# LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY

Congratulations to the winners of the inaugural running of the Pa-Sired Pa-Bred Stallion Series! Bonuses of \$50,000 were presented to the four winning trainers, led by Lupe Preciado receiving \$28,333 for the first-place finish of Flor de Sombra and third with Gordian Knot. Second place money of \$15,000 went to Ed Coletti for Keithsendshelloooo. Bernie Houghton and Butch Reid received \$3,333 each as part of a three-way tie for third. Thanks goes out to all the owners and trainers who participated and let's not forget all our PA Stallions who are the lifeblood of our series.

In 2023 the series will be expanded and run in three legs, SIX STAKES, at 5 1/2 furlongs for \$100,000, 6 1/2 furlongs for \$150,000, and a flat mile for \$200,000. Each leg will consist of a 2yo race and a 2yo filly race. Don't forget about the \$50,000 trainer bonus for the top three point-earning horses. Nomination forms for the 2023 series are only \$200 if paid by Dec. 31 of the participants yearling year. You can go to [pabred.com](https://pabred.com) under 'Featured' and print the nomination form.

Penn National Race Course, HBPA, and PHBA will be offering two introductory starter allowances with purses of \$50,000 on the Friday, Nov. 25 card. The conditions will be 3&up and 3&up F&M who have run for a tag of \$7,500 or less within the past 18 months at a distance of 6 furlongs. Based on interest level for these races, there could be the possibility of a PA-Bred Claiming Crown Day in 2023.

As a reminder, the Annual Stallion and Breeding Farm Directory will be published in December. Please make sure you reserve your spot before Nov. 11. Don't miss out on this free service!

Please remember, for the foal crop of 2023, broodmares must be in the state by Dec. 1, 2022, or within 14 days of a public sale (within 60 days of a sale outside the U.S.) or bred back to a PA-Sire. We ask that you submit all broodmare domicile forms online. The new form is now available for use by going to [pabred.com](https://pabred.com) under forms. As usual, please contact our office with any questions you may have. Pennsylvania is the only place to Breed & Race and remember, you ain't seen nothing yet! Go PA!!

# In Celebration of the PA Breeding Program

From Iroquois to Smarty Jones, Flatterer to Unique Bella, Pennsylvania-breds have shown they can compete with the very best. Danzig and Storm Cat helped shaped the breed, Princess of Sylmar won the Kentucky Oaks, and Alphabet Soup, Finest City, Go for Wand, Shamrock Rose and Tikkanen all won Breeders' Cup races.

With a comprehensive system of bonuses for breeders and owners, Pennsylvania is a premier place to breed and race horses. Owners from other states – including Kentucky and New Jersey – have been moving their mares to the Keystone State in pursuit of those bonuses, and have been reaping the rewards.

"You cannot beat the breeders' awards and what they are doing with the program," said Rick Molineaux, a New Jersey resident who has had as many as eight mares a year in Pennsylvania. "Where else can you breed a horse and run it for seven years or more and make that much money? With just one horse I made about \$500,000 and that doesn't include the awards. It's a win-win."

Molineaux's history with Pennsylvania runs deep, as aunt

Jane Baker was involved in the sport from the 1950s.

"I started breeding in 2000, but my aunt was breeding horses in Pennsylvania in the late '70s or early '80s," he said. "She was very much a senior citizen but she loved her horses."

Molineaux became involved by picking out stallions for Baker's mares. "I went to the breeding farms and they met me and my 50 questions and decided to educate me," he recalled. "The Pennsylvania breeding farms were very helpful to everybody."

Over time, Molineaux bred several major earners, including Winning the Medal, a son of Medallist who had a record of 43-7-6-9

with earnings of \$461,516. He was a multiple stakes winner. Stakes-placed Estrada's Girl ran 56 times with 15 wins and 20 placings, earning \$549,854. Ricky's Lite was a stakes-placed earner of \$277,262, and the Vicky Schowe-bred but Molineaux-raced Aussie Mist compiled \$273,886. Almost every start came in Pennsylvania.

The breeders' bonuses in maiden races are 50% to a Pennsylvania-sired and bred runner, or 25% for a non-Pennsylvania-sired state-bred. Other race conditions are 40% for dual qualifiers and 20% otherwise. As for owners, the bonuses are paid by the track, with 40% paid out from Parx, 30% at Presque Isle, and 30% at Penn National.

"Do you know how many vacations I can take due to these horses?" Molineaux joked.

Wife Liz added, "Breeding in Pennsylvania is well worth it, financially. And it's a better organization all together. The people you deal with are nice, they're more organized, the farms are well maintained. It's worth it, to us."

Mark Toothaker, Stallion Sales Manager at the renowned Spendthrift Farm in Kentucky, also has become involved in Pennsylvania. "I've been part of the program there for quite a while," he said. "I want to be able to breed back to Kentucky stallions while taking advantage of the program up there, so being able to foal the mare there is a plus. I was looking for a state program that had that option."

