Multi-Surface Winner Imply a "Unique" Breed



Owner/breeder Larry Karp noted she's "unique." Trainer Bernie Houghton called her, "an absolute pleasure to train." The mare in question? Imply, a six-year-old Pennsylvania-Bred daughter of E Dubai – Allude, by Orientate. The classy chestnut is riding a fourrace win streak – and five of her last six starts - after taking the \$100,000 Mrs. Penny Stakes at Parx on August 3.

Sitting fourth in a field of nine early, jockey Julio Hernandez tracked the pace set by Shemakesmehappy and O'Paddy, with Imply's stablemate and half-sister Advert running third. Imply rallied into the stretch to take the lead, ultimately drawing off to win by two lengths over Pink Elephant, with Shemakesmehappy third.

Imply ran the 1 1/16 mile turf race in 1:48.47. It was the 12th win in 28 starts for the homebred mare, who has earned \$769,228.

"She's not American Pharoah or Justify, but to me she's right up there for sure," Karp said. "I've been in this business for 35 years, and of all the horses I've had, this is the best one I bred myself."

Imply is scheduled to race just twice more, when she will likely retire. "She's six now and perfectly sound, and hasn't been over raced." Karp said. "She's very valuable; given her value, I wouldn't be able to breed her to just any down the street stallion. She has to go to a commercial stallion, which is expensive. It's about 80 to 20 percent that she won't be racing next year."

Imply's value is increased due to the

fact that she is a stakes winner on all three surfaces. "She's a very unique horse, which I don't say just because I own her. She has stakes wins on three different surfaces: grass, Tapeta, and dirt. That's really special. You don't find many horses that can even win on two surfaces."

Imply clearly doesn't mind running on anything. "She even got beat a nose in a stakes on a sloppy track, so she can handle everything," Karp said.

The gritty mare broke her maiden at Parx July 11, 2015 at 28-1 odds, scoring by a length over a field of juveniles. She added the Mrs. Henry D. Paxson Memorial on Presque Isle Downs' synthetic surface in her second start. She won three allowance races in 2016 before returning to the winner's circle in the Northern Fling Stakes in 2017. She added the Lyphard on turf and the Plum Pretty on dirt in 2018 before going on her current tear.

In her 2019 debut, Imply won another Presque Isle allowance May 21. She successfully defended her crown in the Lyphard, running away to win by 3 ¾ lengths. After finishing third in 2018, Imply wrestled back her Northern Fling title July 7, winning by 1 ¼ lengths over Darcy Mae, who was more than 10 in front of the third-place runner. The Mrs. Penny came next.

"I honestly think it was fairly easy for her," trainer Houghton said of the race. "She didn't have to stress or run too much."

Keeping her current win streak going is of high importance to Houghton, who likened himself to being "the manager of a baseball team. I have to place her in the right spots. It's going to be tough when she does get beat; people want me to try this race or that race but I think we're going good the way we are."

Imply is easy to be around in the barn. "She just does her business. She's nice to ride. I have one exercise rider that gets on her all the time. She's a little strong but not too bad. She loves to stand at the racetrack and just stand for half an hour if you let her."

Karp obtained Imply's dam Allude in 2011 at the Keeneland November Sale when she was in foal to Divine Park. He only paid \$17,000 for her, and was able to sell her just three years later for \$100,000 to Clarkland Farm. In that time she produced winner Refer (Divine Park), Imply, and the Lonhro (Aus) filly Advert, also a stakes winner. Allude has gone on to have five winners from eight starters, with three stakes winners including her 2010 Divine Park filly Dancinginthecircle.

"The people who bought Allude are able to breed her to Curlin and Into Mischief," Karp said of Clarkland Farm. "And I still have Advert."

Ultimately selling Imply while retaining Advert as a broodmare would be bittersweet for Karp, who is extremely fond of the whole family. "All three stakes winners out of Allude are fillies," he said. But none is as special as Imply.

"Imply brings me to tears when I watch her. She's not the greatest horse that ever lived, but she sure tries hard. I've loved every minute of having bred and owned her."

Selling Imply would be difficult, but with Advert as a broodmare, Karp still has a member of the family. "You have to have a passion for this game," he said of both racing and breeding. "If you don't have the passion, then it is not something you want to get involved in."

Bronx Beauty's Third Win Gives Her Series Championship & \$110K

SEPTEMBER 28, 2019 - In a thrilling finish to the 2019 MATCH Series, 2W Racing's BRONX BEAUTY fought off MS LOCUST POINT after a long duel in the \$100,000 Regret Stakes at Monmouth Park Sept. 28 and won not only her division but the overall championship, which required a tie-breaker.

BRONX BEAUTY (above), trained by Anthony Margotta Jr., and Jim Reichenberg and Cash is King's MS LOCUST POINT, trained by John Servis, each ended the series with 40 points. The first tie-breaker is most wins in a division, and BRONX BEAUTY had three to one for MS LOCUST POINT.

