History and family key to Houghton success

To get everything done himself, Bernie Houghton would need several more hours added to each day. Luckily for him, Houghton doesn't have to handle his sprawling Pennsylvania farm and string of runners at Penn National all on his own.

His family's Sylmar Farm is a 300-acre spread housing around 200 Thoroughbreds at any given time. "My parents started it," Houghton explained. "My father passed away last year, but my mother still runs everything. I do the training. My wife takes care of the broodmares. My brother farms. The whole family helps out."

The sport has long been in Houghton's blood; he rode steeplechase races for 10 years, and was a leading rider in 1985 before he ultimately quit to start training at Delaware Park. Houghton noted he had, "a hard time making it," so when trainer Barclay Tagg asked him to come on as an assistant, Houghton jumped at the chance.

"That changed everything," he said, heading to Maryland to help Tagg with a string of horses. "I did that for a year, then worked in the racing office for 10 years. I was a patrol judge. I was horse identification. All that kind of stuff."

In 2000, Houghton's father was slowing down and no longer interested in training the young horses on the farm. Houghton made

one last career move, and has been satisfied ever since, settling in on the family farm with a family of his own. He has 45 head in training at Penn National, and drives an hour each way at least five days a week to watch the horses train with the help of a standout assistant and some stellar barn staff. Then it's back to the

farm, where there is a training track, two exercise machines, and five barns to tend.

"We leg up horses and break yearlings," Houghton said. "We have 38 mares on the farm, but they aren't all ours. My mother has 15, my wife and I have five. The rest are client mares."

Houghton has a certain affinity for mares, as many of his best racehorses have been female. Imply, who is owned by Larry Karp's Barlar LLC, has earned \$771,228, while Trace of Grace is marching towards a milestone with \$481,552 in earnings.

Pennsylvania-bred Imply has won 12 of 29 starts and is 4-for-5 this year. The daughter of E Dubai—Allude, by Orientate, is a seven-time stakes winner, including two editions of the \$100,000 Lyphard Stakes and more recently the \$100,000 Mrs. Penny Stakes. She had a four-race win streak recently snapped when trying to defend her titles in the Plum Pretty Stakes at Parx Sept. 21, losing to her stablemate Trace of Grace.

"I don't want to sound biased,"
Houghton said, "but Trace of Grace is
my favorite." He and his wife bred the
daughter of Petionvile under the banner of

their WMT Stables, and still own her while Houghton himself trains. Trace of Grace has won eight of 35 starts with 23 top-three efforts, including two wins to date in 2019. She also won the Plum Pretty back in 2016, which was her very first stakes score.

"She's been a great mare for us," Houghton said. "She's done everything we could ask of her." He admits that Imply, "is probably the better of the two fillies," but is fond of them in a way reminiscent of having children. Both horses were raised on the farm.

Another favorite is the Maryland-bred filly Crabcakes, by Great Notion. She won nine of 17 starts, including consecutive editions of the Maryland Million Distaff, after taking the Maryland Juvenile Filly Championship at 2. Crabcakes earned \$419.532.

"It does seem like it's all fillies,"
Houghton admitted, noting that he also
won three stakes races with Karp's
Pennsylvania-bred Jump Start daughter
Bound, and another stakes with Advert,
Imply's half-sister by Lonhro (Aus). There
have been colts and geldings, too, such
as the multiple stakes-placed Saco River,

by Patton, and the graded stakes-placed Uptown Boy, by Johannesburg, but 10 of his top 13 runners to date have been fillies and mares.

Houghton is closing in on 700 career victories as a trainer, and has lifetime earnings over \$18.6 million. This season alone he has 45 wins (through mid-October), which comes two years after a banner 2017 where he won 78 races for earnings over \$2 million.

But the affable Houghton couldn't do it alone. "I have great assistants and help at the track," he said. "This is a big farm to run. And I've got my three kids running around the place, as well."

Breeding and racing in Pennsylvania has all but ensured the family's continued success. "Pennsylvania racing has paid for this farm," Houghton said. "I have a 20-acre place myself where I just built a barn, and horses like Trace of Grace have literally paid for that. I can't say anything bad about racing here in Pennsylvania. It's the best program going for sure. We wouldn't even consider another state. We're just happy with Pennsylvania."

Congrats to Blackstone Farm, who received a \$5,000 bonus from the PHBA for being the breeders of Bronx Beauty, not only the top PA-Bred female in the just-completed MATCH Series, but the overall winner of the series! The 4-year-old by Liaison won the Filly & Mare Sprint — Dirt Division and the MATCH Series title by a tie-breaker with Ms. Locust Point. Each finishing with 40 points, Bronx Beauty was crowned champion after having more wins than her rival. MATCH was a big success in 2019. We're already looking forward to 2020!

As we come to the last two months of the year, it's time to showcase our PA-Bred 2-year-olds. The Blue Mountain Juvenile for the fillies will be held Nov. 27 at Penn National and the Pennsylvania Nursery is scheduled for Dec. 7. One of the great things about this business is that you never know what's going to happen with the new crops. Can't wait to see them run!

Please remember, for the foal crop of 2020, broodmares must be in the state by Dec. 1, 2019, or within 14 days of a public sale or breed back to a PA-Sire. We ask that

you submit all broodmare domicile forms online. You can access the online submission at

www.pabred.com/forms. If you cannot submit online, please call our office to make other arrangements. Please do not use an old form as they are changing this year.
