The Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association has named its champions and leaders for 2013, based upon the recommendation of its Awards Committee of Jane White (chair), Susan Meckling, Connie Nesteruk, and John Benson.

### TWO-YEAR-OLD MALE – STORMING INTI

Ch.c., 2011, Stormy Atlantic—Tarfaya, by Pulpit. Bred by Brushwood Stable.

Winner of three of four starts in 2013. After finishing third in his career debut, Storming Inti won his next three races, including the \$100,000 Awad Stakes at Belmont Park and \$100,000 Pulpit Stakes at Gulfstream. He earned \$179,500.

### TWO-YEAR-OLD FILLY – MISS BEHAVIOUR

B.f., 2011, Jump Start—Successful Romance, by Successful Appeal. Bred by Cal MacWilliam, Teitelbaum & Associates.

Miss Behaviour won her first three starts in 2013, including the \$100,000 Sorority Stakes at Monmouth Park and \$200,000 Matron Stakes-G2 at Belmont Park, and was second in the Sharp Cat Stakes at Belmont. With a record of 5-3-1-0, she earned \$242,000.

### THREE-YEAR-OLD MALE – EDGE OF REALITY

Dk.b./br.c., 2010, Lawyer Ron—Our Nancy Lee, by Touch Gold. Bred by The Elkstone Group LLC.

In his first season of competition, Edge of Reality won four of 10 starts to earn \$367,695. His biggest achievements were a thrilling frontrunning victory in the \$350,000 Smarty Jones Stakes-G3 at Parx Racing and a third-place finish in the Curlin Stakes at Saratoga.

### THREE-YEAR-OLD FILLY AND PENNSYLVANIA'S HORSE OF THE YEAR – PRINCESS OF SYLMAR

Ch.f., 2010, Majestic Warrior—Storm Dixie, by Catenus. Bred by Ed Stanco.

Princess of Sylmar had one of the greatest years for a Pennsylvania-bred in history. A finalist for an Eclipse Award, she won six of her eight starts with one second. Princess of Sylmar was victorious in four Grade 1 races—the Kentucky Oaks, Coaching Club American Oaks, Alabama and Beldame, the latter over three-time Eclipse Award winner Royal Delta. She also won the Busher Stakes and finished second in the Grade 2 Gazelle. Bred and owned by Ed Stanco (King of Prussia Stable), Princess of Sylmar amassed \$1,539,000 for the year.

### CHAMPION OLDER MALE AND MALE TURF HORSE – REAL SOLUTION

B.h., 2009, Kitten's Joy—Reachfortheheavens, by Pulpit. Bred by Kenneth L. Ramsey and Sarah K. Ramsey.

Real Solution won the Arlington Million Stakes-G1 and finished third in Belmont Park's Manhattan Handicap-G1 and Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational Stakes-G1. Although only winning one race from five starts in 2013, he amassed \$675,500.

### CHAMPION OLDER FEMALE – MOON PHILLY

B.m., 2009, Malibu Moon—Astor Place, by Deputy Minister. Bred by Ellen Dale Racing.

Moon Philly won three of 10 starts, including the Nellie Morse and Maryland Racing Media Stakes, both at Laurel. She also captured the Justakiss Stakes at Delaware Park and earned \$163,259 while racing exclusively in stakes competition.

## **CHAMPION FEMALE TURF HORSE – EMOTIONAL KITTEN**

Ch.f., 2010, Kitten's Joy—Silent Emotion, by Ghazi. Bred by Kenneth L. Ramsey and Sarah K. Ramsey.

Emotional Kitten won three times, and placed in three others, from seven starts. Her first stakes win of the year came in Pimlico's Hilltop Stakes in May. She concluded her season with a victory in the Mrs. Revere Stakes-G2 at Churchill Downs in November. The filly also placed in the American Oak-G1 and Del Mar Oaks-G1. She earned \$317,693 during the year.

## **CHAMPION FEMALE SPRINTER – SO MANY WAYS**

B.f., 2010, Sightseeing—Happy Scene, by Dehere. Bred by John R. Penn and John C. Penn.

The champion 2-year-old filly and female sprinter of 2012, So Many Ways repeated as champion female sprinter by taking the Grade 3 Eight Belles Stakes at Churchill Downs and \$400,000 Charles Town Oaks. From seven starts, which included thirds in the Iowa Oaks-G3 and Primal Force Stakes and fourths in the Grade 1 Test and Prioress Stakes, she earned \$409,348.

