JUST ONE TIME WINNING BIG FOR BREEDER

She's breeder & owner Warriors Reward LLC's first GS winner.

When the hammer fell for Hip 1376 at the 2017 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, few expected the baby in utero would end up being a Grade 1 winner, let alone just a stone's throw from the auction ring.

Chad Schumer signed the \$45,000 ticket on behalf of Donny Brown and Tom McClay's Warriors Reward partnership. The 7-year-old mare, named Ida Clark, was a daughter of Speightstown who was carrying her third foal following an uninspiring racing career that saw her win two of 10 starts for \$25,000 in earnings.

Despite her less-than-flattering race record, her pedigree offered promise as the half-sibling to two stakes winners, including Grade 3 winner and black-type producer For Rubies. And despite not meeting her reserve on her first trip through the ring when in foal for the first time, two of her earlier foals sold for \$55,000 and \$65,000 respectively.

Ida Clark was in foal to first-year stallion Not This Time, a promising son of Giant's Causeway whose racing career was cut short by injury. After breaking his maiden on second asking by 10 lengths, Not This Time demolished the Grade 3 Iroquois field at Churchill Downs by nine. He would end up going off the clear-cut favorite in the Grade 1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile, but his rally ultimately fell a neck short of eventual juvenile champion Classic Empire. It would be his final career race, as a suspensory injury later that month ended his racing career.

Out of the five-time stakes winning mare Miss Macy Sue, Not This Time's pedigree earned him a spot at a central Kentucky stud farm. The fourth foal for his dam,

he was already a half-brother to stakes-winning filly Taylor S, as well as Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile-G1 and Woodward-G1 winner Liam's Map. Not This Time's stud career commenced at Taylor Made Farm, and Ida Clark was one of his first customers.

Shipped north to Pennsylvania, Ida Clark settled into her new home. In late January, her first foal, Black Stetson, broke his maiden at Parx Racing. Two months later, Ida Clark delivered a leggy chestnut filly with a crooked blaze down her face on Easter, April 1, 2018. Two weeks following the birth of his newest sister, Black Stetson posted an 18-1 upset in the Bridgetown Stakes at Aqueduct.

Now the dam of a stakes winner, Ida Clark was subsequently bred back to Kentucky stallion Outwork and entered in the following year's Keeneland January Sale, where she sold for \$60,000. Off to New York, the Not This Time filly would be her lone Pennsylvania-bred for Warriors Reward.

After growing into herself in Pennsylvania, the filly was sent south to Virginia to receive Virginia certification. That May, she was officially named Just One Time. She was broken and went through her first lessons, posting the first few breezes of her career in September of her 2-year-old year at the Ingleside training center in Charlottesville, Va. The following month, she was shipped back to the Keystone State and into the Penn National barn of trainer Michael Salvaggio Jr. The filly breezed consistently for the next six months before finally showing up in the entry box for the May 14, 2021, card at Penn National.

Already nearly midway through her 3-year-old year, Just One Time was one of only two first-time starters in the field of 10. Despite that, she was a close second choice in the wagering. Fractious in the gate, Just One Time still managed to break sharply to contend for the early lead with Made to Hustle. Following pressured fractions of :22.11 and :45.63, Just One Time

secured the lead turning into the stretch. She turned away a bid from Amen Sylvania before pulling away to a comfortable one and three-quarter-length score in a final time of 1:11.45 for six furlongs.

The performance was enough to warrant a jump straight into stakes company for her next start. With the Malvern Rose Stakes for sophomore Pennsylvania-bred fillies two months later, Just One Time continued to train forwardly at Penn National before shipping into Presque Isle for the stakes affair. With a field of seven lined up for the six and a half-furlong contest, Just One Time ended up the second choice behind Kentucky shipper Rookery. Settling just behind early leaders Tactical Pajamas and Jenna's Lil Agnes through splits of :22.71 and :45.91, Just One Time moved in to take advantage turning into the stretch before blasting away to a four and a quarter-length victory over the all-weather surface. She posted a final time of 1:17.42.

