—PHBA'S FOCUS ON—

PRINCESS OF SYLMAR STILL QUEEN OF PENNSYLVANIA

Ed Stanco, majority partner of Pennsylvania breeder and owner King of Prussia Stable, is CEO of Toa Re America, a Morristown, N.J.-based reinsurance company which is the overseas subsidiary of Japan's Toa Tokyo. But when it comes to caring for the filly Princess of Sylmar, Stanco is happy to defer to her trainer.

Stanco, who has been with Todd Pletcher for 12 years, says "Todd is the CEO, and I am on the board of directors. He is the real genius, and he plans everything out for the filly." Plans which this past season included a trip to the West Coast for the 30th running of the Breeders' Cup at Santa Anita. King of Prussia Stable is a small group of seven partners formed in 2006 which owns and breeds just two mares, racing their offspring.

"We like to race just one or two horses at a time," said Stanco. "We are just a couple of prudent guys who work with a manageable budget."

Stanco's first Breeders' Cup runner was Capeside Lady, who ran for the partnership So Madcapt Stable and was sixth in the 2005 Distaff. At the time, Stanco thought he'd never have another Breeders' Cup experience. In 2006, bloodstock agent Joe Brocklebank encouraged the purchase of Storm Dixie from the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic 2-year-old sale in Timonium. The daughter of Catienus retired stakes-placed with one win. In 2009, her planned breeding to Grand Slam at Ashford Stud in Versailles, Ky., was cancelled after the stallion was injured covering a mare. Instead, Storm Dixie was bred to first-year stallion Majestic Warrior, a son of A.P. Indy.

The following spring, Princess of Sylmar was foaled at Ronnie and Betsy Houghton's Sylmar Farm in Christiana. Living nearby in Malvern, Stanco made one of his regular trips to the farm the day the chestnut filly was foaled.

"Racing has its own adrenaline rush, but I really enjoy going out to the farm. It is great to have 20 yearlings surrounding you in a big field," he said. "The hardest part is trying to name the babies, but to me, one of the best parts of the filly's story is her name—she was named for the Houghtons' Sylmar Farm, where she was born, raised and broken to ride."

Princess of Sylmar lost her debut at Penn National, but was sensational breaking her maiden by 19 lengths in her second start at the Grantville track in November 2012. She then reeled off three more wins, including two stakes at Aqueduct, before finishing second in the Grade 2 Gazelle Stakes. Her next victory was in the Kentucky Oaks-G1 over the Eclipse Award winner Beholder. That began a historic skein of wins in the 3-year-old filly division which included the Grade 1 Coaching Club American Oaks and Alabama Stakes at Saratoga.

Stanco admits that he had suggested the Alabama Stakes in August for his Pennsylvania-bred filly. As a native of upstate New York, it was a race he always dreamed of winning. "My uncle used to take me to the races in Saratoga when I was a kid," he said. "I fell in love with the horses."

The Alabama was Princess of Sylmar's third consecutive Grade 1 victory, and rumblings about an Eclipse Award as top 3-year-old filly became louder.

"Ed threw a huge party at Saratoga, and we were all invited," said Betsy Houghton, there along with about 120 people, including the filly's farm blacksmith, Chris Marsh, and his family, and Kim Eshelman, who has been breaking youngsters at Sylmar for 36 years and was the first person to put tack on Princess of Sylmar. "Ed stood up at the party and introduced Kim, saying she was the filly's first grade teacher. He gave credit to everyone who had a part in this."

"She came out of the Alabama so well," said Stanco. "Her exercise rider, Jake Nelson, said she was back training like she had never even raced. We still were adamant, however, that we'd not go the Breeders' Cup. But then came the Beldame against older fillies and mares."

Her 2-length victory at Belmont in the Grade 1 Beldame over champion Royal Delta nearly guaranteed the 3-year-old filly championship. Rarely has a filly accomplished what she had in winning four consecutive Grade 1 races.

