PHBA: TOBA Breeder of the Year - Larry Karp

"I'm just not that big of a deal," Larry Karp insists. "I'm just a little guy with a couple of mares."

Whether or not his assessment is correct, Karp has done something right, as the 77-year-old has been named not only the Thoroughbred Owner and Breeders Association's State Breeder of the Year for Pennsylvania, but also the National Small Breeder of the Year.

"I wasn't surprised about getting it for Pennsylvania," he admitted,

"because my mare and her foal [Grade 1 winner Mirth] took all the awards here — I got five awards from the state this year. But to get it nationally really blew me away."

The mare in question is Di's Delight, who Karp's Barlar LLC purchased for \$55,000 in 2011.

"So much of what you do in this sport is fate," Karp said. "I bought Di's Delight nine years ago at Keeneland November, and she did okay! She threw runners, winners, whatever, but nothing special until Mirth."

He went on to note that the story of Pennsylvania-bred Mirth had its own fairytale twist. "I had a dilemma on who to breed Di's Delight to one year. Carl McEntee, who is my bloodstock guy, was the bloodstock manager at Darby Dan Farm in Kentucky. He told me his boss had a season to Colonel John, and why don't we do a mare share? I put up the mare, he put up the stud, and then you sell the mare at Keeneland and split it. I thought that was a good idea, because Colonel John stood for \$15,000 and I thought he fit well with my mare."

Di's Delight got pregnant, and Karp figured she would sell for the typically formulated two and a half times the stud fee. "I thought she'd go between \$35,000 and \$40,000," he said. "I'm watching the sale, listening with Carl, and it stalled at \$19,000. So, I blurted out, 'Look, if it doesn't get past \$22,000, I'll take her back!'"

Di's Delight hammered at \$23,000, with Karp having to pay \$11,500 to get out of the partnership. "It was less than the stud fee, and I ended up with Mirth," he said. "And if I hadn't kept Di's Delight, I wouldn't have Vault. Talk about fate playing a part."

Mirth won six of 18 starts with four seconds and two thirds. Her signature score came in the \$300,000 Rodeo Drive Stakes-G1 at Santa Anita in 2019, one month before she gave owners Little Red Feather Racing a thrill by leading the field in the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf-G1 before tiring to sixth. Mirth is now in foal to Constitution, and will be offered for sale this fall.

While Mirth may have gotten away, Karp still has a percentage of Vault. Born one year after Mirth in 2016, Vault has won five of 17 starts with 10 top-two finishes, for earnings of \$224,914. The daughter of Pennsylvania legend Jump Start won the Thirty Eight Go Go Stakes

at Laurel Park last year, set a track record at Penn National, has two stakes-placings this year and remains in training through the end of 2021.

For someone who is meant to have a small broodmare band, Karp finds himself with eight broodmares, all of whom are pregnant. "I wanted four, five at the most," he joked. "I've been trying to get the operation to the right size."

In the band is Di's Delight, who is 20 years old. "We're getting to the

end," Karp admitted regarding Di's Delight's age. "She's in foal to Midshipman, and I'm almost for sure going to have her foal in Pennsylvania. What happens after that is in Mother Nature's hands."

Karp also has homebred Imply, a Pennsylvania-bred who earned \$772,728. "She's a special case, in that I could have sold her at Keeneland for a substantial amount of money, but I decided to breed her commercially and have the option of keeping her foals, or racing them." Imply is carrying her first foal, by \$40,000 sire Hard Spun.

Although he keeps trying to pare down the operation, Karp purchased the Dansili (GB) mare Cycle (GB) from England and has bred her to dual Grade 1-winner Brody's Cause. "I happened to own a lifetime breeding right to Brody's Cause," he explained. "He has been a surprising first-year stallion with four stakes horses and a Grade 3 winner out of a small group."

Brody's Cause isn't the only stallion Karp is invested in; he owns Maryland stallion Alliance, an unraced half-brother to champion Tepin. "Half of my mares are in foal to Alliance," he said. "The other half are in foal to Kentucky stallions."