Returning to Presque Isle the following month for the Lady Erie Stakes against open company, Just One Time was installed second choice behind Kentucky invader Bullseye Beauty. Blasting from the gate, the filly went toe-to-toe with 12-1 longshot Lady Edith on the early lead. With jockey Angel Rodriguez struggling to restrain his mount, the pair ripped through the opening quarters in the ultra-swift times :21.60

and :43.96. While the duo still turned into the stretch together, the pack was closing in, and Just One Time gave way late as Bullseye Beauty swept to the front. Just One Time ended up fading to seventh in the field of 10.

Regrouping from her first loss that displayed some of the filly's inexperience, Just One Time returned in a Penn National allowance the following month. With the field scratched down to four, the filly sat a length off the early leader in the opening stages before taking command through splits of :21.92 and :45.27. She drew away down the stretch under a hand ride, posting a six and a quarter-length victory in a swift 1:09.28 for six furlongs.

With the New Start Stakes one month later at Penn National, Just One Time returned to Pennsylvania-bred company for the six-furlong event. With the field scratched down to seven, the daughter of Not This Time ended up the 7-5 co-favorite with impressive Parx shipper Oxana. Pressing the quick opening pace set by Secret Banker, Just One Time took over rounding into the turn and bounded away to a three-length lead by the top of the stretch. She continued to pull away, crossing the wire five and three-quarter lengths ahead of Oxana in 1:10.07.

JUST ONE TIME CONTINUED...

The performance turned heads, including that of Todd Mosteller, executive director of the Pennsylvania Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association. Mosteller owned racehorses through his Commonwealth New Era Racing for 15 years, including on the national stage with Taris. Mosteller purchased the filly for \$90,000 as a yearling in 2012. Taris broke her maiden by 12 lengths at Aqueduct before winning the Wide Country Stakes at Laurel in her second start. After failing as the favorite in the Grade 3 Honeybee and missing six months, Taris returned an eight-length winner in a Presque Isle allowance. She subsequently blew the doors off in the Grade 2 Raven Run Stakes at Keeneland, annihilating the field by nine lengths in a track record time of 1:21.32 for seven furlongs. At the following month's Fasig-Tipton November Sale, she hammered for \$2.35 million to trainer Simon Callaghan on behalf of Coolmore.

Mosteller reached out to Donny Brown about buying into Just One Time, and the pair struck a deal, but her new owner believed the filly good enough for the national stage. He recommended that they transfer Just One Time to the barn of two-time champion trainer Brad Cox. The barn change was completed, and the filly posted her first

workout for her new trainer at Churchill Downs three weeks following her romp in the New Start.

With plenty of gate schooling and work put into the filly over the next four months, she was finally ready to debut for her new connections in the Grade 2 Inside Information Stakes. The seven-furlong contest for older fillies and mares was the first start in graded company for Just One Time, but the betting public was not deterred when making her the decisive 3-2 favorite in the field of 10. Despite her extensive schooling, Just One Time was fractious in the gate yet again and got off to a poor start. She found herself seventh of 10, far from her customary pace-stalking position. Jockey Joel Rosario opted to take the filly widest of all around the turn, and she responded once in the clear from kickback. Moving up to third approaching the top of the stretch, Just One Time rallied down the center of the track, collaring fellow Pennsylvania-bred Jakarta in the final sixteenth before holding off the closing kick of Four Graces to post a three-quarter-length victory.

Just One Time had passed her graded stakes test with flying colors, and her team now knew that she was capable of competing at the highest level. The filly and mare sprint division offers minimal top-level opportunities, with only three Grade 1 races available each year outside of the Breeders' Cup. The first is the \$500,000 Madison

Stakes on opening Saturday at Keeneland, and Just One Time was pointed towards the seven-furlong contest.

