

# Millionaire Tom's Ready heads off to stud

GMB Racing's Tom's Ready has completed his racing journey. It began in the rolling hills of Pine Grove, Pa., continued to the country's finest racetracks where he faced the toughest competition, and now has ended at Spendthrift Farm in the Bluegrass of Kentucky, where he'll stand at stud.

The bay son of More Than Ready out of the Broad Brush mare Goodbye Stranger, foaled at Blackstone Farm on Feb. 1, 2013, was purchased by GMB Racing, the nom-de-course of owners Gayle and Tom Benson, for \$145,000 at the 2014 Fasig-Tipton New York Saratoga yearling sale.

He represented a renewed interest in the Thoroughbred business by Tom Benson, who'd owned Thoroughbreds in the 1970s and 1980s, racing them at old Jefferson Downs, La., as well as at the Fair Grounds. The 90-year-old Benson is a self-made billionaire, who started out as a bookkeeper at a New Orleans Chevrolet dealership with only a high school diploma, and then parlayed his money into additional dealerships, banks and sports teams.

In 1985, Benson bought the NFL's New Orleans

By 2014, Benson and his wife Gayle decided to get back into Thoroughbred racing at the highest levels, naming their stable "GMB" (for Gayle Marie Benson). Since that time, they've invested more than \$20 million in horses as well as a Kentucky farm, christened Benson Farm, where they currently house four broodmares.

At the Saratoga sale, trainer Dallas Stewart saw the colt and thought he would be able to buy him for the Bensons. He asked Greg Bensel, who manages the GMB Racing operations and is also the Saints and Pelicans senior vice-president for communications and broadcasting, how much Tom Benson was prepared to pay. As the story goes, Bensel asked Benson if he was ready to buy the colt, and Benson replied, "I'm ready." When the sale was complete, the colt had his name — Tom's Ready.

While many owners wait years for their sales ring purchases to pay dividends, the Bensons hit the jackpot almost immediately with Tom's Ready. As a 2-year-old, he broke his maiden at Churchill Downs and was second in the \$81,750 Street Sense Stakes at the Louisville oval, beaten a length by another GMB Racing horse, Mo Tom.

Tom's Ready blossomed at 3, winning or placing in four graded stakes. His season was highlighted by a second-place finish in the Grade 2 Louisiana Derby, and then both he and Mo Tom

gave the Bensons the thrill of a lifetime as they were both entered in the Kentucky Derby-G1. While neither finished in the money, Tom's Ready came back five weeks later with an exciting off-the-pace victory in the \$500,000, Grade 2 Woody Stephens Stakes at Belmont Park on Belmont Stakes day, leaving in his wake the talented Sharp Azteca. A win in the \$100,000, Grade 3 Ack Ack Stakes October at Churchill Downs, over a field that included sprint champion Runhappy, was his final triumph of the year.

At age 4, Tom's Ready continued to compete against top company, winning the \$200,000, Bold Ruler Handicap-G3 at Belmont Park, and placing in three other graded events, including the Grade 1 Forego Stakes at Saratoga. His final start came in the Grade 1 Cigar

Mile at Aqueduct on Dec. 2.

Tom's Ready retires with a record of five wins and seven placings from 21 starts, and \$1,036,267.

"He was a real war horse," said Stewart, in reflecting upon his career. "He battled hard in every race, against the best competition at Saratoga, Bel-Churchill mont, Downs. He won Pennsylvania at Presque Isle Downs on the polytrack. He traveled around and always gave his best."

Stewart said that Tom's Ready

was a real character in the barn, and had "cute little pointy ears."

"He loved apples, and loved to graze," said Stewart. "He had a great personality. He was a very sound horse and had no health issues. Hopefully I can train some of his sons and daughters in the future."

It was announced on Dec. 4 that the colt would stand at Spend-thrift Farm for the 2018 season. His stud fee is set at \$6,000 live foal, and he will participate in Spendthrift's popular "Share The Upside" program for a fee of \$7,500.