He has found the market in Pennsylvania to be ideal. "It's a great avenue for me to take mares I'm looking to move along. I could sell them in Kentucky but I would rather work with the

breeders in Pennsylvania, give them the mare at no expense, and split the foal and the breeders' award money."

Toothaker makes sure to send at least one if not two mares every year. "It's a great program," he said. "You can run in restricted company at some of the tracks where you aren't having to face the world. It's a big advantage to race there and still have a chance to get black type."

Spendthrift sent Grade 1-winning stallion Wicked Strong to Pin Oak Lane Farm in Pennsylvania for the 2021 season. "When things went south as far as commercial breeders abandoning him in Kentucky, we didn't want to give up," Toothaker said. "I really think he's a great fit for the Pennsylvania breeder. He can get you a runner that goes long or short, so we're hoping something big will pop up for him."

David Todd Wilkinson, one of the four "Ds" in New Jersey's Hidden Acres 4-D Farm, has become fond of the Pennsylvania program as well. "It's actually closer for us to see our horses race," he said. "We are about 20 minutes from Parx, where they run almost all year. And between Parx, Presque Isle and Penn National, there's racing almost every single day."

Wilkinson has been sending mares to Pennsylvania for eight years, and owns a breeding right to WynOaks Farm stallion Warrior's Reward. "We just like the program," he said. "We are the breeder, the owner, everything. So we foal out in Pennsylvania, then breed back to a PA-sire. I like that when you have a Pennsylvania sire, it's even more money for the breeders awards. Hopefully it promotes bringing new stallions here and making the program even better."

Wilkinson had as many as 12 mares before, but is down to four, all of which will foal in Pennsylvania in 2023. He also bred Fortheluvofbourbon, a multiple stakes winner who has won 11 of 22 starts and earned \$518,120. The son of Bourbon Courage has won five starts in a row and just defended his title in the 2022 Banjo Picker Sprint on Pa Day at the Races.

The PHBA Breeding Fund distributes an average of \$28 million each year in Breeders Awards, Stallion Awards, Owners Bonuses and purses for Restricted Races. With the extra funding available to owners and breeders, Pennsylvania stands as the place to develop a racehorse. ■

# RRP Thoroughbred Makeover Recap

The Retired Racehorse Project's Thoroughbred Makeover returned to a semblance of normalcy for the 2022 edition following last year's Mega Makeover. Horses from all over the country gathered at the Kentucky Horse Park to compete across 10 different disciplines from October 12-15.

A total of 18 Pennsylvania-breds strutted their stuff in eight disciplines at the Thoroughbred Makeover. Of the 18 entrants, 10 of them were also PA-Sired.

The first two days were the preliminary rounds of competition, with each horse competing for a spot in Saturday's finale. Horses could compete in two disciplines, and the top five scorers would move on to the finals.

The freestyle competition is a fan favorite every year. Trainers have the ability to create a routine that best displays their horse's unique strengths outside a certain discipline. The creativity displayed during freestyle always makes for an entertaining show. Two PA-breds competed in freestyle. Guns of Steel, bred by Heart Hill Farms LLC, placed a respectable 7th and was honored among the top 10 at the finale.

Callaway King, bred by Main Line Racing Stable, was trained by Lindsey Partridge, who is known to put together incredible routines for the freestyle competition. Callaway King was no exception, wielding a waving blue flag, jumping and lifting a giant white tarp over his head, and finally pulling a wagon behind him with unbothered ease. The team ended up tallying the highest overall preliminary score.

Unfortunately, the Partridge barn had to pack up early due to unforeseen circumstances, so Callaway King was forced to scratch and give up his spot in the finale.

Over in the field hunter competition, Downtown Doc Brown, bred by Uptowncharlybrown Stud LLC, chalked up a score of 332.033 to end up fourth in the preliminary round. The son of Uptowncharlybrown sported a Pennsylvania themed stall for trainer Hannah Freeman.

Eventing is one of the more popular discipline choices, with over 50 horses competing in the 2022 event. A horse's versatility is on display while competing across showjumping, dressage, and cross country tests. PA-Bred Mi Padrino, bred by Mr. and Mrs. Charles Cuprill, finished 7th overall to be honored on finale day. But leading them all was Sapphire Surprise, a Pennsylvania-bred daughter of PA sire Weigelia bred by Jean Mary Walter. Sapphire Surprise and trainer Cindy Faherty Napravnik won the eventing

preliminaries by 0.084 of a point for an overall score of 250.167. By taking home the top score in eventing, the pair won the Top Pennsylvania-Bred Award that came with a prize of \$5,000.

Honorable mention in the preliminary rounds also goes to PA-Bred Total Futbol, bred by The Elkstone Group LLC, for a top-10 finish in barrel racing.

