

LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY

Remember, if you purchase a mare in foal at a public auction after Dec. 1, she must be brought into the state within 14 days of purchase through foaling (60 days if purchased at an overseas sale).



During the foaling year the foal or its dam must spend at least 90 days in the state in order for that foal to be eligible to become a registered PA-Bred. You can also bring in your mare anytime, stay 60 consecutive days through foaling and breed back to a PA-Sire. You can find that PA-Sire in our new 2021 Stallion and Boarding Farm Directory. It has been mailed out to all breeders and you can view it now at <u>pabred.com</u>.

Our 11th annual Stallion Auction on <u>thoroughlybred.com</u> will begin on Jan. 12 and end on Jan. 18 so you'll be able to bid on seasons from all over the country. Just go to our website to view the available seasons.

To help put the old year behind us, we felt a refresh of the Thoroughbred Report was due. New year, new look! Look for new features as the year rolls along, and remember to send us your foal photos! Here's to a fantastic 2021 and a Happy and Healthy New Year! Go Pa!!

WICKED STRONG JOINS PA STALLION ROSTER

Millionaire son of Hard Spun brings star power to PA

An exciting addition to the Pennsylvania stallion roster for the 2021 season is Grade 1-winning millionaire Wicked Strong, who will stand at Dr. William Solomon's Pin Oak Lane Farm in New Freedom, Pa.

The son of Hard Spun is being offered at \$3,500 live foal/stands and nurses, or \$3,000 for two mares. For three or more mares, the fee is \$2,500 to any Pin Oak Lane stallion.

Wicked Strong brings an outstanding race record and pedigree to Pennsylvania, and his progeny earnings immediately propel him to the top of the Mid-Atlantic second-crop sire list and fourth on the Mid-Atlantic leading sire list, with progeny earnings of more than \$2.4 million in 2020.

His 2-year-old son Brooklyn Strong became his first U.S. graded stakes winner Dec. 5 when he captured the Grade 2, \$150,000 Remsen Stakes at Aqueduct in impressive fashion; in his prior start Oct. 24 he won the \$150,000 Sleepy Hollow Stakes for New York-breds at Belmont Park. In total, Brooklyn Strong has won three of four starts, and \$195,000.

Brooklyn Strong's performance in the Remsen immediately sparked talk about his continuing on to the major 3-year-old races in 2021.

The Equibase chart footnote stated that he "clawed his way towards the [leader]" at the top of the lane in the 1½-mile test, then "appeared undeterred getting carried out a few paths by an errant Ten for Ten in midstretch," and finally "ground his way to the front end with gameness to get the job done."

"Any time you see a 2-year-old finish a race the way Brooklyn Strong did," said Dr. Solomon, "there's a good chance he has a bright future." "I think Wicked Strong will be a really good fit in Pennsylvania," said Mark Toothaker of Spendthrift Farm, where the stallion began his stud career. "He bred a lot of mares in his first three seasons, he's a very fertile horse, a very straightforward horse, and has outstanding conformation. I'm sure breeders in Pennsylvania will find a lot to like about him."

As a racehorse, Wicked Strong was considered among the best of his crop at ages 2, 3, and 4. He showed precocity by breaking his maiden in his second career start, a one-turn mile at Belmont Park, and placed in the Grade 3 Remsen Stakes behind Honor Code, who would go on to become a multiple Grade 1 winner, millionaire and champion.

Wicked Strong's 3-year-old season was highlighted by a 3½-length victory in the Grade 1, \$1 million Wood Memorial, in which he completed the 1½-mile distance in 1:49.31, at the time the fastest in nine years. He suffered a troubled trip in the Grade 1 Kentucky Derby, stumbling at the break, but still managed to finish fourth behind California Chrome.

Later that year, he captured the Grade 2 Jim Dandy Stakes by 2½ lengths over Grade 1 Belmont Stakes winner Tonalist, and followed that up with a strong effort in the Grade 1 Travers Stakes, in which he was beaten a nose by V.E. Day, with Tonalist third.

As a 4-year-old, Wicked Strong competed strictly in stakes competition, placing four times, including a second-place finish in the Grade 1 Jockey Club Gold Cup behind Tonalist. He retired with earnings of \$1,994,460.

Wicked Strong's pedigree has stamina influences on both top and bottom. His dam Moyne Abbey is by Horse of the Year Charismatic, winner of the Kentucky Derby and Preakness Stakes and third in the Belmont Stakes. Moyne Abbey is out of Classic Approval, by Canadian Triple Crown winner With Approval, and she is a half-sister to multiple graded stakes winner and turf miler Gulch Approval, as well as graded stakes-winning turf performer Rusty Slipper.