A field of nine fillies and mares lined up for the Madison, including defending champion Kimari, nine-time stakes winner Bell's the One, and Brad Cox's other runner, the last out, stakes-winning Lady Rocket. With the quintet vying for favoritism leading up to the race, Just One Time assumed the role over Kimari and Lady Rocket as the gates sprung. And again, Just One Time failed to break with the field. With Lady Rocket and Kimari contending the early pace through a :22.11 opening quarter, Just One Time and rider Flavien Prat found themselves in eighth, leading only the deep-closing Bell's the One. With the pair up front posting a punishing half mile split in :44.50, Just One Time was still eight and a half lengths behind, and Bell's the One had already started to unravel her closing kick.

With her rival whizzing past heading into the turn, Just One Time, now last, switched to the outside clear of kickback and began to pick off rivals. As Bell's the One's rally carried her even with the frontrunning duo at the top of the stretch, Just One Time was still over two lengths behind and widest of all. Bell's the One began

to spurt clear of the tiring Kimari and Lady Rocket and looked to be on her way to victory before a mud-spattered chestnut materialized down the center of the track, seemingly having jumped into the race at the sixteenth pole. It was Just One Time, closing with a full head of steam, drawing even with her hard-trying rival in the dying stages. Bell's the One tried to fight back, but she gave in in the finals strides as Just One Time edged to a ¾ length Madison Stakes victory.

It took 1:22.79 for Just One Time to become a Grade 1 winner, and the celebration was euphoric, with the caravan from Pennsylvania piling onto the Keeneland turf course for the winner's circle celebration. The victory marked the sixth of seven in Just One Time's blossoming career, pushing her earnings above the half-million mark.

Just One Time has returned to Churchill Downs to prepare for the second of four female sprint Grade 1s, the Derby City Distaff on the sport's biggest stage, Kentucky Derby Day. With an exciting year in store for the Pennsylvania-bred filly, the ultimate goal is a return to Keeneland in November, where the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint will be run over the same course and distance as the Madison. ■

PENN STATE EQUINE PROGRAM VISITS CABIN CREEK FARM

In February, the Pennsylvania Horse Racing Association hosted their annual field trip for students of Penn State's equine program. Starting on the backstretch of Penn National Racecourse and ending at Cabin Creek Farm, students had the opportunity to look into multiple different career paths available in Pennsylvania's Thoroughbred racing and breeding industry.

To start off the morning, students met in the barn of trainer Carl O'Callaghan. Previously based on the West Coast, O'Callaghan made the move to base his stable out of Penn National in mid-2016. Students had the chance to meet the trainer's millionaire winner Kinsale King, who won the Group 1 Dubai Golden Shaheen in 2010, along with some of his other current runners. O'Callaghan described the typical daily workings of his barn, as well as the business aspects of running a racing stable. He talked about the differences between horses and the importance of placing them where they can be most successful. He also touched on the differences between training in his native Ireland compared to the United States.

In addition, students got to hear from jockey Andrew Wolfson about the experience and lifestyle of race riding, as well as from Todd Mosteller, breeder, owner, and executive director of the Pennsylvania Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association. Mosteller highlighted PHBA's breeder award program.

Following Carl O'Callaghan's barn, students shifted to the barn of trainer Erin McClellan. With the majority of the students women, McClellan offered the component of speaking from a woman's perspective within the industry. McClellan did not grow up in a racing family and made the decision

for a full-time career in racing later in life than most. Following questions, students had the opportunity to walk throughout McClellan's barn and meet some of her horses, including 2019 Pennsylvania Nursery winner Hockey Puck.

With time on the backstretch wrapping up, the students headed to the front side for lunch next to the paddock. Dr. Jerry Pack joined them to discuss his job as Penn National's track veterinarian. Dr. Pack talked about equine anatomy and the importance of his daily role on the racetrack. He touched on how the Thoroughbred has evolved over the years and the way his job has evolved as well.