The ability to foal them in Pennsylvania is part of the appeal. "I don't have anything to look forward to anymore, what with Covid," Karp said. "I haven't left my house in six months. So, I was very grateful for the award from TOBA. I will continue to breed horses for the programs in Pennsylvania and Maryland, because they don't have to be superstars and they still earn money. Over the years I've bred six or seven stakes winners myself, and not one of them was by a stallion that cost more than \$10,000."

Karp was gratified to see his team rewarded for their efforts. "I've been with Carl for 10 or 12 years, and the guy that breaks my horses and gets them started is someone I've been with 35 years. I've only had three trainers over 36 years. It's a small group of people who have supported me, and I'm grateful to every one of them."

Although pleased, receiving the award still baffles Karp. "I don't know how I got to be the national guy; it's just mind boggling. But it's been fun and I will continue with the program to the extent that I can."

PA STALLIONS BRED MORE MARES IN 2020 FOR HIGHEST INCREASE IN NATION

The busiest stallions in Pennsylvania in 2019 topped the the state's Report of Mares Bred list for 2020, and led the way as the total number of mares bred in the state rose 7 percent (734 to 686) based on RMBs received by The Jockey Club at this time a year ago. The increase was the biggest among the top-10 states, in which Pennsylvania ranks seventh.

According to The Jockey Club's Report of Mares Bred (RMB) statistics through Oct. 18, 2020, this year 37 Pennsylvania stallions were in action. Northview PA's second-year stallion Hoppertunity covered more than 100 mares for a second time, as the \$4.5 million-earner bred a total of 107 (in his first year he covered 129). WynOak Farm's popular Warrior's Reward, ranked as the Mid-Atlantic region's leading active sire of 2019 and again this year, covered 95 mares.



PA-BRED YEARLING TOPS FASIG-TIPTON MIDLANTIC SALE

A Gun Runner colt bred in Pennsylvania by Jon A. Marshall checked all the boxes and brought a final bid of \$270,000 from Lambe Bloodstock to top 379 sold at the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Fall Yearlings sale held Oct. 5 and 6 in Timonium. Md.

Out of Stormy Tak, a daugher of Stormy Atlantic and the topclass multiple Grade 1-winning sprinter Lady Tak, the chestnut colt is a half-brother to three winners. Lady Tak earned \$1,160,782 while winning the Test and Ballerina, both Grade 1 sprints at Sarato-

ga, and five other stakes. The family also includes Volatile, out of Stormy Tak's stakes-winning sister Melody Lady. Volatile has won five times (plus a second) in six starts, including this year's Grade 1 Alfred G. Vanderbilt Handicap at six furlongs.

The colt is one of three foals bred in Pennsylvania by Marshall out of Stormy Tak, the first her current 2-year-old filly by Point of Entry named Tak E Lady who is unplaced in two starts, and a colt by Cross Traffic foaled this past May. The Gun Runner yearling, sold through the consignment of Becky Davis Inc., went to the sale as Delaware certified, Virginia certified, Breeders' Cup nominated and a registered Pennsylvania-bred.

A total of 72 Pennsylvania-breds sold at the Midlantic sale for an average of \$24,647. Two others brought \$135,000 each — a filly by Declaration of War out of the Unbridled's Song mare Newstouse, and a colt by Kantharos out of Fleetheart, by Northern Afleet.

The Declaration of War filly is a half-sister to two-time stakes winner and 2019 PA-Bred champion 2-year-old colt Newstome. Her third dam is Eclipse Award winner Hollywood Wildcat, dam of Breeders' Cup winner and sire War Chant and five other stakes performers, including the filly's stakes-winning second dam Double Cat. Bred by Equivine Farm and consigned by Paramount Sales, the filly was purchased by BSW/Crow bloodstock agency.

