Charly making a little magic in Pennsylvania

As they say in Hollywood, life imitates the movies.

My late best friend was trainer Alan Seewald, who unexpectedly passed away eight years ago this April while Uptowncharlybrown was on the Triple Crown trail. Alan thought Uptowncharlybrown was the best of his generation and once turned down \$2.5 million for 'Charly' as he's affectionately known.

At the same time, we also had a top-class filly in the barn who was turning heads by the name of R Betty Graybull. Betty was a multiple stakes winner and earned nearly a half-million dollars. Among her many victims with her pattented last-to-first style was Grade 2 winner Quiet Giant (now best known as the dam of Gun Runner) in the Ladies Handicap. We used to tease Alan all the time that we were going to breed Betty to Charly while he wasn't looking. Unfortunately, fate had other plans for all involved.

Betty was subsequently sold to Adena Springs for \$300,000. With Alan's passing, what Charly couldn't prove on the racetrack because his career was short circuited because of injury, he's now proving as a prolific sire. Through late March, Charly was the number one third-crop sire in Pennsylvania and the Mid-Atlantic region. He's produced 80 percent winners, with his progeny averaging nearly \$60,000 per starter. Three

different offspring have won by margins of greater than 10 lengths and already exceeded \$100,000 in career earnings.

If that wasn't enough, Midtowncharly-brown is among the finalists for Pennsylvania-bred 3-year-old top male honors of 2017, with six wins from nine starts, including a stakes-placing. Charly's daughter, Dixie Serenade, was among the top 2-year-old Pennsylvania-bred fillies last year. Dixie's next assignment is the \$300,000 Gazelle Stakes-G2 at Agueduct on April 7, as we

point her toward the Grade 1 \$1,000,000 Kentucky Oaks the first Friday in May. Charly's current crop of juveniles are training up a storm in Ocala, Fla. It won't be long until we unveil the most powerful group of his sons and daughters yet.

Yes, you can say Pennsylvania is being very well represented by the Uptowncharlybrown progeny. Everywhere I go these days I'm being congratulated about Charly's success as a stallion. In the next breath I'm often asked about the Pennsylvania state-bred program. Everyone can see the tremendous breeding award money being offered. I often feel as if I'm the ambassador from Pennsylvania promoting the program, but it's all true!

We believed so much in the Penn-

sylvania program that we continued to purchase quality broodmares to support Uptowncharlybrown, and we now proudly own 15. Bar none, Pennsylvania offers the best state-bred program in the land.

We still had one piece of unfinished business that was eight years in the making. When we noticed R Betty Graybull was set to be auctioned off in November 2015, one of our partners successfully bid \$110,000 to get her back. He did so with only one thought in mind, that is, to make a little magic! On March 4, we were blessed with the arrival of a gorgeous and perfectly-balanced Uptowncharlybrown PA-Bred filly out of R Betty Graybull. You've heard the expression 'Only in Hollywood?" Well introducing Pennsylvania's version of "Only in Pennsylvania". . .

May I suggest you run, don't walk, to buy yourself a broodmare as the Pennsylvania state-bred program will reward you many times over. As they say in the movie Back To The Future: To Be Continued. . .
