Jump Start reaches stakes winner milestone

Pennsylvania sire Jump Start reached an important milestone this summer, when daughter Sexy Reasons became his 50th stakes winner.

"His 50 stakes winners for a regional stallion is quite astounding," said Richard Golden, President and CEO of Northview Stallion Station in Peach Bottom, where Jump Start currently stands.

Even from his racing days, Jump Start has had quite the journey. The Overbrook Farm homebred with a royal pedigree debuted to much fanfare, winning a Churchill Downs maiden race by 2 ¼ lengths in 2001. D. Wayne Lukas trained the son of A.P. Indy, and wheeled the colt back at Saratoga to win the \$150,000 Saratoga Special Stakes (G2). Jump Start ran second in the \$500,000 Champagne Stakes (G1) at Belmont Park, but was injured in the running of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile and retired with \$221,265 in earnings.

Jump Start stood his first six seasons at stud at Overbrook Farm before moving to Ghost Ridge Farms in Brogue, Pennsylvania. He shuttled for five years to Argentina, and although he doesn't shuttle anymore, his impact there is still being felt. In 2011, Jump Start was moved to Northview during a time in which his progeny was excelling.

Son Rail Trip won consecutive grade 2 events in California in 2010, then

moved to New York for the 2011 season before returning to the Golden State to rack up another grade 2 race at Del Mar in 2012. Rail Trip earned \$1,516,520 before his retirement a year later.

Another millionaire, Pants On Fire, won 11 of 35 starts including the Louisiana Derby (G2) and Pegasus Stakes (G3) in 2011 and the Monmouth Cup Stakes (G2) and Ack Ack Handicap (G3) in 2013. Prayer for Relief raced for seven seasons, earning \$2,277,948 over 46 starts. His victories include four graded stakes.

Jump Start's success as a stallion seemed inevitable, given his family. He is by the venerable A.P. Indy and out of the Storm Cat mare Steady Cat, a multiple graded stakes placed winner. Steady Cat's other foals include Steady Course, dam of the extremely talented grade 1-winner Mastery, and Lasting Appeal, who is the dam of multiple stakes placed Conquest Windycity. Steady Cat's Mr. Prospector dam, Hopespringsforever, never raced, but her progeny includes stakes winner Apollo Cat and Union City, second in the Santa Anita Derby (G1) in 1993.

With 12 crops of racing age, Jump Start has produced 602 winners from 911 starters (a 66% strike rate), and has progeny earnings of \$52,060,498. He has been the leading Mid-Atlantic sire for the last two seasons, with 13 runners that have earned at least half a million

dollars.

Current standouts on the track include a pair of six-year-olds, the multiple graded stakes placed Just Call Kenny, who ran second in the Salvator Mile (G3) at Monmouth in June, and Disco Chick, a Pennsylvania-bred with \$729,250 in earnings, who recently won the Regret Stakes at Monmouth.

Dr. Jerry Kolybabiuk bred and owns Disco Chick, who is out of the Disco Rico mare Disco Flirt, a five-time winner under Dr. Kolybabiuk's Freedom Racing banner. Disco Chick has won 10 of her 42 starts, has been in the top three spots a staggering 30 times.

"She did really well at Monmouth," Dr. Kolybabiuk said. "The race was fairly easy for her. We're very happy with Disco."

While Dr. Kolybabiuk contemplates selling Disco Chick at one of the Kentucky sales in November, he has other Jump Start offspring to keep an

eye on. "He's great, my favorite stud," he said. Kolybabiuk also bred Lover's Dream, a Jump Start daughter that earned \$227,738 and is now a broodmare. "I think the world of Jump Start," he continued. "I saw him in Kentucky when he was standing next to Storm Cat, and he was majestic looking. I've been breeding to him ever since and I've done really well as they are all nice horses. I've got two Jump Start colts that will run next year."

Just Call Kenny, a Virginia-bred, was bred by Althea Richards. The \$363,565-earner has won races at Belmont Park, Laurel Park, and Monmouth Park, as well as winning the \$100,000 Spectacular Bid Stakes at Gulfstream Park. A \$35,000 yearling, Just Call Kenny was out of Richards's winning Green Dancer mare, Green Jeans.

While his American progeny excel, his Argentinian runners are also

thriving. The juvenile filly Sexy Reasons captured the 50th stakes winner milestone by taking the June 25 Clasico Gran Premio Criterium Potrancas (G2) in Uruguay. Two other Argentina-based runners have been named Champion, with Idolo Porteno earning the honor as Horse of the Year, Champion Stayer, and Champion Older Horse in 2015, and Seresta taking the title of Champion Two Year Old Filly in 2016. Other stakes horses include \$865,900-earner Willet and \$790,834-earner Miss Behaviour.

With successful offspring on two continents, Jump Start's legacy will continue to grow. "Jump Start is an amazing sire," Northview's Golden said. "We actually have limited his book to approximately 75 mares this year." 18-year-old Jump Start stood for \$10,000 in 2017.

A few words from the Executive Secretary



Fall is just around the corner, and with it comes the annual submission of the broodmare domicile report. The PHBA is happy to announce that the submission dates have changed, effective for the 2018 crop of foals.

Broodmares must be in the state by December 1st, or within 14 days after a public sale. Previously the deadline was November 1st. Coinciding with this change, broodmare domicile reports must be submitted to the PHBA by December 15, 2017. If you are breeding back to a Pa Stallion the domicile requirement is now 60 days and that report must be received in the office within 14 days of entering the state.

Forms can be found online at www.pabred.com/forms. It would be greatly appreciated if you can fill out and submit the form online. If you are unable to submit the form online, you may either print out a report and mail it in, or let us know and we'll mail a copy to you.
