# **Sloane Ranger: Always a Trooper**


Racing fans will remember Sloane Ranger as he was on the racetrack: a gritty, hard-knocking Pennsylvania-bred that earned over half a million dollars. Now he is enjoying a second career over jumps in the show ring, proving once again that off-track Thoroughbreds have a wide array of options for a second career.

Thorough

Vicky Schowe bred and raced Sloane Ranger, who defied the odds from birth. "Being a small breeder, he was an absolute gift," Schowe said. "He was the only horse I bred that year, and she was my only broodmare."

Sloane Ranger, a son of Parker's Storm Cat. was foaled in 2006 from the winning You and I mare Toppenish, who almost didn't survive the night. "The mare colicked when he was born," Schowe recalled. "She went to New Bolton and they wound up doing colic surgery, but because she wasn't insured they asked me if I wanted to put her down instead. I couldn't do that to a horse, and I'd had her since she was 3. Through the whole thing, her colt was very stoic. He behaved himself so well, almost as if he knew he had to behave himself, so my younger daughter and I started calling him Trooper. That's what his barn name became."

"Trooper" would grow up to be Sloane Ranger, named for the United Kingdom term of a young upper-class person pursuing a fashionable lifestyle. He was quirky, Schowe noted, he "didn't like to be touched on the



head, and always had a lot of energy, but he was also funny." Sloane Ranger liked to race a filly that he was turned out with in the paddock as a youngster, but would often "cheat" by cutting across the field while she ran the perimeter. "He would meet her on the other side, as if to say 'l'm not going the whole way around!'"

Despite his "goofball" tendencies off the track, Schowe saw a difference in her silly gelding once he got into serious training. Under the tutelage of trainer Martin Ciresa, Sloane Ranger took to training well approaching his first career start. Dismissed at 12-1 in his Penn National debut on July 31, 2009, Sloane Ranger romped home by 7 lengths. "My husband and I were watching the race, and when he pulled away and crossed the wire we looked at each other and said, 'Was that Trooper!?' That kind of effort normally doesn't happen in a first start, and we had no expectations."

Sloane Ranger bounced around the Pennsylvania circuit, picking up a handful of thirds and a second, but didn't win again until November 2010, when he added a  $1\frac{1}{16}$ -mile allowance race by  $5\frac{3}{4}$  lengths. From there he blossomed, ready to have an outstanding year in 2011.

Starting with an allowance win at Parx Racing in January, Sloane Ranger hit the board seven consecutive times through July. He picked up his first stakes-placing when second in the \$75,000 Docent Stakes in June, a preview of the future.

That fall's \$100,000 Maryland Million Sprint Handicap at Laurel Park is a race that still stands out to Schowe. Sloane Ranger scored by a half-length, stopping the clock in 1:10.15 over eight rivals. "That was a wonderful event," she said. "They really treat the owners very well."

Showing his typical gameness, Sloane Ranger often ran hard against tough stakes competition and almost always picked up a check. He was third in the \$150,000 Frank J. De Francis Memorial Dash, second in the \$75,000 Lyman Handicap, and won the \$150,000 Donald LeVine Memorial in 2012. That race set him up for Schowe's favorite effort of "Trooper's" career; the \$200,000 Monmouth Cup-G2. Sloane Ranger finished third after dueling with eventual winner Rule through much of the 1-mile race. Multiple Grade 1 winner Flat Out finished a head in front of Sloane Ranger for second.

He added one more stakes race, the \$75,000 Banjo Picker Sprint, but in 2013 and 2014 Sloane Ranger lost a step, eventually struggling in allowance class races. "Those allowances were stakes level," Schowe said. "If he's just going to be in against such stiff competition, even if he always ran his heart out, we had to do what's right by the horse. He deserved a good life, and I think now he has a great one where he's really enjoying himself."

Sloane Ranger was retired with \$540,004 in earnings and eight wins, six seconds and nine thirds in 41 starts. He returned home to live with Schowe, who quickly realized her horse needed a job. "He was home for a while, but he's very athletic and he needed to do something."

Schowe turned the horse over to Brooks VonNieda, who has retrained

numerous off-track Thoroughbreds at her Straight Up Stables, a 50-acre farm in Nottingham that offers boarding, sales and horse shows. "I find their niche and move them on other homes, but he was a special case," VonNieda said. "My best friend's daughter, Devon Williams, has been riding my sales horses for years, and when she started riding [Trooper] they just connected. I gave her the horse, and he jumps phenomenally."

Sloane Ranger kept his name for the show ring, is still known as Trooper around the barn, and is settling into his new life well. "The environment of the shows made him ready to race at first," VonNieda said. "It takes time to get acclimated, but each place we take him to he gets more relaxed."

Trooper's personality still shines through. He is kind, curious and pushy, but "not in a bad way," VonNieda added. "He knows what he wants, in a goofy way."

Schowe misses her horse, but knows he is in the best home possible. "I never thought I'd ever have a horse like that. I got many moments of enjoyment out of him, and I hated to give him away, but it was the right thing to do. You just can't put a horse like that out in a field to do nothing. He's a beautiful memory."
