## New Broodmare Domicile Requirements & Registration Eligibility for 2018 Foals

With the 2018 breeding season rapidly approaching, the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association is informing all of our current breeders (and prospective new breeders sending mares to Pennsylvania) that we have recently changed our Broodmare Domicile requirements, as well as Registration Eligibility criteria for foal crops beginning in 2018. We are pleased to announce these changes, as we believe that it will benefit both in, and out-of-state broodmare owners.

The deadline for broodmares entering Pennsylvania during the year of conception has been moved back one month from November 1, to the new deadline of December 1 as indicated below.

(1) The dam of the foal resided continuously in Pennsylvania on or before December 1, 2017, through foaling. Mares not being bred back will fall under this category.



For in-foal broodmares purchased at a public auction, this date has also been extended to December 1 (formerly November 1).

(2) The dam of the foal was purchased at a public sale after December 1, 2017, then brought into Pennsylvania within 14 days of the date of purchase, and resided in Pennsylvania through foaling. During the year of foaling (2018), the foal or its dam must spend at least ninety (90) days in the state.

Mares not meeting the criteria outlined above, but will be bred back to a Registered Pennsylvania stallion, have to reside in the

state for 60 consecutive days (formerly 90 days).

(3) The dam of the foal will be bred back in 2018 to a stallion standing in Pennsylvania (which is registered with the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders

Association as a Pennsylvania stallion during the breeding season of the year foaling) and reside in the state for at least sixty (60) consecutive days during which foaling occurred.

Mares bred to registered Pennsylvania stallions are up substantially this year, according to our preliminary count, and continuing that trend will move us to an increase in PA registered foals, which is our priority.