The pair put on great shows in three stakes in the Filly and Mare Sprint—Dirt Division: BRONX BEAUTY on the Penn Ladies Dash at Hollywood Casino at Penn National Race Course and Dashing Beauty Stakes at Delaware Park along with the Regret and each time MS LOCUST POINT was a close second.

"It was a fairytale ending," Monmouth-based Margotta said. "This is a tremendous accomplishment and I'm so proud of my team. They work hard and deliver under pressure, and BRONX BEAUTY has the heart. Some horses just have that determination.""The races we've had with our horse and MS LOCUST POINT are the kind that can bring



people back to the game," said Richard Woll, the principal of 2W Racing and a New Jersey resident. "It was oh so exciting."

BRONX BEAUTY, a 4-year-old Pennsylvania-bred filly by Liaison, was reluctant to enter the gate for the six-furlong Regret but emerged with the rail from post 2 and was just behind Ms Locust Point, who fired out from post 8. Bronx Beauty gradually edged away to a half-length lead over her nemesis, and won by a length under Paco Lopez. MS LOCUST POINT amely held second over Steve and Debbie Jackson's LAST TRUE LOVE in third.

BRONX BEAUTY, second choice in the race behind New York shipper Satisfy, paid \$5.40 to win and covered the distance in 1:10.39 on a track rated fast. It was the eighth win—seven



of them stakes—for the filly bred by Blackstone Farm.

The overall MATCH Series championship is worth \$50,000 to the winning owner and \$25,000 to the winning trainer. They also receive \$20,000 and \$15,000 for the division title for a total of \$110,000.

BRONX BEAUTY's breeder will get a \$5,000 bonus from the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association for being the Pennsylvania-bred filly or mare with the most points in the series.

Margotta had said BRONX BEAUTY was playing catchup with MS LOCUST POINT, who started in all five division legs. The filly missed the first leg at Laurel Park, but made up for it with three victories.

"We we're cautiously optimistic we could win it," Margotta said. "Richard's grandson had it all figured out. He was keeping track of the points and what the outcomes could be."

Woll's grandson, Matthew Ciamei, was on hand at Monmouth. "This has been great," he said. The racing has been fantastic, and going to the different tracks in the series has been fun. It's a really good series."

In their previous meeting in the Roamin Rachel Stakes at Parx Racing, BRONX BEAUTY was third and MS LOCUST POINT fifth. Margotta said his filly was compromised by her inside post.

"At Monmouth, the rail and the inside isn't bad but at Parx it can be," the trainer said. "Paco is going to be a Hall of Fame rider, and I just let him play the break. I think BRONX BEAUTY speaks for herself. How many different racetracks has she run on, and how many different riders has she had? This is tremendous."

The rescheduled Mark McDermott on October 16 at PID, the Blue Mountain for fillies at Penn National on November 27 and the Nursery at PARX on December 7. I can't wait to see the new crop. Maybe we'll see a PA-Bred in the winners circle the first Saturday in May!

Please remember, for the foal crop of 2020, broodmares must be in the state by Dec. 1, 2019, or within 14 days of a public sale or breed back to a PA-Sire. We ask that you submit all broodmare domicile forms online which will be available on the end of October. You can access the online submission at www. pabred. com/forms. If you cannot submit online, please call our office to make other arrangements. Please do not use an old form as they are changing this year. Mares bred to registered PA-Sires are up again this year, according to our preliminary count, and we're just waiting for the official numbers from the Jockey Club to confirm a fantastic PA increase.

Our annual Stallion Directory will be published in December. Please note that all information and directory pages will be due back in our office by Oct. 18, 2019. Online registration is coming soon and we'll let you know when it's ready to launch. Go Pa!!



Beginning with the crop of 2020, the domicile report must be on file when you register your foal. At the time of registration, the PHBA will verify



that the domicile report is on file and was submitted timely.

Please do not use any old forms. The new form will be accessible on our website at the end of october. We are requesting that it be submitted online only. If it is imperative that you need a paper copy, please call our office to have one mailed to you.

OBITUARIES: LOUIS "PADDY" NEILSON III

Legendary horseman Louis "Paddy" Neilson III died Thursday, September 5 at the age of 77. He was the husband of Toinette Phillips Neilson, with whom he shared 31 years of marriage.

Known best for his prowess in the horse world, he began riding at age six, rode his first race at 14 and won Maryland's Grand National at 15. And, that was just the beginning. He was a corporate bond broker for Alex. Brown & Sons in Philadelphia for years while foxhunting, galloping race horses and riding races on the side. He retired from racing for 9 years, but was drawn back in for one ride, but stayed in after the stock market crash in 1987. He left his desk to devote himself to training horses fulltime at his Rockaway Farm in Chatham with Toinette.

He was renowned for winning races in four decades, including riding the daunting Maryland Hunt Cup race 21 times and winning it three times in three decades. For 10 years he was the leading amateur steeplechase jockey in North America. A passionate foxhunter, Paddy hunted with Mr. Stewart's Cheshire Foxhounds since childhood and devotedly served as full-time amateur Whipper-in for the last 13 years, jumping his last fence in the line of duty just a couple of weeks before his death.

