LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY

It's been another great year for the Pennsylvania Breeding Program and I look forward to 2022. Thanks to our PA horsemen, we'll give out almost \$25 million in awards, bonuses, Stakes and restricted races. We've returned to some state of normalcy and mares have arrived to get ready to foal in the new year, and we've been back at the track in person to cheer on our PA-Breds.

Remember, if you purchase a mare in foal at a public auction after Dec. 1, she must be brought into the state within 14 days of purchase through foaling (60 days if purchased at an overseas sale). During the foaling year the foal or its dam must spend at least 90 days in the state in order for that foal to be eligible to become a registered PA-Bred. You can also bring in your mare anytime, stay 60 consecutive days through foaling and breed back to a PA-Sire. Take a look at the Fasig Tipton December 7th sale on Tuesday.

You can find a PA-Sire in our new 2022 Stallion and Boarding Farm Directory and purchase a season from our 12th Annual Stallion Season Auction on thoroughlybred.com which will begin on January 15 and end on January 22nd. You'll be able to bid on PA-Sires or Sires from all over the country.

Our Stallion Directory will be mailed to all breeders before the end of December but you can view it now at pabred.com.

It couldn't be easier. Purchase a mare in foal on Tuesday at Fasig Tipton Timonium, bring her to PA, stay for 60 days through foaling, find a PA-Sire in our online directory and go to our Stallion Auction at thoroughlybred.com in January to purchase that season. Your PA-Sired PA-Bred will be eligible for up to 50% in Breeder Awards!! Wow!

Here's to a fantastic 2022 and a Happy and Healthy New Year! Go PA!!

WICKED STRONG TO REMAIN IN PA

The son of Hard Spun is the region's leading stallion by 2021 progeny earnings

“Nothing has moved the needle to warrant bringing him back to Kentucky,” Mark Toothaker said. “We felt like the best fit at present time is to remain in Pennsylvania.”

Just like that, leading stallion Wicked Strong is going to remain in Pennsylvania for 2022.

Wicked Strong, a 10-year-old son of Hard Spun—Moyne Abbey, by Charismatic, relocated to Dr. William Solomon's Pin Oak Lane Farm a year ago, and has quickly made waves in the area. He is the leading Mid-Atlantic sire with 80 winners, and progeny earnings of nearly \$3.7 million.

“He's been well supported,” Dr. Solomon said. “He came in with a significant number of yearlings and 2-year-olds, and produces consistent winners, far more winners than anyone else in the region. He's a beautifully-conformed horse, balanced, and was a good racehorse. All of those things combined make him very attractive.”

A \$375,000 yearling purchase by Centennial Farms at the 2012 Keeneland September Yearling Sale, Wicked Strong ultimately earned \$1,994,460. His sire, Grade 1 winner Hard Spun, was a classy and consistent racehorse with graded stakes wins from seven to nine furlongs and a second-place effort in the

Kentucky Derby-G1, Breeders' Cup Classic-G1 and Haskell-G1 to his credit. Dam Moyne Abbey was a winner at Gulfstream Park in 2005, and Wicked Strong offered plenty with physical and pedigree combined to justify the price tag.

He broke his maiden second out at Belmont Park, then placed in the Grade 2 Remsen Stakes to signal his participation on the Kentucky Derby trail. Wicked Strong was 9-1 when he upset the Grade 1 Wood Memorial at Aqueduct by 3½ lengths under Rajiv Maragh, then ran very well to be fourth in the Kentucky Derby after stumbling out of the gate and facing traffic trouble. Wicked Strong was also fourth in the Belmont Stakes, dead heating with California Chrome in that runner's Triple Crown attempt.

Just one start later, Wicked Strong defeated Belmont winner Tonalist in the Grade 2 Jim Dandy, a \$600,000 contest at Saratoga. He was second, beaten just a nose, in the \$1.25 million Travers Stakes-G1 before his sophomore season ended when he lost his rider after clipping heels in the Jockey Club Gold Cup-G1.

Wicked Strong didn't win again, but continued to compete successfully at the highest level. He was third in the Grade 1 Woodward and second in the Jockey Club Gold Cup before running fourth in the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile at Keeneland. He retired with three wins, four seconds, and three thirds in 19 starts.

