## Quality breeding in PA

When it comes to choosing a stallion for their mare, Pennsylvania's breeders have many fine choices. The state's stallion roster for 2018 reflects that diversity, ranging from the leading stallion in the Mid-Atlantic region to young sires that sport top race records and pedigrees.

And breeders can choose with confidence, as the resulting foal will be supported by a lucrative breeding program that has been distributing more than \$30 million in awards, owner bonuses, and restricted races for the last five years.

Topping all stallions in the state, as well as in the region, is perennial leading sire Jump Start, whose total progeny earnings in 2017 have surpassed \$5 million for the fourth consecutive year, and his lifetime earnings are pushing towards \$54 million. He stands at Northview PA in Peach Bottom, a full-service Thoroughbred facility, for \$10,000 live foal.

A son of A.P. Indy out of Steady Cat, by Storm Cat, Jump Start was a precocious, graded stakes winner at 2, and has gone on to an outstanding stud career. He's sired 58 stakes winners, 17 graded or group winners, and 15 Grade 1 winners, topped by Prayer for Relief (\$2.2 million), as well as millionaires Pants On Fire (\$1.6 million) and Rail Trip (\$1.5 million). His North American average earnings per starter is \$81,639.

While Jump Start is the anchor of the Northview PA roster, two new stallions are setting sail on their stud careers.

Fresh off his first season in 2017, during which he bred 103 mares, is Uncle Lino, a track record-setting, Grade 1-placed performer and the first son of top sire Uncle Mo to stand in the Mid-Atlantic region.

Uncle Lino set a track record in winning the California Chrome Stakes at Los Alamitos, running the 1 $\frac{1}{16}$ -mile distance in 1:40.82, and was second in the Robert B. Lewis Stakes-G3 and third in the Santa Anita Derby-G1, retiring with earnings of \$316,160 from eight starts.

Uncle Lino has an outstanding bottom line, being out of the Orientate mare Haysee, a full sister to Grade 1 Alabama Stakes winner Lady Joanne and half-sister to classic winner Shackelford. His 2018 stud fee is \$4,000 live foal.

Joining Northview PA for 2018 is Peace and Justice, a son of War Front. Peace and Justice has a unique offer: A bonus payment of \$250,000 will be paid to the official breeder of record with The Jockey Club of the stallion's first offspring to win a non-restricted stakes race during the period from Jan. 1, 2021 and ending Dec. 31, 2022. For more details on the bonus, contact the farm.

Peace and Justice broke his maiden at Belmont Park, and was a multiple allowance winner at Santa Anita, in which he ran three 95+ Beyer Speed Figures. He's a half-brother to graded stakes winner Hudson Steele (\$513,824, Dixie S-G2, etc.), and stands for \$3,500 live foal.

An exciting young stallion whose first foals have come out running in 2017 is El Padrino.

A son of Pulpit, El Padrino was the sire of two stakes winners on the Delaware Park card Sept. 30—Enchanted Star, winner of the Small Wonder Stakes, and Whereshetoldmetogo, who captured the First State Dash Stakes. He is also the sire of five other juvenile winners.

El Padrino, who won the Grade 2 Risen Star Stakes and earned more than \$326,000 during his racing career, is a half-brother to multiple Grade 1 winner Verrazano. El Padrino stands for \$5,000 live foal.

Northview PA is also home to solid established sires Bullsbay (\$3,000 live foal) and Medallist (\$2,000 live foal).

Ron and Barbara Rickline's Xanthus Farms in Gettysburg offers a wide variety of stallions to suit any mare, and has been among the top breeders in the state for many years.

New to Xanthus in 2018 is multiple stakes winner Unfettered, standing for \$2,000 live foal, as the property of DB Dojo LLC.

A gray or roan son of champion sire Rockport Harbor, Unfettered captured nine of 16 starts during his career, earning \$209,516, including the SunRay Park and Casino Handicap at SunRay Park, and is out of a half-sister to millionaire and Grade 1 winner Unbridled Belle. His first foals arrive in 2018.

Also new is Drinkwiththedevil, by top sire Smart Strike out of Approve, by Deputy Minister, who stands for \$1,000 live foal.

From 54 foals of racing age, Drinkwiththedevil has sired four stakes winners, including Bisque, 2013 Indiana-Bred 2-Year-old Colt of the Year.

The Xanthus stallion lineup also features Xixixi, a half-brother to Triple Crown winner American Pharoah, who stands for \$3,500 live foal, or \$2,500 for mares foaling in PA. His first crop will be yearlings in 2018.

Also standing are Andiron (\$2,000 live foal), Banachek (\$2,000 live foal), In the Woods (\$1,500 live foal), Red Vine (\$3,500 live foal), Southern Success (\$1,500 live foal), Taken by the Storm (\$1,500 live foal), Victory Isle (\$1,500 live foal) and White Mercedes (\$1,500 live foal).

Chip and Barbara Wheeler's WynOaks Farm in Delta is home to Weigelia, an outstanding sire with average earnings per starter of \$72,610, quite a return on investment for his stud fee of \$3,500 live foal.

Weigelia has sired 14 winners of more than \$100,000 and five stakes winners—his leading earners are Fat Kat (\$423,318), Pink Princess (\$420,328), Isabella Swift (\$414,589), Disco Rose (\$403,010) and Brenda's Way (\$350,752).

WynOaks also stands Rule by Night, a multiple stakes-winning son of leading sire Malibu Moon out of Silver Reserve, by Silver Deputy, a half-sister to Boone's Mill, a 2-year-old graded stakes winner of more than \$400,000. He stands for \$3,500, the fee payable after the foal's first win.

Glenn and Becky Brok's Diamond B Farm in Mohrsville, a leading breeder in 2017, stands Got the Last Laugh, a son of Distorted Humor. He's sired 13-time winner Dixie's Last Laugh, an earner of \$268,040 who won six of eight starts in 2017. The sire of 84 percent winners from starters, his runners include stakes-placed runners Grady (\$209,460), Laugh At Life (\$190,630), Big Foot Ben (\$115,729), and Sepicato (\$114,297). Got the Last Laugh stands for \$2,500 live foal.

A Grade 1 performer who earned more than \$600,000, Talent Search, by Catienuus out of Mrs. K., by Dixieland Band, has sired the winners of \$4.25 million, including two stakes winners and four stakes-placed horses. He stands for \$2,500 live foal.

Stakes winner and graded stakes-placed Uptowncharlybrown has gotten off to a strong start at stud from his first two small crops, including Midtowncharlybrown, a stakes-placed earner of \$151,700, and Alan's Legacy, who's earned over \$100,000.

A son of Limehouse, Uptowncharlybrown stands as the property of Uptowncharlybrown Stud LLC for \$1,500 with a special offer for breeders: Pay no stud fee until the foal wins.

Diamond B also stands Eclipticalspraline, whose first Pennsylvania foals were born in 2017. A winner at Gulfstream Park, he stands for \$1,200 live foal.

Dr. William Solomon's Pin Oak Lane Farm in New Freedom stands two outstanding stallions: Lord Shanakill, who has sired Group 1 winner My Dream Boat (\$998,843) and Dark Kingdom (\$667,585), and Last Gunfighter, a millionaire, graded stakes-winning son of First Samurai.

Lord Shanakill, a son of Speightstown and a half-brother to Group 1 winner Together Forever (Ire), stands for \$3,500 live foal.

Last Gunfighter, who captured four graded stakes during his career and posted seven triple-digit Beyer Speed figures while defeating the best of his generation, stands for \$2,500 live foal. His first foals are yearlings of 2018.
