John Servis: A Great Advocate for PA-breds

It was a magical day in mid-2014 for Pennsylvania Senator Kim Ward when a group of state representatives was welcomed onto the Parx Racing backstretch for a tour of the grounds. The highlight of the morning was when Ward had the opportunity to meet John Servis, trainer of the most famous Pennsylvania-Bred of the new millennium, Smarty Jones.

"Who doesn't know John Servis and Smarty Jones? I was really looking forward to this!" Ward exclaimed at the end of the tour before excitedly asking if she could take a picture with Servis.

It has now been twelve years since Smarty Jones' exciting run for the Triple Crown, one that set in motion the drive that would result in the passage of Act 71, which permitted the installation of slot machines in the state of Pennsylvania. The funding that would come from casino gaming enabled the state's horse racing industry to flourish, boosting interest in racehorses eligible for the rich Pennsylvania-Bred bonuses.

John Servis has always been an ardent supporter of Pennsylvania racing and his training barn is usually filled with talented PA-Bred runners. He also owns PA-Breds under his stable name Joshtylane Farm in partnership with many of his owners.

"Before the slots came, if I found a horse I liked at the sales and he was a PA-Bred, I would sometimes spend a little bit more for him," he notes. "Now it's no question: there's certainly plenty of money to be made if you have a PA-Bred with any ability at all."

Servis has also taken advantage of the rich PA-Bred stakes program, including notching victories in recent back-to-back runnings of the \$100,000 Pennsylvania Nursery Stakes at Parx Racing. He first won the race in 2003 when Smarty Jones captured the Nursery while drawing off to an easy fifteen-length score for owners Roy and Patricia Chapman of Someday Farm. In 2014, Smarty Jones'

son Nasa won the Nursery for the same connections, while Bird of Trey took the 2015 edition for new Pennsylvania breeders JRita Young Thoroughbreds. Both horses were subsequently crowned Champion Two-Year-Old Male at Parx Racing for their respective years.

"We have owned horses for about eight years," says owner Rita Young, wife of J.R. Young (hence the stable name of JRita Young Thorougbreds). "But in 2012 we bought a PA-Bred by Flower Alley named Back Alley Ambush. She was the first horse that John trained for us and we got so involved in the state-bred program that we sent (Bird of Trey's dam) Take Me Home Too to Shirley Lojeski's to foal in Pennsylvania."

Servis maintains a full barn at Parx Racing with "quite a few" owners sending him PA-Breds to train. He says that most of his owners who were not breeding in Pennsylvania before, such as the Youngs, have been converted to foaling mares in the Keystone State.

"The program is just that good here in Pennsylvania," Servis affirms, noting that part of his success is due to the opportunities for PA-Bred racehorses. "As a trainer, you always try to find the best place to run your horse. The Nursery Stakes, for example, is perfect for a young Pennsylvania-Bred, and it is ridiculous not to use it as a confidence builder for a young, potential stakes horse. It's the distance and the timing that makes it so appealing. I'm based at Parx, which doesn't run babies until later in the year, so it is kind of like a test for both quality and distance."

2016 has already been a rewarding one for Servis and his owners. Beginning March 30 with a smashing 4 ¾-length allowance victory by Someday Jones at Penn National, the Servis barn captured nine races in a row including an outstanding four-win day at Parx Racing on April 4. Five of those nine winners were bred in Pennsylvania: Someday Jones (by Smarty Jones), Miss Avalon (by Jump Start), Authoritative (by Pollard's Vision), Hearty Jones (by Smarty Jones) and Smarty Mr D (by Smarty Jones). Servis's Joshtylane Farm owns a piece of Smarty Mr D, who broke his maiden by 4 3/4 lengths to close out that brilliant April 4 race day at Parx Racing.

As the calendar moves into the heart of the racing season, the future looks even more promising. In addition to Nasa and Bird of Trey, current PA-Bred standouts include multiple stakes winner Res Judicata and fourtime winner Neshaminy. Pennsylvania-Bred maiden winners Authoritative, Anytime Soon (by Fairbanks), Humility (by Indygo Shiner), Key Cheyne (by Smarty Jones), Miss Avalon and Smarty Mr D, as well as Nasa's unstarted full brother Kendricks, are just some of the talented youngsters in the Servis barn.

J.R. and Rita Young have been attending the big, premiere races for years as fans and

traveled to New York in 2004 in order to cheer on Smarty Jones during his epic Triple Crown attempt. It was on the massive Belmont Park backstretch that the couple met John Servis for the first time.

Rita Young remembers, "He was so gracious, signing our (Smarty Jones) hats for us. We were so impressed, but had no idea he'd eventually be training for us in Pennsylvania."

Entering the industry in Pennsylvania has been an incredibly smart decision for the couple. Now just over ten years later, thanks to John Servis and his expert knowledge of the fantastic Keystone State breeding and racing program, JRita Young Thoroughbreds has become just one more ownership group that is hooked on the opportunities that can be found within Pennsylvania horse racing.