Following lunch, the Penn State students hopped on a bus and took the 30-minute trip to Cabin Creek Farm. Once there, they were met with a stallion show featuring Cabin Creek's four current stallions – Red Vine, Ice Box, Lentenor and Unfettered. Afterwards, the group moved inside and received a lesson from an equine nutritionist before PHBA's executive secretary, Brian Sanfratello, further explained the Pennsylvania-bred breeding and racing program and the impact of the industry on the Commonwealth. To cap off the day, the students returned outside to observe a farrier at work. ■

Stepping up to the highest level, Just One Time rallied from last to defeat eight others in Keeneland’s Grade 1 Madison Stakes on April 9.

Sent off the slight 2-1 favorite in the seven-furlong test, Just One Time drifted far back over the muddy track behind an early pace of :22.11, :44.50 and 1:09.64 and, as the field entered the far turn, she was last under Flavien Prat.

With no room to go to the inside, Prat swung her six wide entering the stretch and she took dead aim on Bell’s the One, who had also been far back in the early stages and gotten the jump on her as they turned for home. Digging in, Just One Time was relentless as the mud-streaked filly caught her rival late and edged away to win by three-quarters of a length. The final time was 1.22.79.

The 4-year-old filly races for her breeders, Donald Brown and Tom McClay’s Warriors Reward LLC, in partnership with Todd Mosteller’s Commonwealth New Era Racing, who purchased an interest last fall.

The chestnut daughter of Not This Time and the Speightstown mare Ida Clark was unraced at 2, and won four of her five starts last year, including the Malvern Rose in her second start in July at Presque Isle Downs, and the New Start Stakes at Penn National in October. Previously trained by Michael Salvaggio Jr., Just One Time was transferred to the barn of trainer Brad Cox last fall. She is now on four-

race win streak after also capturing the Inside Information Stakes-G2 in January at Gulfstream Park, and has career earnings of \$525,195 from seven starts. ■

Fortheluvofbourbon and Beren couldn't have made it any more exciting after being locked in a duel from the far turn in the seven-furlong Page McKenney Handicap at Parx Racing on April 25 and hit the wire together, with Fortheluvofbourbon getting the victory by a neck.

Owned by Smart Angle LLP and trained by Michael Pino, 5-year-old Fortheluvofbourbon recorded his second career stakes win with gritty determination, similar to his win in a three-way photo in last summer's Banjo Picker Sprint Stakes on the Pennsylvania Day at the Races card.

For his most recent win he had to face 2021 Pennsylvania-bred Horse of the Year finalist Beren as well as the likes of stakes winners I Am Redeemed and Wait for It in the field of 10. Hustled from the gate by Kendrick Carmouche, Fortheluvofbourbon pressed Beren through opening fractions of 22:63 and :45.19. After six furlongs in 1:09.87, the two battled through the stretch with neither willing to give way as they hit the wire. The final time was 1:23.49.

In between his two stakes wins, Fortheluvofbourbon had won or placed in four of his six starts, including a third-place finish in the Blitzen Stakes at Parx in December. In 18 outings, 13 have come at Parx, resulting in all 11 of his top-three placings.

A son of Bourbon Courage, Fortheluvofbourbon made his career debut at 3 for Vaccaro Racing Stable and trainer Patricia Farro, which he won by five and a half lengths at Parx in February 2020.

A little over a month later he was running at Oaklawn Park with trainer Philip D'Amato for owners Agave Racing Stable and ERJ Racing LLC – in his first start for his new connections he finished in a photo for third and wound up fifth. Two starts later he was claimed by Pino and Daniel Ryan at Churchill Downs for \$50,000. Except for a try in the Maryland Million Sprint at Laurel last fall (where he finished sixth) he has raced at Parx exclusively.

Bred by longtime New Jersey breeder Hidden Acres 4-D Farm, Fortheluvofbourbon is the first foal out of the Not For Love mare Nosubstituteforluv from the family of stakes winner Love Who (by Not For Love). His Pennsylvania-bred half-sister Gateway Love (by Uncle Lino) placed in both her starts in 2021. ■

After the flashy chestnut filly Cinnabunny became a stakes winner last September, she made her next appearance in the auction ring as a racing or broodmare prospect. Caroline and Greg Bentley spent \$240,000 at the Keeneland November sale to take her home.