"He was our first yearling purchase in 2014, and he was our first 3-year-old to get enough points to run in the Kentucky Derby,"

said Gayle Benson. "He has provided us with so much joy and fun. We're so proud of him and very proud of Dallas (Stewart) for training him, and of course we are thrilled for the success of the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association for having another champion and hopefully great stallion. We look forward to bringing a few of our mares from Benson Farm to Tom's Ready at Spendthrift."

"Gayle and I love the horse racing industry and we love seeing Tom's Ready head off to Spendthrift to stand as a stallion," said Tom Benson. "While it is bittersweet to have his racing career end, he is ready to move on to his next job. We could not be more proud of all of the work that went into getting him to become a very fine racehorse, and that started with the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association all

the way to Dallas (Stewart) and his fine staff that cared so deeply for Tom's Ready.

"We would also like to thank everyone at Spendthrift, especially Mr. (B. Wayne) Hughes, Ned (Toffey), and Mark (Toothaker), for believing in our horse," continued Benson.

Tom's Ready retires 26th on the list of 29 Pennsylvaniabred millionaires. Eight PA-breds earned more than \$2 million during their careers, led Someday Farm's Smarty Jones. who bankrolled

\$7,613,155 in 2003-'04. He is followed by Japanese-based Nobo Jack (\$4,033,400), Alphabet Soup (\$2,990,270), Hard Spun (\$2,673,470), With Anticipation (\$2,660,543), Yankee Affair (\$2,282,156), Sahpresa (\$2,032,282) and Princess of Sylmar (\$2,017,220).

Three millionaires were added to the list in 2017 — in addition to Tom's Ready, they are multiple Grade 1 winner Mor Spirit and Eclipse Award winner Finest City. Two PA-bred millionaires remain in training — the durable gelding Page McKenney (\$1,756,378) and Mor Spirit (\$1,668,400). Closing in on the mark is Favorite Tale (with \$960,300).

# **Sprint star Unique Bella gets first Grade 1 win**

Unique Bella, one of the most dynamic 3-year-old fillies of 2017, capped off her breakout season with a Grade 1 score in the La Brea Stakes at Santa Anita on Dec. 26. In recording her fifth win of the year, all in graded stakes, the daughter of Tapit increased her career earnings to \$592,400 from eight starts for owner Don Alberto Stable.

Trained throughout her career by Hall of Famer Jerry Hollendorfer, the gray Brushwood Stable-bred filly shot to the top of everyone's watch list at the end of her 2-year-old season when breaking her maiden in her second start by more than 10 lengths at Del Mar. She became one of the nation's most notable 3-year-olds when winning the Grade 2 Santa Ynez Stakes at Santa Anita on Jan. 8 by seven and a half lengths in only her third start. Less than a month later, she struck in the Grade 2 Las Virgenes Stakes, scoring by eight and three-quarter lengths, and became the heavy favorite on Churchill Downs' 2017 Kentucky Oaks Future Wager.

Her next step was a victory in the Grade 3 Santa Ysabel at Santa Anita in March. The margin wasn't as great — two and a quarter lengths — but the runnerup was Abel Tasman, who by the end of the year was widely regarded as the leader of the division.

While Abel Tasman was winning the Kentucky Oaks-G1, Unique Bella was on the sidelines due to a sore shin. Her return to the races seven months later was another stellar effort, a three and a half length victory in the L.A. Woman Stakes-G3 in her first start against older runners. Sent off as favorite in the Grade 1 Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint back at Del Mar, she smoked through an opening quarter in :21.84 and a half in :44.35, which drained her as the field hit the top of the stretch. She faded to seventh in the 14-horse field.

Once again facing 3-year-olds in the La Brea, Unique Bella prompted a more modest pace before taking aim at the talented Paradise Woods and driving past in the final sixteenth to finish in 1:21.49 for the seven furlongs.