Dr. S. Mark Rayburg bred the Kantharos colt; Tonja Terranova Agent made the purchase. Consigned by Heart Hill Farms, agent,



the chestnut colt is out of stakesplaced Fleetheart, a full sister to stakes winner Afleet Angel and stakes-placed Guardianofthenorth, and half-sister to stakes winner Guardianofthegate and stakesplaced La Nina Dancer, from the family of Grade 1 winner M One Rifle and numerous graded winners including Adorable Micol, Palliser Bay and He Loves Me.

Pennsylvania sires represented included Uncle Lino, the sire of 12 sold for \$308,000 (an average of \$25,667) including a \$75,000

PA-Bred half-brother to multiple graded stakes winner and PA-Bred champion Call Paul and multiple stakes winner Pink Caddy.

WynOak Farm's Weigelia had eight sell for \$135,500, led by a \$52,000 full sister to stakes winners Fat Kat and Smooth B and stakes-placed Disco Rose and Pink Princess.

A dozen Peace and Justice yearlings sold for \$122,700. His top price was a \$31,000 colt from the family of Kentucky Oaks-G1 winner Cathryn Sophia.

Fasig-Tipton Kentucky October Yearlings

The top price of 13 PA-Breds sold at Fasig-Tipton's Kentucky sale from Oct. 26-29 in Lexington was a \$200,000 Constitution filly bred Roberta L. Schneider MD.

The filly went through this year's Keeneland January sale as a short yearling, selling for \$165,000. She was a \$150,000 RNA at Fasig-Tipton's Selected Yearlings Showcase in September, but attracted the attention of Shepherd Equine Advisors, agent for buyers Sanders and Hirsch at the October sale. She is the fifth foal out of Distinct Sparkle, a daughter of With Distinction whose first two foals to race are six-figure earners. Third dam Constant Change is a stakes-placed half-sister to Breeders' Cup Sprint-G1 winner Very Subtle.

The sales average for the PA-Breds at the October sale was \$36,115.

PEACE AND JUSTICE FIRST STAKES WINNER PROVIDES WINDFALL FOR BREEDER GLENN BROK

The 2-year-old Pennsylvania-bred gelding Like a Saltshaker hit a homerun at Presque Isle Downs Oct. 12 when taking \$75,000 Fitz Dixon Jr. Memorial Stakes against open company. Not only did he get his first stakes win for owner Magic Oaks and trainer Adam Rice, he earned a \$250,000 bonus for his breeder Glenn Brok as the first open stakes winner for his sire Peace and Justice.

The first foal out of the winning Harlan's Holiday mare With Sprinkles, Like a Saltshaker was foaled at Brok's Diamond B Farm in Mohrsville, where Steve Young's Peace and Justice stood his first seaosn in 2017. Young wanted breeders to take his speedy son of War Front seriously, and promoted his stallion the first two years by offering the quarter-million-dollar incentive, which remains on the table for Peace and Justice's 2-year-olds of 2021.

The first winner for his sire when breaking his maiden in late September, Like a Saltshaker rated close to the pace in the 6 1/2-furlong Dixon until taking aim on the leaders in the stretch, spliting rivals and going on to win by three-quarters of a length. He returned on Oct. 31 to face open company once again, shipping out of state for the first time for Belmont Park's Awad Stakes on the turf.

He shot to the lead in midstretch of the mile and a sixteenth stakes contested over a yielding turf, but got caught in deep stretch and finished second by a half length. In his four starts, Like a Saltshaker has earned \$91,030.

Peace and Justice covered 38 mares his first season. There are less than 20 first-crop 2-year-olds in training. For the past three years Peace and Justice has stood at Northview PA in Peach Bottom, breeding significantly more numbers. Young is still considering options of where to stand the 10-year-old stallion next year, but would prefer to keep him in Pennsylvania.

A top-notch miler at the track, Peace and Justice was won turf allowances at Belmont Park and Santa Anita in fast times. In his two California wins he ran the mile in 1:32.36 and 1:33.27.