Wicked Strong entered stud at Spendthrift Farm and has seen success, with 121 winners to date including six stakes winners and nearly a dozen stakes placers. His daughter Evil Lyn, out of the Mr. Greeley mare Miss Relentless, won the Lady Canterbury Stakes this year after taking the Hilltop Stakes at Pimlico in 2020. Son Brooklyn Strong did his sire one better when winning the Grade 2 Remsen last year after first taking the Sleepy Hollow Stakes. Por Que No

won the Boiling Springs Stakes on the grass at Monmouth Park over the summer, and Wicked Runner is a three-time stakes winner in Puerto Rico. Wicked Strong's daughter Jilted Bride was graded stakes-placed at Belmont Park this year.

The decision was then made to move him from Spendthrift to Pin Oak Lane. Spendthrift's sales manager Mark Toothaker helped broker the deal. "He's an outstanding option for Mid-Atlantic breeders with a regional mare," Toothaker said.

"If you take a horse like that, who hasn't produced what is considered enough stakes winners, then move him to a place like Pennsylvania, you can hope that he blossoms further," Dr. Solomon said. "The rest is history. He gets a lot of good runners, there's no question about that."

Wicked Strong is likely to remain in the Keystone State for the foreseeable future. "You

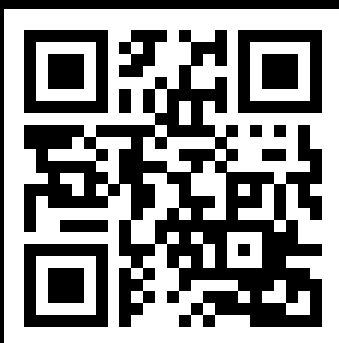
always have the option to take him back if you have to, but I don't think that is going to happen," Dr. Solomon said. "If he doesn't keep his position in Pennsylvania he could go back, but if he does then I don't think there would be a reason to leave."

Nationally, Wicked Strong is a top-10 third-crop sire on the progeny earnings list and is ranked fourth by number of winners, ahead of Liam's Map, Carpe Diem, Tonalist and Honor Code. His other stakes runners include winners Wicked Warrior and Wicked Empire and stakes-placed Secretly Wicked, Microcap, Inawic, Shooger Ray Too, Strong Rules, Myawaya, Wicked Slider, Smart N Wicked, and 2021 juvenile Simply Wicked.

He stands for just \$3,500. ■

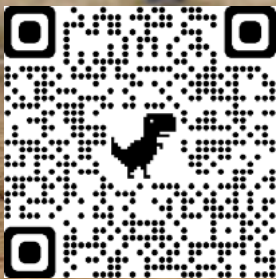

GOLDDIGGER'S BOY NOW STANDING AT EQUISTAR

Golddigger's Boy, one of the richest runners for the region's longtime leading sire Jump Start, has been moved to stand at Rodney Eckenrode's Equistar Training & Breeding in Annville, Pa., in 2022. The stud fee for the dark bay 14-year-old owned by Luana J. Johnson is \$2,500 live foal, payable when the foal stands and nurses.

A four-time stakes winner – from seven furlongs to a mile and a sixteenth – with earnings of \$585,985, Pennsylvania-bred Golddigger's Boy entered stud in 2015 at Whirlwind Stable in Grantville. In his first three crops, through his current 3-year-olds, he is the sire of 18 named foals, with seven winners from 10 starters.



His nine starters this year have combined to earn over \$250,000, for an average approaching \$30,000 per runner, and are led by multiple allowance-winning 4-year-olds Copperhead Creek and Eagles Cry. ■

WELL SPELLED MOVES TO MOUNTAIN SPRINGS

Frank Vento and Judith Barrett have moved their stallion Well Spelled to Mountain Springs Farm in Palmyra, Pa., for the 2022 season.

With four small crops to race, Well Spelled has ranked as one of the state's leading sires by PHBA stallion awards the past three years. He is the sire of Hockey Puck and Well Graced, both stakes winners at 2, in his first two crops that total 24 foals. And his daughter Fish to Fry was Penn National's 2019 Horse of the Year when she won six of nine starts at the track that year.

This year is his best yet, with progeny earnings approaching \$500,000 with 20 runners (from 45 total foals), led by 4-year-old No More Martinis, a winner of three of his four starts.