## **CHAMPION MALE SPRINTER – ZEEWAT**

B.c., 2010, Harlan's Holiday—Delizia, by Distant View. Bred by Derry Meeting Farm.

Zeevat won three of seven starts in a season in which he earned \$201,450. He launched his campaign with a win in the California Derby at Golden Gate and turned in an exciting performance

for the victory in the Damascus Stakes early on the Breeders' Cup card at Santa Anita in November. He also ran an impressive third in the Malibu Stakes-G1 to finish out the year.

## **CHAMPION STEEPLECHASE HORSE – DIVINE FORTUNE**

Ch.g., 2003, Royal Anthem—My Tom-bola, by Northern Fling. Bred by William L. Pape and Jonathan E. Sheppard

The Eclipse Award winning Steeple-chaser of 2013, Divine Fortune repeats as Pennsylvania's champion steeple-chase horse, taking the title for the third year in a row. The chestnut gelding was a fixture in Grade 1 company, winning the Grand National Hurdle Stakes-G1 and placing in the Calvin Houghland Iroquois Hurdle Stakes-G1 and A.P. Smithwick Memorial-G1. He earned a career best \$207,000 for the year.

## **LEADING BREEDING FUND RECIPIENT (HORSE) – DANI'S STORM**

Ch.m., 2009, Changeintheweather—Stormy Danyelle, by Storm Broker. Bred by Xanthus Farms.

Dani's Storm led all Pennsylvania-breds in Breeding Fund money earned in 2013 with \$131,750. She scored five victories in 2013 and earned \$60,491 in Breeders Awards, \$20,164 in Stallion Awards and \$51,096 in Owner Bonuses.

## **CHAMPION STALLION – REAL QUIET**

Real Quiet led all Pennsylvania stallions in 2013 with \$88,865 in Stallion Awards. Among his top Pennsylvania-bred and sired runners was Parx stakes winner Norman Asbjornson.

## **CHAMPION BROODMARE – STORM DIXIE**

Dk.b./br.m., 2004, Catienu—Golden Wave Band, by Dixieland Band. Owned by Ed Stanco.

Storm Dixie has had four foals to date. Her first foal and only one to start is Pennsylvania-bred Horse of the Year Princess of Sylmar, with 11 career starts, eight wins (six stakes, four Grade 1) and earnings of over \$1.6 million.

## **LEADING BREEDING FUND AWARD RECIPIENT – XANTHUS FARMS (BARBARA RICKLINE)**

Barbara Rickline's Xanthus Farm in Gettysburg led all Breeding Fund Recipients in 2013 with \$179,138 in Breeders Awards.

## **LEADING OVERALL BREEDER OF PENNSYLVANIA-BREDS – GEORGE STRAWBRIDGE JR. (AUGUSTIN STABLE)**

For the seventh year in a row Augustin Stable is the state's leading breeder by earnings. Horses bred by Augustin Stable won over \$1,804,000 in 2013. Major earners include European-based Sir Ector (\$175,630) and stakes winner Kitten's Point (\$149,135), one of five 2013 stakes winners he bred in Pennsylvania, the others being Cat's Holiday, Fencing, Hello and Ski Holiday.

## **How the PA-Bred Fund Works**

Pennsylvania's Breeding Fund Program distributes more money, on a per foal basis, than nearly every other state-bred program now in operation. Established in 1974, the

Pennsylvania Breeding Fund has grown from a disbursement of \$65,000 in its initial year of operation to over \$15 million annually.

The Pennsylvania Breeding Fund is financed by a percentage of pari-mutuel handle and slots revenues. It provides for individual award payments (breeder, owner and stallion awards), overnight races for PA-Breds, purse bonus supplements, and PA-Bred stakes races.

### **OVERVIEW OF AWARDS AND BONUSES FOR REGISTERED PA-BREDS**

- 💰 Award of 30% of purse earned to Breeder for PA-sired horses (first through third)
- 💰 Award of 20% of purse earned to Breeder for non PA-sired horses (first through third)
- 💰 Award of 10% of purse earned to Stallion Owner (first through third)
- 💰 Award of 10% of purse earned to winning Owner on selected open races
- 💰 Bonus of up to 40% of purse earned to Owner on selected races (first through third)
- 💰 Bonus of 25% of purse earned to Owner for PA-sired horses in PA-Bred stakes races (first through third)
