Barlar LLC: Fate jump starts career

Larry Karp always liked horses and betting on the races, but that didn't mean he was planning on buying a horse out of a 2-year-old in training sale at Sportsman's Park on Mother's Day 1985. His unplanned purchase surprised him more than it surprised his wife, who knew immediately upon seeing his face that Karp had "accidentally" added to their expenses.

"I'd just gone down to observe with no intention of buying a horse," Karp recalled. "I was just standing around and made eye contact with a man standing nearby. He already owned horses and was waiting to buy some for his partners. He asked me if I wanted to meet his trainer. I said, 'Why not?'"

Owner Tom Teel introduced Karp to a "scruffy-looking" man moments later. The trainer was Joe Kasperski, and by the end of the sale, Karp had gone to \$6,500 to acquire a filly named Bertie Royal.

"To add insult to the whole thing, I got so carried up that I outbid myself twice," Karp said. "From that day on Kasperski and I stayed together, almost 28 years, but at the time I didn't even know what a trainer's day rate was."

Shortly thereafter, Kasperski convinced Karp that the filly needed to be turned out, and he learned the tough lesson that horses aren't always ready to race on their owner's timetable. After an exceptional day betting on races at Arlington Park, Karp told Kasperski to claim a race-ready horse for him and expected to own a new athlete within a day. It took Kasperski a month to find the right horse and Karp learned yet another lesson about the game.

As he learned, Karp added horses to his stable with gusto. "At one point I had 42 horses in training," he said. "That was more than I could really handle." He raced chiefly in Illinois, tried his hand in California, and eventually settled in Pennsylvania, where the excellent breeding program beckoned.

"Things were growing so quickly in Pennsylvania that Kasperski and I packed up our whole operation and moved there," Karp said. "At that point I was mostly into racing rather than breeding but fate has a big hand in life."

Karp was hunting for Pennsylvania-breds to race at a Timonium sale in 2009 when he came across Tarry Bratton and Carl McEntee, respectively the owner and general manager of Ghost Ridge Farm. They were about to announce that they had purchased the breeding rights to Jump Start, a royally-bred young stallion who stood at Overbrook Farm in Kentucky and would be moving to Pennsylvania for the following season.

"The next day I told Tarry I would take two shares," Karp said. "That was the beginning of my relationship with the breeding side of the business."

Jump Start, by A.P. Indy out of the multiple stakes-placed Storm Cat mare Steady Cat, started his career in flashy fashion, winning a maiden event at Churchill Downs in his debut. He followed that effort with a victory in the Saratoga Special-G2, and two starts later was second in the Grade 1 Champagne Stakes. Injury led to his retirement after the Breeders' Cup Juvenile-G1, but at his new home in Pennsylvania, Jump Start flourished.

From 10 crops to race, Jump Start has produced 47 stakes winners and 471 winners overall. More than two-thirds of his starters are winners and his total progeny earnings are approaching \$43 million, for average earnings of \$61,673 per starter. He is the sire of three millionaires, led by Prayer for Relief, an earner of \$1,985,000 who is currently in Dubai with trainer Mike De Kock.

"He's an incredible stallion," Karp said of Jump Start. "My daughter and I expanded from just two shares to six and a half, that's how much we believe in him as a stallion. I support him with my mares. What he's done with the mares he gets is remarkable." Jump Start was the top ranked stallion in the region last year. A year after investing in Jump Start, Karp approached Bratton and McEntee about buying another stallion, E Dubai. The Ghost Ridge team had already been considering purchasing E Dubai, but decided the timing wasn't right. That meant McEntee was free to represent Karp in the sale under Karp's stable banner, Barlar LLC. When Karp bought E Dubai, it was like bringing home a family member.

Karp raced E Dubai's dam, Words of War, through a tremendous career in the early to mid 1990s. The Lord At War (Arg) daughter won nine of 44 starts with 10 seconds and seven thirds for earnings of \$683,832. For Karp's \$28,000 investment in the 1990 Keeneland September Yearling Sale, Words of War brought \$440,000 while in foal to Nureyev following her racing career. The resulting Nureyev daughter, No Matter What, was a Grade 1 winner and eventual champion producer, and Words of War's second foal, E Dubai,

earned \$920,800. The next time Words of War went through the sales ring she sold for \$1,950,000.

With his earnings and five wins in 11 starts, E Dubai seemed a perfect fit for the Pennsylvania breeding program. After his move to the region, he was represented by 2012 Breeders' Cup Classic-G1 winner Fort Larned, but after being shuffled from Kentucky, to Pennsylvania, to Maryland and then Louisiana, E Dubai has found a permanent home in South America.

Karp is trying to consolidate his Thoroughbred investments and along with daughter Stephanie owns just five mares. "I will continue to stick with that number," Karp said, "but I'll breed in Pennsylvania for as long as I can."

Barlar LLC still has 11 horses on the racetrack, including the multiple stakes-winning Jump Start filly Bound. The homebred runs under the tutelage of trainer Bernie Houghton, who took over Karp's string when Kasperski retired three years ago. Bound has won seven of 19 starts for earnings of \$339,374, with victories in the Plum Pretty Stakes at Parx in both 2014 and 2015. "I had planned to sell her this [past] year in the November sale but I had a premonition that I should keep racing her," Karp said. "I'll race her in 2016 and if she should add a couple graded stakes placings or wins. I'll take her to Kentucky to find out what she's worth. Otherwise I could add her to my broodmare band and be perfectly happy."

The 73-year-old Karp had some advice for owners interested in getting in the game. "I've bought maybe a dozen horses that I paid six figures. Not a one of them has ended up worth anywhere close to what I paid. All of my success has been with horses I paid just a modest amount for or that I bred myself. So I just don't buy expensive horses anymore. Between the stallion awards and the breeder awards, you have the opportunity to make a profit in this state."
