—PHBA'S FOCUS ON—

PHBA REGIONAL MEETING SATURDAY, OCTOBER 27 WILLOW LAKE FARM

The PHBA held its second regional meeting Oct 27. Dale and Ellen Schilling graciously hosted the event at their Willow Lake Farm.

Brian Sanfratello, PHBA president, led the discussion, which included an overview of the Breeding Fund's distributions to date, the restricted race schedules at the three tracks and a government affairs update.

Sanfratello noted that the Breeding Fund did not receive any money from the tax on pari-mutuel handle in 2012, resulting in a loss of budgeted revenue of \$1.5 million. The money did not come into the Fund due to

the decline in handle and the increased costs incurred by the Racing Commission. (By statute, the tax on handle

only accrues to the Breeding Fund after all Commission expenses.) Sanfratello reported that slot revenue to

the Breeding Fund is estimated at \$18.5 million for the calendar year.

Sanfratello noted that the Breeding Fund may see a decline in overall monies available in 2013. Slot revenue is leveling off and in some cases starting to decline—most notably at Presque Isle Downs where competition from Ohio is affecting the Erie facility.

Nonetheless, the Breeding Fund will have ample revenue to pay Breeder, Stallion and Owner Awards although the restricted races and Owner Bonuses

may be supported by the horseemen, either in full or in part, going forward. The PHBA president made a point to thank Mike Ballezzi of the PTHA and Todd Mostoller of the HBPA for their support of the Pennsylvania breeding program. Both horsemen's organizations have paid for a substantial restricted race program which will exceed \$10 million this year.

Sanfratello stressed that the Breeding Fund is healthy and remains one of the strongest programs in the country. The combined outlays from the Breeding Fund and the horsemen will approach \$30 million in 2012—when including Breeder Awards, restricted races, stakes and Owner Bonuses.

The PHBA president reminded the members that the governor's budget address for the 2013-14 fiscal year is approaching.

The PHBA will continue to work with the Thoroughbred and Standardbred horsemen and breeders through the Pennsylvania Equine Coalition. Members of the PHBA were asked to participate in the January 2013 stallion auction and to engage their local representatives to promote the racing industry.

The Schillings provided a lovely lunch for the members at the conclusion of the meeting and all in attendance enjoyed the fall day in Montgomery County.

How the PA-Bred Fund Works

Pennsylvania's Breeding Fund Program distributes more money, on a per foal basis, than nearly every other state-bred program now in operation. Established in 1974, the

Pennsylvania Breeding Fund has grown from a disbursement of \$65,000 in its initial year of operation to over \$15 million annually.

The Pennsylvania Breeding Fund is financed by a percentage of pari-mutuel handle and slots revenues. It provides for individual award payments (breeder, owner and stallion awards), overnight races for PA-Breds, purse bonus supplements, and PA-Bred stakes races.

OVERVIEW OF AWARDS AND BONUSES FOR REGISTERED PA-BREDS

- \$ Award of 30% of purse earned to Breeder for PA-sired horses (first through third)
- \$ Award of 20% of purse earned to Breeder for non PA-sired horses (first through third)
- \$ Award of 10% of purse earned to Stallion Owner (first through third)
- \$ Award of 10% of purse earned to winning Owner on selected open races
- \$ Bonus of up to 40% of purse earned to Owner on selected races (first through third)
- \$ Bonus of 25% of purse earned to Owner for PA-sired horses in PA-Bred stakes races (first through third)