Wicked Strong's third dam, Grade 3 stakes winner Classic Value, by Copelan, produced multiple graded stakes winner Class Kris, who is the dam of multiple Grade 1 winner and millionaire Student Council. This is also the female family of Grade 1 winner Three Ring.

His sire Hard Spun, a Grade 1 winner of more than \$2.6 million, has proven success with Mr. Prospector-line mares. Among Hard Spun's best progeny with this cross is champion 3-year-old filly Questing, who is out of a Seeking the Gold mare. Other Mr. Prospector branches that Hard Spun has crossed well with are the Fappiano branch through Unbridled, Quiet American and Unbridled's Song; the Gone West branch through Mr. Greeley; and the Forty Niner branch through Distorted Humor.

Much like Hard Spun, Wicked Strong has crossed well with mares from branches of the Mr. Prospector line, especially Gone West. Two of Wicked Strong's stakes winners and three of his stakes-placed runners hail from mares of the Gone West branch.

Evil Lyn, winner of the Hilltop Stakes, is out of a mare by Mr. Greeley, a son of Gone West, while Wicked Runner, winner of the Grade 3 Clasico George Washington Stakes, is out of a mare by Mr. Greeley's son El Corredor. The dam of Myawaya, who placed in the Maddie May Stakes at Aqueduct, is also by Mr. Greeley.

Stakes-placed Strong Rules is out of a mare by Roman Ruler, a half-brother to El Corredor. Also, the dam of stakes-placed Villainous is by Strong Hope, a son of Grand Slam (by Gone West).

Wicked Strong's best progeny have also come through the El Prado (Ire) line, with Brooklyn Strong's dam being by Medaglia d'Oro, who is by El Prado. The dams of stakes-placed Telephone Talker and Queen-ofcatniphill were sired by Kitten's Joy, by El Prado.



ROWAYTON JOINS PA STALLION ROSTER

Rowayton will be the first son of Into Mischief to stand in the Mid-Atlantic region



Glenn and Becky Brok's Diamond B Farm in Mohrsville, Pa., is the first farm in the Mid-Atlantic region to stand a son of leading sire Into Mischief with the introduction of Grade 1-placed Rowayton for the 2021 season.

The bay 5-year-old will stand for an initial fee of \$5,000 live foal, as the property of Larry Best's OXO Equine LLC. An opportunity to earn a lifetime breeding right is also being offered to mare owners.

"We're extremely excited about standing Rowayton," said Glenn Brok. "Becky and I have always tried to upgrade the bloodlines available to Pennsylvania breeders, and we've been able to do that with their support. This is a big, beautiful horse, and I knew from the first time I saw him that I wanted him to stand at our farm."

"When I saw him at the sale, it was love at first sight," said Best.

Bred in Kentucky by H. Allen Poindexter, Rowayton was purchased by OXO Equine for \$320,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga select yearling sale from the Gainesway Farm consignment.

"When I saw him at the sale, it was love at first sight," said Best, who has made a splash the last several years owning such horses as Grade 1 winners Cambier Parc and Instilled Regard, and Grade 2 winner and young stallion Instagrand (a son of Into Mischief who stands at Taylor Made Stallions in Kentucky). "I couldn't fault him. He was stunning, and at the top of my list. I was thrilled when I was able to get him."

Last year, Best earned the New Owner of the Year Award, presented by Fasig-Tipton, which recognizes a "new Thoroughbred owner who has been successful in the sport and has had a positive impact on the industry."

Blessed with an abundance of speed, Rowayton debuted at Del Mar at 2 and, as the betting favorite, battled for the lead in a five-furlong maiden special weight before drawing away down the stretch to win by nearly 2 lengths.

The colt followed that up with a second-place finish in the Grade 1, \$300,000 Del Mar Futurity at seven furlongs, in which he led nearly every step of the way until caught late by eventual 2-year-old Eclipse champion Game Winner. Finishing third in that race was Roadster, who went on to win the Grade 1 Santa Anita Derby the following year.

Rowayton completed his juvenile season with another Grade 1 placing, this time in the \$300,000 American Pharoah Stakes at 11/16 miles at Santa Anita, finishing third behind Game Winner.

"He wouldn't change leads until we taught him, and then when he did, his speed, heart and stamina really came through as a 3-year-old," said Best.

In his sophomore year, Rowayton captured a \$92,000 allowance at Belmont Park in 1:14.94 for six and a half furlongs, only two-fifths of a second off the track record, in which he "took command a sixteenth out, then edged away to the finish to prevail," according to the Equibase chart.