Becoming a broodmare will have to wait. Turned over to trainer Cathal A. Lynch, Cinnabunny reappeared on the worktab in January at Fair Hill in Maryland. After a nearly six-month break, she returned to competition in March and finished fourth against heady company in the Penn's Landing Stakes at Parx. Seven weeks later she earned back a bigger portion of her sales price by taking the Unique Bella Stakes at Parx on April 25.

Under the Bentleys' Runnymoore Racing colors Cinnabunny was sent off the favorite in the 11-horse field, rallied past pacesetting stakes winner Hey Mamaluke to grab the lead in the stretch and held off longshot closer Ninetypercentbrynn to win by a neck. Final time for the seven furlongs was 1:25.03.

Cinnabunny was bred by Michael Anspach's Shooting Star Stable and started her career for her breeder, winning four of her first six starts. Madaket Stables (Solomon Kumin), Michael Dubb and Michael Caruso purchased her privately in the fall of 2020, with Anspach retaining a part. She was turned over to Brad Cox and in her next start, and stakes debut, finished third in the Grade 3 Sugar Swirl at Gulfstream that December.

Cinnabunny has made 14 career starts, winning seven and finishing second or third four times while earning \$279,120. She previously won Remington Park's Flashy Lady Stakes in September and was third in last summer's Dr. Teresa Garofalo Memorial Stakes at Parx.

A 5-year-old daughter of Golden Lad, Cinnabunny is the first foal for Pennsylvania-bred mare English Mum, whom Anspach raced and won two races with in late 2014 and early 2015. A daughter of Congrats, English Mum has a 2018 filly by Uncle Lino named Mo Mummy and a 2019 full brother to Cinnabunny named Windsor Gold, both who have yet to start. Her yearling is a filly by Hoppertunity named Mummalicious, and she was bred to Jimmy Creed for this year. ■

Since becoming a stakes winner last December at age 5, Kaylasaurus has proven she belongs at the level.

After Bush Racing Stable and Liberty House Racing claimed her for \$25,000 last November at Penn National, the Timothy Kreiser trainee has raced exclusively at Laurel, running four times in stakes (out of five starts), recording two wins, a second and a fourth, was second in allowance company in March, and has amassed \$163,860.

After capturing the Willa On the Move Stakes in December, Kaylasaurus was runner up behind Time Limit in the What A Summer, ran a bang-up race to be fourth, beaten less than two lengths by winner Glass Ceiling, in the Grade 3 Barbara Fritchie, and now has added the Primonetta.

Sent off the second choice in the field of six going six furlongs on a fast main track, Kaylasaurus rated at the back of the pack while favorite Princess Kokachin set a modest pace. As the pace quickened, jockey Horacio Karamanos swung her out to the five path and with clear sailing she closed steadily outside rivals, took the lead inside the sixteenth pole, and held firm to cross the wire a three-quarters-length winner. Her time was 1:10.74.

From 23 career starts, the daughter of Munnings has eight wins, five seconds and two thirds, with earnings totaling \$319,793.

Bred by Tom Coulter's Arrowwood Farm out of the stakes-winning Flatter mare Five Diamonds, Kaylasaurus made 18 starts for her breeder until last November's claim.

She is the third foal out of Five Diamonds, who was purchased by Arrowwood Farm in November 2011 out of the Keeneland Breeding Stock sale as a maiden mare. She produced her first foal, a son of Petionville, in 2014, and now has six foals of racing age, among them her current 2-year-old colt Totonaco (by Free Drop Billy). Four of her offspring are winners, including \$104,992-earner Jump Shift (by Smarty Jones) and Kaylasaurus' 3-year-old full-brother Nimitz Class, a winner of three of four starts this year. 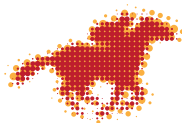
