Dazzling displays on Pennsylvania Day at the Races

Pennsylvania-Breds put on a dazzling display during the five stakes races on the annual Pennsylvania Day at the Races event at Parx Aug. 3. The 12-race card with purses totaling \$1 million was made up entirely of contests exclusive to horses bred in the Keystone State. The runners didn't disappoint, displaying their athleticism and grace in spades.

Five-year-old mare Afleet Tizzy won the \$107,800 Dr. Teresa Garofalo Memorial Stakes at 6 furlongs on the dirt, scoring by a length under Angel Rodriguez in 1:10.52. It was the sixth lifetime win but first stakes victory for the daughter of Tizway out of the unraced Successful Appeal mare Nec Metu. John Tyler Servis trains for Marvin Delfiner and George Krall.

The trainer's father, John Servis, won a different stakes race on the card, the \$119,800 Roanoke Stakes with Someday Jones. The 6-year-old son of Kentucky Derby-G1 and Preakness Stakes-G1 hero Smarty Jones was fourth in last year's Roanoke, but improved to score by 6¼ lengths in the 1¼-mile main track event.

It was the ninth win in 22 lifetime starts for Someday Jones, who last year took the

Robellino Stakes at Penn National in August. His dam, the Concern mare Last Toots, was a stakes-placed winner who has produced six winners from six to race, including Neshaminy. Parx has a \$100,000 turf sprint called the Neshaminy Stakes, run in early September, which Servis had penciled in for Someday Jones but didn't run him.

"He's great, he's like a pony," Servis said of Someday Jones after the race. "It's hard to believe he's a full horse because he's so laid back. He's got a ton of class and is so easy to deal with, easy to gallop. He just goes out and does his thing. There's never been an issue with this horse with his attitude, he's great in that regard."

Someday Jones is owned by Main Line Racing Stable and Alexandria Stable. He

was bred by Patricia Chapman, who also campaigned the horse's famous sire, Smarty Jones. "I was so excited about this race and so glad I was there to see it and congratulate his owners," Chapman said. "They very graciously let me shove my way into the winner's circle with them and even let me stand between them. I'm so proud of this son of Smarty Jones and pleased he is trained by 'Team Servis!'" Servis also trained Smarty Jones, who returned from Kentucky to stand at stud in Pennsylvania this year.

The \$100,000 Mrs. Penny Stakes over 1 $\frac{1}{16}$ miles on the grass went to ImPLY, winning her third consecutive stakes race. The daughter of E Dubai—Allude, by Orientate is trained by T. Bernard Houghton for Larry Karp's Barlar LLC.

"I've been at this for 35 years, and while she's not American Pharoah or Justify, she's right up there for me for sure," Karp said. "This is by far the best horse I've ever bred."

Under jockey Julio Hernandez, ImPLY settled fourth early in a nine-horse field. She took the lead heading into the stretch and kicked clear, scoring by 2 lengths over Pink Elephant and Shemakesmehappy. The final time was 1:48.47.

With 12 wins in 28 starts and 21 top-three finishes for earnings of \$769,228,

ImPLY has proven herself one of the classiest horses in Pennsylvania. "She came out of the race great; everything is good," said trainer Houghton. "I honestly think the race was fairly easy for her, she didn't have to stress or run too much. She's been an absolute pleasure."

Hollywood Talent took the \$100,000 Marshall Jenney Handicap sprinting five furlongs on the grass. He was a 12-1 shot, topping a rich trifecta with 38-1 shot Amblin Man a nose back second and 11-1 shot Smooth B third while favored Smokin Nitro finished fifth. The final time was :59.79.

Ten Strike Racing owns Hollywood Talent, an 8-year-old gelded son of Talent Search—Intrinsic Value, by Johannesburg. The dam was a \$115,000 yearling in 2006; she now has four winners from four to race.

Perhaps the most thrilling race of the day came in the \$100,000 Banjo Picker Sprint, which saw a three-horse finish and full brothers finishing first and second, just a neck apart. Five-year-old Midtowncharlybrown outlasted 4-year-old stablemate Midnightcharly in the 6-furlong, main track contest. The coupled entry was favored, with second wagering choice and defending champion The Man finishing a head back third. The race went in 1:10.64, with

Roberto Rosado riding the winner. Ed Colletti Jr. trains both Godric LLC-bred sons of Uptowncharlybrown out of the Speights-town mare Torchwood. Her 3-year-old daughter Charly's Charm, another full sibling, is 2-for-6 this year.

"I don't want to sound overly confident, but honestly, it was the result I expected," said Bob Hutt, owner of the Uptowncharlybrown Stud LLC. "Midnightcharly stumbled at the start; if not for that he probably would have been the winner. We call them the Smash Brothers, Mr. Inside and Mr. Outside. It's a nice recipe, we are really blessed." Hutt went on to note that, "I don't think all of America knows what's going on." He went on to explain about Uptowncharlybrown's 72 percent winners, 12 percent stakes winners from starters, and his extraordinary position on the stallion lists via his Average Earnings Index and Comparable Index. "The stallions ahead of him have 10-times the runners," Hutt said. Uptowncharlybrown could be standing in Kentucky, but Hutt is a believer in the Pennsylvania-Bred program. "The breeders awards are off the Richter scale."

Pennsylvania's Day at the Races was first launched in 2000, but did not reach \$1 million in purses until 2018. It is now one of the most anticipated events on the Pennsylvania racing calendar.

A few words from the Executive Secretary

Our second annual Million Dollar PA Day at the Races was a huge success! More than 450 breeders and their guests had a great time, as did Marty Shaw from Top Notch Racing who walked away, or should I say drove away, in a brand-new John Deere Gator donated by the NTRA. The fields were full and we were finally on the turf for the first time in three or four years.

Breeding season is upon us! As a reminder, Broodmare Domicile forms will be due by Dec. 1. For the foal crop of 2020,

broodmares must be in the state by Dec. 1, or within 14 days of a public sale. Mares bred to registered PA-Sires are up again this year, according to our preliminary count, and continuing that trend will move us to an increase in registered foals, which is our priority.

We ask that you submit all broodmare domicile forms online. You can access the online submission at www.pabred.com/ forms. If you cannot submit online, please call our office to make other arrangements.

Please do not use an old form as they are changing this year.

Online registration is coming soon! We are currently developing an online registration system where you will be able to register your foals, renew your membership, as well as access information on prior foals and breeder awards. Keep an eye out for further announcements on a launch date!