Rowayton also placed in the Grade 3 Dwyer Stakes at one mile, in which he was forced to steady twice but was able to finish third behind eventual multiple Grade 1 winner and millionaire Code of Honor for trainer Don Chatlos.

In the Grade 1 H. Allen Jerkens Stakes at Saratoga, a nose, a nose and a neck separated Rowayton from winner Mind Control in the seven-furlong test, which was completed in a swift 1:21.43. He retired with earnings of \$252,130.

"He went up against some of the best horses in training, and we didn't choose easy races to put him in," said Best. "He was a Grade 1 talent who just fell a little shy of winning a Grade 1 stakes."

Rowayton's pedigree is free of any inbreeding through the fifth cross. He's the first foal from Rosemonde, an unraced daughter of Indian Charlie, who boasts a deep and blacktype-laden bottom line. Rosemonde, who is out of the stakes-placed Lemon Drop Kid mare Kid Majic, is a half-sister to Into Mischief's graded stakes winning daughter, Canadian champion female sprinter and older mare Miss Mischief (\$522,980).

Rosemonde has also produced a full sister to Rowayton – Clivetty, purchased by OXO Equine for \$900,000 at the 2019 OBS June 2-year-olds in training sale,

broke her maiden at Santa Anita last February. Rosemonde's 2019 filly by Frosted was bought by OXO Equine for \$375,000 as a weanling at the Keeneland November breeding stock sale.

Rowayton's third dam, stakes winner Call Her Magic, by Caller I. D., has ties to the region, as she was owned in the latter half of her career by prominent Delawarean Bayard Sharp, who bred and raced many important horses including Grade 1 winner Mississippi Mud and Grade 2 winner and top sire Dixieland Band. As a broodmare, Call Her Magic produced the precocious Grade 1 winner J P's Gusto, who captured the Del Mar Futurity at 2 as well as the Grade 2 Best Pal Stakes and the Grade 3 Hollywood Juvenile Championship Stakes, earning \$811,760.

Call Her Magic is a half-sister to Pacific Spell, by Langfuhr, who produced champion and Grade 1 Kentucky Oaks and Alabama Stakes winner Proud Spell (\$2,131,610), the dam of stakes winner Indian Spell, by Indian Charlie.

As a broodmare sire, Indian Charlie is ranked among the best in North America, with his daughters producing 739 winners of more than \$70 million, with 64 blacktype winners that includes 2019 champion male sprinter and Grade 1 Breeders' Cup Sprint winner Mitole (\$3,104,910).

Rowayton's sire, Into Mischief, is an elite sire, with 84 blacktype winners through 2020 and progeny earnings of more than \$84 million. The son of Harlan's Holiday, who stands at Spendthrift Farm in Kentucky and is booked full at \$225,000, was the leading sire in 2019 with

nearly \$19 million in earnings, and took the title again in 2020, with earnings of more than \$22 million. His top performer is Grade 1 Breeders' Cup Classic and Kentucky Derby winner and probable 2020 Horse of the Year Authentic (\$7,191,200).

While most sons of Into Mischief are just beginning their stud careers – including Authentic (stud fee \$75,000) and Grade 1 winner Audible (\$22,500) – Goldencents (\$15,000), who entered stud in 2015, may be an indication of what is to come.

Goldencents was North America's top second-crop sire in 2019, one of only eight sophomore sires ever to top \$5.5 million in earnings, and ranked as the top third-crop sire in 2020, with earnings of \$6.5 million.

According to a pedigree analysis on the Spendthrift Farm web site, mares that cross extremely well with Into Mischief, and would no doubt cross well with Rowayton, include those from the Gone West branch of Mr. Prospector (Speightstown, Munnings, Mr. Greeley), as well as the Fappiano branch of Mr. Prospector (Unbridled's Song, Songandaprayer, Empire Maker) and the Forty Niner branch (Distorted Humor, End Sweep, Coronado's Quest).

Best said that he plans on supporting Rowayton to give him every chance to become a successful sire.

"I plan on breeding some very good mares to him," said Best. "This is not a short-term deal for me; I care a lot about my horses, and I want Rowayton to succeed. And I'm sure Glenn and Becky [Brok] will take great care of him."

"We're really happy to be associated with Larry [Best], as he's 'in it to win it," said Brok. "Rowayton represents as good an opportunity that has ever come to Pennsylvania."



PA-BRED STAKES RECAPS



Fire's Finale was just waiting to get to Parx Racing to show what he could do. He is undefeated in his two starts at the Bensalem track, his second win coming in his stakes debut, the Pennsylvania Nursery on Dec. 7.

