breeding operations. Standing seven stallions in 2012, including the current top three sires by progeny earnings in the region, Northview PA has dug its roots deep in Lancaster County soil in its four years of existence.

When Maryland's Northview Stallion Station, an industry leader in the Northeast, expanded into Pennsylvania in 2009 after the approval of slot machines in 2004 (through Act 71), it did not create a spin-off. North-

view PA rivals any major breeding establishment on the East Coast.

Fifth-generation Irish horseman Carl McEntee, the former general manager of Ghost Ridge Farm who put that Felton, Pa., farm on the map in a few short years, took the reins as Northview's director of bloodstock services in 2011 and is collecting an impressive band of stallions.

McEntee did not make the move from Ghost Ridge Farm alone. Joining him were three stallions with extremely impressive credentials—Jump Start, E Dubai and Smarty

Jones. They joined Northview PA's existing youthful contingent, Love of Money, Medallist and Fairbanks, for the 2012 breeding season. And hot young sire Silver Train came in to round out the roster.

"I am devoted to bringing new studs to this region and I particularly wanted to be a part of Northview's growth," said McEntee, whose experience includes three years spent at Darley in the United Kingdom, several more at Paragon Farm in Kentucky, and even a stint as an amateur flat jockey.

The racing season of 2012 has been punctuated by numerous stakes stars by Northview sires. E Dubai's 4-year-old son Fort Larned won Saratoga's famed Whitney Handicap-G1 in early August, placing himself among the best handicap horses in the nation. "It was a fantastic race and really just a feather in the cap for E Dubai," commented McEntee.

Smarty Jones, widely considered Pennsylvania's most beloved racehorse, sired his 16th career stakes winner (from four crops) in Francois, who won the Straight Line Stakes at Arlington on Aug. 18. One week earlier, Smarty Jones' son Old Time Hockey won Del Mar's La Jolla Handicap-G2. Smarty Jones and Jump Start are the Mid-Atlantic region's

leading sires of stakes winners thus far this year, with seven (through Aug. 30).

And McEntee is quick to point out that "Jump Start had four derby winners in one year alone and we may have two horses by our sires entered in the Breeders' Cup, that's a first for the Mid-Atlantic region!"

Northview PA also boasts up-and-coming sire Fairbanks, who had the largest book of any first-year sire in history in Pennsylvania when he entered stud in 2009 (103 mares bred). The son of Giant's Causeway won the Hawthorne Gold Cup-G2 and was second in the Suburban Handicap-G1, amidst several other stakes wins and places.

"He [Fairbanks] has a beautiful pedigree," explains McEntee. "He has been heavily supported through his first three years and we are seeing great results with his foals at the sales."

Like every large breeding facility, Northview PA is not immune to the everyday difficulties. A full breeding and foaling season meant staff and stallions alike were busy, but aside from the demands of a rigorous schedule, the farm experienced no major problems or set-backs.

"There's always a hitch here or there in the works, but in all everything is go-

ing very well," admits McEntee. "We may just fall victim to our own success in the future and see the need to expand. But that is really the type of positive challenge that we welcome."

Northview implements a small farm feel into their two locations.

"We get hands on and take phenomenal care of all the horses. The foals get a lot of hands on attention and are treated as individuals," says Louis Merryman, Northview's general manager. "We see a lot of repeat business, which instills a lot of confidence in our programs," he adds.

Northview PA's commitment to the Pennsylvania breeding industry is a key component to its success and its ability to rival Kentucky stud farms. "The breeders' program in Pennsylvania is so great, and there is truly a viable opportunity for a lot of growth," says McEntee.

During a time when racing is experiencing turmoil and adjusting to changes in how Americans gamble, Northview PA is a beacon of hope that exemplifies the potential of the Pennsylvania racing industry. "I want to see the industry succeed. Northview is very important to local trainers and breeders, and we want to share in their success," stated Merryman.

How the PA-Bred Fund Works

Pennsylvania's Breeding Fund Program distributes more money, on a per foal basis,

than nearly every other state-bred program now in operation. Established in 1974, the Pennsylvania Breeding Fund has grown from a disbursement of \$65,000 in its initial year of operation to over \$15 million annually.

The Pennsylvania Breeding Fund is financed by a percentage of pari-mutuel handle and slots revenues. It provides for individual award payments (breeder, owner and stallion awards), overnight races for PA-Breds, purse bonus supplements, and PA-Bred stakes races.

OVERVIEW OF AWARDS AND BONUSES FOR REGISTERED PA-BREDS

- \$ Award of 30% of purse earned to Breeder for PA-sired horses (first through third)
- \$ Award of 20% of purse earned to Breeder for non PA-sired horses (first through third)
- **\$** Award of 10% of purse earned to Stallion Owner (first through third)
- \$ Award of 10% of purse earned to winning Owner on selected open races
- \$ Bonus of up to 40% of purse earned to Owner on selected races (first through third)
- \$ Bonus of 25% of purse earned to Owner for PA-sired horses in PA-Bred stakes races (first through third)