Prior to the Sept. 28 Beldame, the Breeders' Cup was not in the plans. But "champions don't stay home," said Stanco. "Todd is an incredibly focused guy who wants to do everything the right way. I usually communicate via text messaging with him, he is so busy that I never want to bother him, but this time, I wanted to have a meeting in his office. I shut the door and said 'This is a really big deal to me, is it to you, too?' I wanted him to be as excited as I was about the prospect of running in California."

The decision was made to supplement for \$100,000.

"The way we approached it," said Pletcher, who has saddled 103 Breeders' Cup starters, "is if she continued to train well after the Beldame, we felt she deserved the opportunity. Collectively, to have won four Grade 1 races as she did is extremely rare. I cannot think of anyone else that has done that. I always have some reservations about shipping any horse to California, but she had been training so well."

"It was pretty simple. It was not about her worth, but about something much bigger," said Stanco. "The fans wanted to see her, and there was no way we were going to sit home if she was healthy. We were quite an entourage at Santa Anita," he said. "With the partners very passionate about this filly, we had 50 people—friends from all over: Colorado, Texas, California, Kentucky and Pennsylvania. Win or lose, our filly has quite a following."

Unfortunately, Princess of Sylmar did not handle the speed-favoring Santa Anita surface. Added to that was an outside post and a stumble coming out of the gate, and the filly was defeated, finishing last of six. Stanco said Javier Castellano asked her to move on the backstretch, and got no response.

"Afterwards, I told Todd that I have absolutely no regrets," he said. "Running her was the right thing to do. If people are only in the business for the action, and only for the 'highs' of the sport, they need to rethink wanting to get involved in racehorse ownership. You have to love the Thoroughbreds for what they are, and if you don't have the passion for the animal, you shouldn't be in it."

The Houghtons watched from their farm, and were, as would be expected, disappointed.

"We saw how the races were running out there, and she had a couple of things against her," said Betsy. "The slow start from her stumbling, and the speed bias were very unfortunate, but we knew she had come into the race in great shape. She'll be back next year."

After the race, Princess of Sylmar shipped to Rood and Riddle in Kentucky for a complete physical. Coming out of the race in perfect condition, she was shipped to WinStar Farm for her previously planned vacation. She will return to the track and Pletcher's care in January.

"I have trained some of the top fillies in the country," said Pletcher. "She stacks up to the very top of that list. Her record places her right among them, and I am looking forward to her 4-year-old campaign."

Pletcher said that East Coast races like the Grade 1 Personal Ensign Stakes and Delaware Handicap could be on her 2014 agenda.

Princess of Sylmar has a just-turned 2-year-old half-sister by E Dubai. She is currently hacking under saddle at Sylmar under the watchful eyes of Eshelman and the Houghtons.

Storm Dixie produced a filly by Petionville in May 2013, and was not rebred due to the late foaling.

Queen to Be, a filly by Flatter out of Raise the Kitty unraced last year at 2 (through mid-December), is the second of the King of Prussia Stable runners, and will likely will follow the same path as Princess of Sylmar.

"She went to Todd's barn at Saratoga last August," said Houghton. "And as a 3-year-old, she'll make her first start at Penn National, just as Princess did."

How the PA-Bred Fund Works

Pennsylvania's Breeding Fund Program distributes more money, on a per foal basis,

than nearly every other state-bred program now in operation. Established in 1974, the Pennsylvania Breeding Fund has grown from a disbursement of \$65,000 in its initial year of operation to over \$15 million annually.

The Pennsylvania Breeding Fund is financed by a percentage of pari-mutuel handle and slots revenues. It provides for individual award payments (breeder, owner and stallion awards), overnight races for PA-Breds, purse bonus supplements, and PA-Bred stakes races.

- \$ Bonus of up to 40% of purse earned to Owner on selected races (first through third)
- \$ Bonus of 25% of purse earned to Owner for PA-sired horses in PA-Bred stakes races (first through third)