The Jump Start colt trained by Kelly Breen for breeder/owner Kenwood Racing LLC and co-owners Degaetano and Pastore Inc., made his first five starts outside of Pennsylvania, and proved competitive, with two seconds, a third and two fourths. But his breakthrough came in an open 2-year-old maiden special at six furlongs on Oct. 12 at Parx. Shipping in from Monmouth Park, Fire's Finale went off as the favorite in the field of five and caught the frontrunner in the final strides to win over a sloppy track.

Facing 11 others in the Pennsylvania Nursery, Fire's Finale garnered modest support as the 12-1 fifth choice while facing stakes **1st FIRE'S FINALE** - c, 2, Jump Start - Exchanging Fire, by Exchange Rate O-Kenwood Racing LLC and Degaetano and Pastore, Inc., B-Kenwood Racing, LLC (PA), T-Kelly J. Breen, J-Mychel J. Sanchez, \$54,750

winners Like a Saltshaker and Plane Drunk, and stakes-placed Kidnapped.

Early leader Just a Thought battled a number of challengers through an opening quarter of :22.77 and the half in :46.57, with Fire's Finale at the back of the pack. The eventual winner moved his way up along the rail, rallied four wide in the stretch outside of Kidnapped, who was also making a move, and pulled clear to win by a length. The final time for seven furlongs was 1:25.35. Favorite Like a Saltshaker finished sixth.

Fire's Finale is the last reported foal for Exchanging Fire, a daugh-

ter of Exchange Rate who proved a 100 percent producer, as all four of her foals are winners. Robb Levinsky of Kenwood Racing claimed Exchanging Fire, with a sole maiden claiming win to her credit, for \$50,000 at Gulfstream Park in March 2007 and campaigned her through a career in which she ran in nine straight stakes, winning three. The mare's other starter of 2020 was Start a Fire, a year-older Pennsylvania-bred full brother to Fire's Finale who broke his maiden in September at Penn National.

PA-BRED STAKES RECAPS CONTINUED

CLAIMING CROWN DISTAFF DASH STAKES GULFSTREAM PARK, \$90,000, 3YO/UP, F/M, 5FT, 12/5

A stakes winner and graded stakes-placed over two seasons of competition, Jakarta qualified for the Claiming Crown Distaff Dash Stakes at Gulfstream Park on Dec. 5 with a race early in her career. Those eligible for the Distaff Dash had to have started for a claiming price of \$25,000 or less in 2019-20 - Jakarta fell to that level in August 2019 at Penn National in her fifth start and was promptly claimed by Joseph E. Besecker and trainer Brandon Kulp for \$16,000 from breeder Tom Coulter of Arrowwood Farm.

Jakarta didn't start until her 4-year-old season, but was a firsttime out winner for Coulter in a maiden special weight that June at Penn National. Only twice in her career has she been risked for a tag - Besecker ran her back for \$22,500 in her first start under his colors that September, which she won by daylight. In three more starts for Besecker, Jakarta added two allowance wins and an allowance second, all at Penn, and was offered at the Besecker dispersal during the 2019 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic December mixed sale. Three Diamonds Farm stepped up and bought her for \$35,000. The price was a bargain.

Jakarta made nine starts for her new owner and trainer Maker in 2020, won four and earned \$245,727. Her first stakes win came in the Powder Break at Gulfstream Park in May. She ran four times in graded stakes and added valuable graded status to her pedigree when

third in the Buffalo Trace Franklin County Stakes-G3 at Keeneland in October. She campaigned in Florida, New York (where second in Saratoga's Caress Stakes), Kentucky, Canada and back to Florida. Sent off the 4-5 favorite over 10 others in the Claiming Crown Distaff Dash, she stalked early, rallied around rivals and took charge near the sixteenth pole, drawing off to win by 2 1/4 lengths after running five furlongs on the turf in :56.48.

Jakarta started off 2021 at Gulfstream Park in the Abundantia Stakes on New Year's Day but wound up fourth as the favorite in the field of 10. From 19 career starts, she has eight wins and earnings of \$336,706.

A daughter of Bustin Stones, she is the only foal out of the winning Stormello mare T J's Stormy Wit, and descends from the prolific Temper the Wind, the dam of six stakes horses, four of them winners, including multiple graded winner Stem the Tide. The family includes graded winners Gottcha Gold, American Freedom and Linkage. Coulter purchased T J's Stormy Wit for \$2,500 from Harry L. Landry Bloodstock at the 2014 Midlantic December sale with Jakarta in utero. The filly was born less than two months later.