Unique Bella is the second foal out of Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic-G1 winner Unrivaled Belle (by Unbridled's Song), whom Betty Moran purchased as a broodmare prospect for \$2.8 million in 2011 and resold at the 2016 November sale for \$3.8 million. Unique Bella was purchased by her current owner as a yearling at Keeneland September for \$400,000.



## FASIG-TIPTON MIDLANTIC DECEMBER MIXED SALE LED BY HARRY WEISLEDER/DASL STABLE DISPERSAL

Dr. Harry Weisleder, a dedicated Harrisburg dentist who turned a passion of horse racing into a growing operation with Pennsylvania horseman Clovis Crane, died suddenly of a heart attack on Nov. 6 at age 72. His wife Cammy (Leib) Weisleder chose to disperse his stable, and the horses were a late addition to the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic December Mixed sale in Timonium, Md., held on Dec. 5.

Sold by Crane as agent, the Weisleder consignment of 34 horses – a number of them bought at Timonium over the years – sold for \$733,500 and included the sales topper, the 3-year-old stakes-placed colt Carradine, who was purchased by his trainer, Linda Rice, for \$105,000. The son of Grasshopper had last raced in April at Laurel Park, when fourth in the Federico Tesio Stakes, and earned \$156,100 from eight starts in Weisleder's DASL Stable colors. Second highest price from the consignment was Carradine's dam Summer Moon, a daughter of Maria's Mon sold in foal to Bodemeister for \$48,000 to Ed Price.

Weisleder's operation included the racing stable — he noted on Thoroughbred OwnerView that what he liked about Thorough-

bred racing was "the dream" and his best experience as an owner was "every time you win" — but he also was highly successful as a pinhooker. On a smaller scale was a breeding operation, and those young PA-Breds were in the sale. The highest-price was realized for a Maclean's Music weanling filly out of Spinning Looks, a daughter of Hard Spun and the stakes-winning mare Mingling Glances. The first foal for Spinning Looks, the filly, bred by Crane Thoroughbred Services LLC, sold for \$25,000 to D R Investments.

The most expensive weanling in the sale was a Pennsylvania-bred, but not from the Weisleder dispersal. Longtime breeder/owner/trainer Daniel Lopez offered breeding stock with agent Gracie Bloodstock, sold in the name of his Joe-Dan Farm. The City Zip weanling filly out of Lopez's top racemare Geeky Gorgeous brought a final bid of \$80,000 from agent Doug Arnold.

The PA-Bred filly is the second foal out of Geeky Gorgeous, a five-time stakes winner of \$525,644. The family includes Geeky Gorgeous' stakes-winning half-brother Chubble Maker and half-sister Lookinforchange, and graded stakes winners Texas Glitter and Mr. John.





## **Pennsylvania News Briefs**

## GROWN OF THORNS IN PA

Rodney Eckenrode will stand former Florida stallion Crown of Thorns at his Equistar Training Center in Annville, Pa. A 13-year-old son of millionaire Repent who formerly stood at Woodford Thoroughbreds in Reddick, Fla., for \$2,000, payable when the foal stands and nurses, Crown of Thorns has the same stud fee and conditions in 2018. Woodford retains ownership.

With 49 foals in his first three crops to race, Crown of Thorns is represented by stakes winner and graded stakes-placed Swagger Jagger, and I'malreadythere, who placed in four straight stakes, including the Grade 1 Los Alamitos Futurity and Grade 3 Bob Hope Stakes at 2. His 37 starters have earned more than \$1.2 million.


Crown of Thorns was a graded stakes winner of \$821,693 in 13 starts. He won both his outings at 3: the Robert B. Lewis Stakes-G2, getting  $11/_{16}$  miles in 1:40.76 over Santa Anita's synthetic track, after winning a 7-furlong maiden special in 1:20.65 by 7 lengths over the same surface.

Away from the races for 19 months, he made three starts at 4—two in Grade 1 races. Following a second in the Ancient Title at 6 furlongs to Gayego, he missed by a nose to Dancing in Silks in that year's Breeders' Cup Sprint at Oak Tree at Santa Anita.