His dam, the Smart Strike mare Strike the Sky, also has produced graded stakes winner Hudson Steele, an earner of \$513,824, as well as stakes-placed graded stakes producer Lauren Byrd. The family traces directly back to champion What a Treat, dam of group winner and sire Be My Guest.

TOP SOPHOMORE SIRE WICKED STRONG TO PIN OAK LANE FARM

Millionaire Wicked Strong has moved to Dr. William Solomon's Pin Oak Lane Farm in New Freedom, Pa., to stand the 2021 season. The 9-year-old syndicated stallion, who previously stood at Spendthrift Farm in Lexington, Ky., will stand for \$3,500, payable when the foal stands and nurses.

"He's by far the leading second-crop sire in the Mid-Atlantic region," said Solomon of Wicked Strong, who ranks fourth among

the region's active sires on the general list in 2020 with nearly \$2 million in progeny earnings. "And he comes with 154 2-year-olds and yearlings, so I think his chances of succeeding are good for that reason. He also has nine stakes horses in his first two crops to race. All these things make him one of the most attractive sires in the Mid-Atlantic."

A top-10 freshman sire nationally in

2019 by progeny earnings, Wicked Strong ranked second by number of winners with 26, one less than American Pharoah, Constitution and Tapiture. Among his first crop runners, now 3, are Evil Lyn, winner of Pimlico's Hilltop Stakes in October, and Wicked Runner, a stakes winner at 2 and 3 in Puerto Rico. In his second crop he has sired Belmont Park stakes winner Brooklyn Strong, recent winner of the Sleepy Hollow Stakes and second in the Bertram F. Bongard Stakes in three starts. Of Wicked Strong's nine black-type horses, six earned black-type at 2.

One of the top runners of his generation, Wicked Strong won the \$1 million Wood Memorial Stakes-G1 in stakes-record time and

captured Saratoga's Jim Dandy Stakes-G2 over Belmont Stakes-G1 winner Tonalist.

Graded stakes-placed at 2 when third behind Honor Code in the Grade 2 Remsen, he was second by a nose to his stablemate V. E. Day the next summer in the Travers Stakes-G1. He turned in strong showings in the 2014 classics, finishing fourth after a tough trip in the Kentucky Derby-G1 won by California Chrome, and

getting up to dead heat with California Chrome for fourth in the Belmont Stakes-G1 while finishing less than two lengths behind Tonalist.

Wicked Strong competed in 14 consecutive stakes at 3 and 4, 10 of them Grade 1. During his 4-year-old season, he had four stakes-placings, including a second to Tonalist in the Club Gold Jockey Cup-G1 and a third behind Liam's Map in the Woodward Stakes-G1,



and concluded his 19-start career with a fourth in the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile-G1 won by Liam's Map. He is the richest son of top sire Hard Spun to stand at stud, with a record of 3-4-3 for earnings of \$1,994,460.

Wicked Strong has a pedigree with strong classic lines. His winning dam Moyne Abbey is by Kentucky Derby/Preakness winner Charismatic, who in turn is by Preakness winner Summer Squall. His family is filled with graded stakes winners including two-time Grade 1-winning millionaire Student Council; his dam is a half-sister to graded winners and Grade 1-placed Gulch Approval and Rusty Slipper as well as stakes winner and graded-placed Approval Rating.

PAT ON THE BACK TO STAND AT GODSTONE FARM



Millionaire and top miler Pat On the Back has been added to the Godstone Farm roster in Littlestown, Pa. The property of a partnership, the 6-year-old will stand his first season in 2021 for \$3,500 live foal, with special consideration to approved mares.

An eight-time stakes winner, Pat On the Back recorded nine wins in 30 starts, with four seconds and six thirds (all stakes), while amassing \$1,144,545. He is the richest son of Congrats, one of the nation's top sires, to enter stud. A son of A.P. Indy, Congrats is the sire of 45 stakes winners, three millionaires.