In an article that ran in the October issue of the PA Thoroughbred Report, Barrett said: "Since we started breeding him, they've all been runners. They all have speed, most hit the board, and they do well from stakes and allowances to claiming, long and short – they're just runners."



The 13-year-old gray son of Spellbinder, from the Storm Cat male line, is a graded stakes-winning sprinter who finished in the top three in 10 of his 11 starts at 2 and 3, and counted wins in the Jersey Shore Stakes-G3 at Monmouth and the Gallant Bob Stakes at Parx over that year's Eclipse Award-winning sprinter Trinniberg while getting six furlongs in 1:09.08.

He stands for \$1,500 live foal, payable when the foal stands and nurses, with special consideration to approved mares. ■

The formula that has worked brilliantly for the past decade for the St. Omer's Farm of Susan Quick and her late husband Stephen continues to yield fantastic results. Juvenile filly Disco Ebo, the ninth foal for Pennsylvania sire Weigelia and the Disco Rico mare Katarica Disco, became the mating's fifth stakes performer when she dominated the \$200,000 Shamrock Rose Stakes at Penn National on the evening of Nov. 26.

Sent off as the 3-2 favorite in the field of nine while seeking her third consecutive win, Disco Ebo took charge from the start. Away alertly, she zipped through fractions of :21.79, :45.48 and :58.06 while never being pressed, drew clear on the turn, and was lengths the best in the stretch. Wrapped up late, she won by five and three-quarter lengths while completing the six furlongs in 1:11.25.

Disco Ebo was purchased as a yearling for \$52,000 by LC Racing and campaigns for Cash is King LLC and LC Racing LLC. Now with earnings of \$203,060 in five starts, she is trained by Butch Reid, who has had many of the filly's siblings in his barn, including additional stakes winners Smooth B, who pushed his earnings to \$526,288 this year and has won or placed in seven stakes; and \$423,318-earner Fat Kat, as well as graded stakes-placed Disco Rose, an earner of \$449,280.

Disco Ebo made her debut in June at Monmouth and finished a game second. Sent to Parx in August, she gave way after battling What's Cookin early and finished second. Her first win was by an eye-catching 10 3/4 lengths two weeks later at Parx.

Disco Ebo has now twice turned the tables on What's Cookin – she won a Penn allowance on Oct. 26 by 10 1/4 lengths while What's Cookin finished third. And both were in the Shamrock Rose, with What's Cookin finishing far back in the strung out field.

Katarica Disco, bred by Stephen Quick, has 10 foals of racing age, and all 10 have won, earning a combined total of \$2,491,984, led by stakes-placed Pink Princess with \$572,135. The mare's first foal, the filly Cryptic Kate (by Crypto Star), is the only one not by Weigelia (he entered stud the following year). But when bred to Weigelia, Cryptic Kate has as her first foal the \$118,004-earner Confirmed Genius, a four-time winner this year at 3.

Disco Ebo was a mid-May foal, and Katarica Disco missed to the cover of Weigelia for 2020, but has since had a colt by him this past February and was once again returned to the stallion who stands at Wyn Oaks Farm in Delta. Disco Ebo is Weigelia's ninth stakes winner. ■

PA-BRED ELIGIBILITY & DOMICILE REQUIREMENTS

A Thoroughbred foal born in the state of Pennsylvania and registered as such with the Jockey Club is eligible for Pennsylvania-Bred registration with the PHBA if one of the following conditions is met:

A) For foals of 2019 and thereafter, the dam of the foal resided continuously in Pennsylvania since December 1 of the year of conception through foaling. Mares not being bred back also fall under this category. Domicile form required by December 1.

B) The dam of the foal was purchased at a public sale after December 1 of the year of conception and brought into Pennsylvania within 14 days of the date of purchase (60 days if outside the US) and remained continuously through foaling. During the year of foaling, the foal or its dam spent at least ninety (90) days in the state. (Note: Must be a public sale – not a private transaction.)

C) The dam of the foal was bred back to a stallion standing in Pennsylvania which was registered with the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association as a Pennsylvania stallion during the breeding season of the year of foaling, and said dam of the foal resided in the state for at least sixty (60) consecutive days during which foaling occurred.

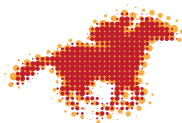