He served as Master of Foxhounds, alongside his daughter Sanna, and chaired Cheshire's most successful Point-to-Point Races earlier this year. Paddy was proud to have chaired the Pennsylvania Hunt Cup Races for 17 years, and later the Plumsted Races for 11. Over the course of those 11 years the Plumsted Races benefited the nearby Chatham Acres senior citizens home, giving a huge boost to its program. Additionally, Paddy was a founding board member of the American Steeplechase Injured Jockeys' Fund and on the original committee that began the Winterthur Point-to-Point.

Always on display was Paddy's pride in and great love for his wife Toinette and his daughters Kathy, Sanna, Liza, Daphne and Emily and grandchildren Skylar, Parker, Nina, Natalie, Max, Pell, Perry, Izzie, Burr, Nell and Beasie. He is also survived by his brother Cook Neilson and sisters Madeline Rockwell and Carol Neilson.

A Celebration of Paddy's Life will be held Friday, October 4th at 2 PM on the kennel lawn of Mr. Stewart's Cheshire Foxhounds at 1549 West Doe Run Road, Coatesville, PA. 19320.



JAMES COURTNEY

James M. Courtney, Jr., passed away on Saturday, August 31, 2019. The former Monkton resident was 88.

Jim graduated from Seton Hall Prep then received a BS in chemical engineering at Seton Hall University in 1952 and an MBA at Rutgers University in 1962. He was employed in the specialty chemical industry his entire career. Jim started his own company, Courtney Industries Inc. in 1978. He then moved the company to Baltimore and his family to Glen Arm, MD. In 1994, Jim retired and sold his company.

In his retirement he fulfilled his lifelong passion for thoroughbred racing. Establishing his own stable in Monkton, he began breeding, training, and racing thoroughbreds. With more than thirty horses running throughout the East Coast from 2000 to present, his horses were first place winners in 68 races and placed in an additional 121. Jim was a Multiple Graded Stakes Placed Owner.

Jim's top 5 horses as breeder and owner are PA-Breds, including MGSP Power of Snunner, earner of \$638,685. He was also a member of the MD Horse Breeders Association, MD Thoroughbred Horseman's Association, and the PA Horse Breeders Association.

The Blackstone Farm bred Ledecka captured the \$100,000 Malvern Rose Stakes by a ½ length in her stakes debut at Presque Isle Downs. Ledecka covered the mile distance over the synthetic in 1:38.64 against eight 3 year old filly rivals. Trained by Fair Hill based Arnaud Delacour, and owned by LNJ Foxwoods, the 3 year old Tiznow filly - out of Slews Golden Rule - has career earnings of \$111,600 in only 5 lifetime starts. Redeem my Heart was 2nd, with Key Light finishing 3rd.

PA-Bred Stakes Recaps

Plum Pretty Stakes, Sept. 21, Parx WMT Stable's Trace of Grace held off a late inside run from her stablemate Trolley Ride to capture the \$100,000 Plum Pretty Stakes going 1 1/16 on the dirt at Parx Racing for trainer Bernie Houghton. Bred, owned and trained by Houghton who is Penn National based, she also won the Plum Pretty Stakes in 2016. Trace of Grace was named after Houghton's 7 year old son, Trace, who was in attendance for her special stakes win on the PA Derby undercard. The PA-Sired/PA-Bred 6 year old Petionville mare now has career earnings of \$481,552. Houghton trained Trolley Ride was 2nd with Mill and Gloria finishing 3rd.





Alphabet Soup Stakes, Sept. 21, Parx 8 year old Pumpkin Rumble wins the \$100,000 Alphabet Soup Stakes just getting up and setting a new course record time of 1:40.21 for the 1 1/16 over firm turf. The 6/5 favorite in a field of 7 PA-Breds improved his record to 10-for-45. Trained by the Woodbine based Kevin Attard, and owned by the father and son team of Al and Bill Ulwelling, the GSW son of English Channel bred by Daniel Ryan's Smart Angle now has career earnings of \$633,777. Saratoga Jack finished second 2 lengths ahead of Taxable Goods who was 3rd. Mrs. Henry D. Paxson Stakes, Sept. 23, PID Weed Wacker stalked the pace, then pulled away in the stretch to win the \$100,000 Mrs. Henry D. Paxson Memorial Stakes at Presque Isle Downs. Walber Alencar piloted the 2 year old Artie Schiller filly to a 3 ¼ length score in the six furlong test for 2 year old fillies in a running time of 1:10.92. Weed Wacker, who had won her only previous start before tackling stakes company, is owned by her breeder, Triple Threat Stables LLC, and is conditioned by PID based trainer Lance Stokes. Post time favorite Lula's Roadrunner was 2nd with Leaky Cauldron holding on for 3rd in a field of eight.