Pat On the Back had his biggest season in 2019, capturing Belmont Park's one-mile Kelso Handicap-G2 in 1:33.97, as well as the Affirmed Success and Commentator Stakes, the latter in 1:33.43 for the mile. A stakes winner every year from 2 to 5, from

six furlongs to a mile and an eighth, he recorded rich scores in the \$300,000 Empire Classic Handicap at 4 and the \$250,000 Sleepy Hollow at 2.

Pat On the Back is one of eight winners from eight starters for the Awesome Again mare Accomplished, also the dam of stakes winner and producer Sarah Accomplished. His second dam, the winning Copelan mare I'm in Celebration, produced 10 winners including stakes winners Nice to Know (19 wins, \$421,556) and Cheers and Tears, both graded stakes-placed, as well as graded stakes-placed Brave Victory. Others found in the family include Grade 1 winner and sire Is Your Pleasure, Group 1 winner Little Baby Bear and graded stakes winner and track record setter Beautiful Bets.

2020 PA-Bred Stakes Recaps



After a stakes-packed card on PA Day At the Races Day and two offerings at Presque Isle Downs, the 2020 stakes schedule concludes with PA-Bred stakes for 2-year-olds at Penn National and Parx Racing.

Hard Spun Stakes

In four starts since returning to the races in July, Wait for It has found his groove. He's won three times, twice in stakes, the most recent Presque Isle Downs' newlynamed Hard Spun on Oct. 21.

The Edward J. Coletti Jr. trainee was never far off the pace set by longshot Lawn Dart in the Hard Spun, moved up three-wide around the far turn and took aim on Missin the Big Dog, who took over the lead heading into the stretch. Wait for It responded like the 7-10 favorite he was, drawing off to win by two and a quarter lengths. Missin the Big Dog, at 13-1, held for second, with veteran stakes performer Fielder finishing third. Wait for It completed the mile and 70 yards in 1:41.21.

Owned by Uptowncharlybrown Stud LLC, the 5-year-old Uptowncharlybrown gelding was bred in the name of Fantasy Lane Stable. Stakes-placed at 3 when third in the Crowd Pleaser at Parx, Wait for It has won 10 of 25 career starts, but didn't get his first stakes win until the Storm Cat on the PA Day At the Races card two starts back. During his career he has shipped outside his home state four times, getting a win in al-

lowance company at Delaware this past July and finishing third over the Delaware oval in the DTHA Governors Day Handicap, sandwiched between his two stakes wins. Back in 2019 he finished a competitve fourth in the Grade 3 Pimlico Special at Pimlico. He's earned \$463,428 to date.

He's one of two winners for his dam Kimberley Diamond, a winning daughter of Posse who has seven consecutive foals by Uptowncharlybrown. The mare was bred back to Uptowncharlybrown for 2021.

Malvern Rose Stakes

Caravel boosted her record to four wins in five starts as the Liz Merryman-trained homebred dominated the Malvern Rose Stakes at Presque Isle Downs on Oct. 22.

The 3-year-old Mizzen Mast filly, who recorded her first stakes win in Presque Isle's Lady Erie Stakes in August, shot to the lead, turned back a bid by Madam Meena, and drew off from there, crossing the wire

nearly five lengths ahead of Remain Anonymous, who passed Madam Meena for second. After setting splits of :23.28, :45.85 and 1:09.15, Caravel's final time of 1:15.40 was less than a second off that of Canadian champion Ami's Mesa's time in winning the track's Masters Stakes in 2017.

A winner of her first two career starts at Penn National since June, Caravel's only blemish was a gritty third-place finish over a yielding turf course at Pimlico in the Hilltop Stakes on Preakness Day, Oct. 3 after getting the lead a quarter mile from home in the onemile stakes.

The filly is the first foal out of Zeezee Zoomzoom, a winning Congrats mare who has a 2-year-old filly by Bourbon Courage named Tipsy Chatter and a yearling colt by Great Notion. After foaling a colt by Holy Boss in April, she was bred back to Great Notion.
