PA Horsemen Loving PA-Bred Racing Program

Thirty years ago, a 4-year-old horse who has earned six figures would have been a multiple stakes winner. In 2020 that is far from the case, especially when that horse's connections can confidently place him in races that offer bonuses like the lucrative Pennsylvania-Bred program.

Word On a Wing is a prime example, earning \$156,950 despite never having contested a stakes race in eight career starts.

The PA-Bred son of young sire Winchill has practically never finished off the board in eight starts, with only a disqualification last fall. Throw that race out, and Word On a Wing has a record of 7-5-1-1 and average earnings per start of over \$22,000. The gelding notched his first career victory by 16½ lengths in a maiden special weight in February 2019. He also captured his first PA-Bred allowance condition, first open allowance, second open allowance and second PA-Bred allowance--an incredible average of nearly 6½ lengths per win. Those last two victories have come since Parx Racing reopened after the COVID-19 shutdown.

"As Pennsylvania breeders, we like to support the Pennsylvania program so you try to at least get your conditions," notes trainer Kate DeMasi. "As far as running out of state [in stakes races], I don't think there's a big incentive. You're going to probably run against tougher horses and as a breeder you're not going to get anything in terms of your bonus money."

Word On a Wing was a welcome face when he arrived at Parx last year. He is a third-generation member of the DeMasi barn on his mother's side and DeMasi also trained his father, Winchill. His maternal grandmother Merry Princess was a three-time stakes winner in the early 2000s and

while his dam Merry's Pegasus, a daughter of Fusaichi Pegasus, won but one race (at Atlantic City in 2009), she has more than made up for it in producing Word On a Wing.

"My groom rubbed the mother and Winchill so he rubbed both parents," says DeMasi. "He's really a combination of horses that we've had over the years. It's really very exciting to see him develop into the horse that he is. [Merry's Pegasus] foaled a full sibling this year."

Merry's Pegasus' first foal Merry Giant (by Red Giant) won three races and her filly Tarafirma (by Any Given Saturday) won four including a first-level open allowance on the turf at Penn National. DeMasi has continued working on Tarafirma's second allowance condition this year. But that 2020 full brother to Word On a Wing certainly carries the highest hopes for Pewter Stable.

"I think overall Winchill is doing really well," says DeMasi proudly. "[His babies] come to hand quickly enough but I think that they benefit from a bit more maturity to them. They're smart and overall they're fairly correct-looking individuals. I think that his babies tend to favor the mothers a little bit in terms of the looks. So if you've got a big,

rangy mare you're probably going to get a big, rangy baby."

While Word On a Wing has stayed in sprint races on the dirt, his female family is primarily turf and DeMasi is curious if the gelding would handle added ground.

"[Winchill's first winner] You Must Chill actually won [on the grass] on the west coast and then won the PA-Bred allowance on the dirt right before we went on the break with COVID. He's the only one I know of that runs long. I haven't had any myself yet that I would say are routers, although I wonder if Word On a Wing would do both. But it's kind of like, if it ain't broke don't fix it. I'm a little hesitant to go hunting grass for him when he's just fine on dirt."

Other Pennsylvania horsemen have taken full advantage of the PA-Bred racing program. Wendy Mutnik's homebred Final Shot is a leader in the Parx standings this season with two allowance wins and earnings of over \$76,000. And in January, Bobby Mosco claimed Admiral Abe for \$25,000 for Stefcon Racing, then just before the shutdown in March snuck in his first open allowance victory, ironically just ahead of Final Shot. Admiral Abe also has two 2020 wins and boasts earnings of \$77,255.

"I think the PA-Bred program is great," says fellow Parx trainer Ed Coletti Jr., who

conditions recent Iroquois Award winners Midtowncharlybrown (\$496,548), Midnightcharly (\$354,308) and Dixie Serenade (\$339,485). "It helps the breeder as well as a person who just likes to own horses. The ability to be able to win a PA-Bred 1xmc ['A-Other-Than'], then if the horse is good enough win the open 1xmc, then do it again in the PA 2xmc and open 2xmc is so helpful for people to be able to recoup some of their investment, plus hopefully pay the bills on the horse."

It also helps to have a quality horse with plenty of potential and talent. Word On a Wing certainly has just that and according to DeMasi he has shown that ability and work ethic from the very beginning. However with her lifetime of experience she knows better than to get too excited too early.

"I've always been a believer that you've got to let them take you where they need to go," she notes. "What they do in the morning is different than what they show in the afternoon. The proof is always in the pudding when they get to racing. But I think we always thought that he was talented but you never know what they're going to be until you get them up against the competition. But he kept stepping up to the plate every time."

As a reminder, Broodmare Domicile Reports are due to the PHBA by Dec. 1. Broodmares must be in the state by Dec. 1, or within 14 days of a public sale (60 days if sale outside the US). If you're breeding back to a registered PA stallion, you must complete the domicile report within 14 days of entering the state