His two starts at 5 were seconds in the 7-furlong Pat O'Brien-G1 at Del Mar and 11/8-mile Goodwood-G1 at Santa Anita.

Crown of Thorns returned at 6 to capture the Grade 2 Mervyn LeRoy Handicap, defeating Sidney's Candy by more than a length, and was third in the Pat O'Brien-G1.

Champion sprinter and top sire Smoke Glacken is a half-brother to Crown of Thorns' dam Crowning Touch (by Thunder Gulch), as is graded stakes winner and stakes producer Smokey Glacken, stakes winner and producer Capote's Crown and graded stakes-placed Argyle Pink. Champion Tepin, millionaire Vyjack and graded winners Miss Slewpy and sire Disco Rico are also found in the family.



# New Broodmare Domicile Requirements & Registration Eligibility for 2018 Foals

We are pleased to announce that the Registration Eligibility and Broodmare Domicile requirements for the 2018 crop of foals have changed. Mares bred to registered PA-Sires are up substantially this year, according to our preliminary count, and continuing that trend will move us to an increase in registered foals, which is our priority.

- The dam of the foal resided continuously in Pennsylvania since DECEMBER 1 of the year of conception through foaling. Mares not being bred back will fall under this category. (Formerly November 1.)
- The dam of the foal was purchased at a public sale after DECEMBER 1 of the year of conception and brought into Pennsylvania within 14 days of the date of purchase and remained continuously through foaling. During the year of foaling, the foal or its dam spent at least ninety (90) days in the state. (Formerly November 1.)

• The dam of the foal arrived after **DECEMBER 1** of the year of conception, foaled in Pennsylvania and was bred back to a registered PA stallion standing in Pennsylvania and the dam of the foal resided **SIXTY (60)** consecutive days during which foaling occurred.

The PA-Bred stakes calendar kicks off in April with two seven-furlong sprints for older runners at Parx Racing the final Saturday of the month.

## Pennsylvania Nursery Wraps Up 2017 PA-Bred Stakes Schedule

#### **Pennsylvania Nursery**

It was impossible to overlook Prince Lucky in the Pennsylvania Nursery at Parx on Dec. 2. Dan McConnell's bay colt, making his first start in Pennsylvania, boasted a record of 2-for-3 in open company at Delaware Park and Laurel Park, his wins coming easily (combined margin of nearly 10 lengths). His only loss was in his second start when third as the 3-5 choice in the First State Dash Stakes at Delaware Park in September.

Trainer Larry Jones sent the son of Corinthian from his Delaware Park base to Parx and watched him pull away a two and three-guarter length winner as the 4-5 favorite over Tudox Expectations. Jw'strickymischief finished another four lengths back in third over the tiring track. Final time for the seven furlongs was 1:27.62.

With the win, Prince Lucky has earned \$132,690 in four starts.

Prince Lucky is a second-generation homebred for McConnell, who co-bred the colt's dam Lucky Notion (by Great Notion) with Norris Gelman and Lee Vosters, and campaigned the PA-Bred mare with Gelman for two full seasons before retiring her after a January start in 2012. Lucky Notion picked up checks her entire 12-start career, earning \$117,464 with five wins, three seconds, two thirds and two fourths.

Bred that spring, Lucky Notion produced the winning Rimrod filly O Aubrey in 2013. Her second foal, the Redeemed filly Saint Main Event trained by Keith Nations, has also been a model of consistency, finishing third or better in 10 of 15 starts while earning \$154,579 for McConnell. Prince Lucky, whose sire Corinthian stood at Pin Oak Lane from 2014 until being sold to Turkey this past July, is the mare's third foal. Barren in 2016, she had an El Padrino filly last February and was bred back to Uncle Lino.

Prince Lucky has moved with Jones' string to Fair Grounds, where he posted a work of :47.60 in a Christmas Eve breeze. the third fastest of 108 works.