The finale setup of the Makeover changed this year in that preliminary scores were not factored into the finale score for the first time. Previously, both preliminary scores and final scores were combined to determine the order of finish.

Starting with a fresh slate, eventing was the first on the docket for finale day. Sapphire Surprise and Napravnik ended up taking home fifth place overall. With the field hunters competing shortly thereafter, Downtown Doc Brown

and Freeman managed to bump themselves up a spot to secure third place.

The RRP's Thoroughbred Makeover is always an exciting event to attend and watch, and most importantly it displays the versatility of off-track Thoroughbreds in second careers. Pennsylvania-breds put forth a great showing at this year's event, and we are already looking forward to next year!

## **PHBA, Wanamaker's Team Up for Second Annual PA-Bred Sale**

Wanamaker's is proud to host their second annual Pennsylvania-bred Sale, in conjunction with the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association. The sale will be a mixed sale open to Pennsylvania-bred weanlings, yearlings, and race-horses, in addition to broodmares and broodmare prospects owned by a PHBA member.

"I think the PA-bred online auction hosted by Wanamaker's is just one more added benefit to the Pennsylvania program.", says PHBA Executive Secretary Brian Sanfratello. "It gives some of our breeders the ability to sell their horses without all the costs involved in sending them to a regular sale."

Graduates from the 2021 sale include Simmons, a racing prospect who sold for \$27,500 to Leonard Supchak and has gone on to earn \$30,652 since the sale. This includes a PA-bred allowance victory at Penn National in March. Union Rally, a racing/broodmare prospect from last year's sale, sold for \$3,500 to Marcia Wolfe and has earned a victory and \$13,440 since the sale.

"We had a great response to the PA-bred sale last year and are excited to host it again this year," said co-founder Liza Hendriks.

The entry fee for the Pennsylvania-bred sale will be discounted to \$150 and commission will remain at 5%. There are no commissions on RNAs through Wanamaker's.

Entries for the Pennsylvania-bred sale will close on November 29<sup>th</sup> and the catalogue will be released November 30<sup>th</sup>. Bidding will open on December 4<sup>th</sup> at 8AM ET, and close on Thursday, December 8<sup>th</sup> at 5PM ET. Subsequent listings will close in three-minute increments. # Star Mares Offered at Star-Studded Fall Sales

On the opening day of the mammoth 10-day Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, which begins on Monday, Nov. 7 at 1 p.m., Pennsylvania-bred star power will be on display.

The PA-Bred Horses of the Year of 2018 and 2020, Shamrock Rose and Caravel, respectively, are due to appear in the auction ring the first day. Shamrock Rose, bred for the third time (her first foal is a yearling colt by War Front), is in foal to Curlin; Caravel sells as a racing or broodmare prospect.

And the 2021 PA-Bred Horse of the Year Chub Wagon? She is also headed for the limelight of the select fall sales. Chub Wagon is in Fasig-Tipton Kentucky's The November Sale – “The World's Premier Breeding Stock Event” – on Sunday, Nov. 6. Selling as a broodmare prospect, the daughter of Hey Chub is Hip 275.

Fasig-Tipton hails Chub Wagon as a “lightning fast race mare” who retires as a winner of 12 of 15 career starts. Bred by Joe-Dan Farm and George Chestnut, Chub Wagon earned \$669,400 as she blazed her way through 11 consecutive stakes races, winning eight. Undeclared in the first eight starts of her career, she won eight of nine starts in 2021 to take the title of Horse of the Year, as well as state-bred champion older female and champion female sprinter.

Elizabeth M. Merryman-bred Caravel sold at last

year's Fasig-Tipton's November sale for \$500,000 as a racing or broodmare prospect. This year she has won four of seven starts, all stakes, to date, two of them graded, while earning \$410,983, and makes a return trip to face males in

the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint-G1, two days before the Keeneland sale. The daughter of Mizzen Mast has won 11 of her 19 career starts while earning \$811,152.

Shamrock Rose captured the 2018 Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint-G1 on her way to earning \$968,962 from 13

starts and being named the Eclipse Award Champion Female Sprinter. The last time the daughter of First Dude, bred by Best A Luck Farm LLC, walked through the auction ring was in 2019 at the Fasig-Tipton November sale as a broodmare prospect – she walked out having sold for \$2.5 million.

Grade 1-winning sprinter Dame Dorothy, now an established broodmare, will also be offered the first day of Keeneland. Her previous appearance in the sale was in 2019 as a \$3.1 million RNA. The foal she was carrying, a colt by Uncle Mo, was sold in 2021 by breeder Bobby Flay for \$1.6 million at Saratoga. She's currently in foal to Curlin, the sire of her first foal, graded stakes winner Spice Is Nice.

Other stakes-winning PA-Bred fillies found in the Keeneland catalog are graded winners Emotional Kitten and Miss Behaviour as well as Deesadiva, Disco Chick, Firsthand Report, Kaylasaurus, Please Flatter Me and Valued Strike. ■

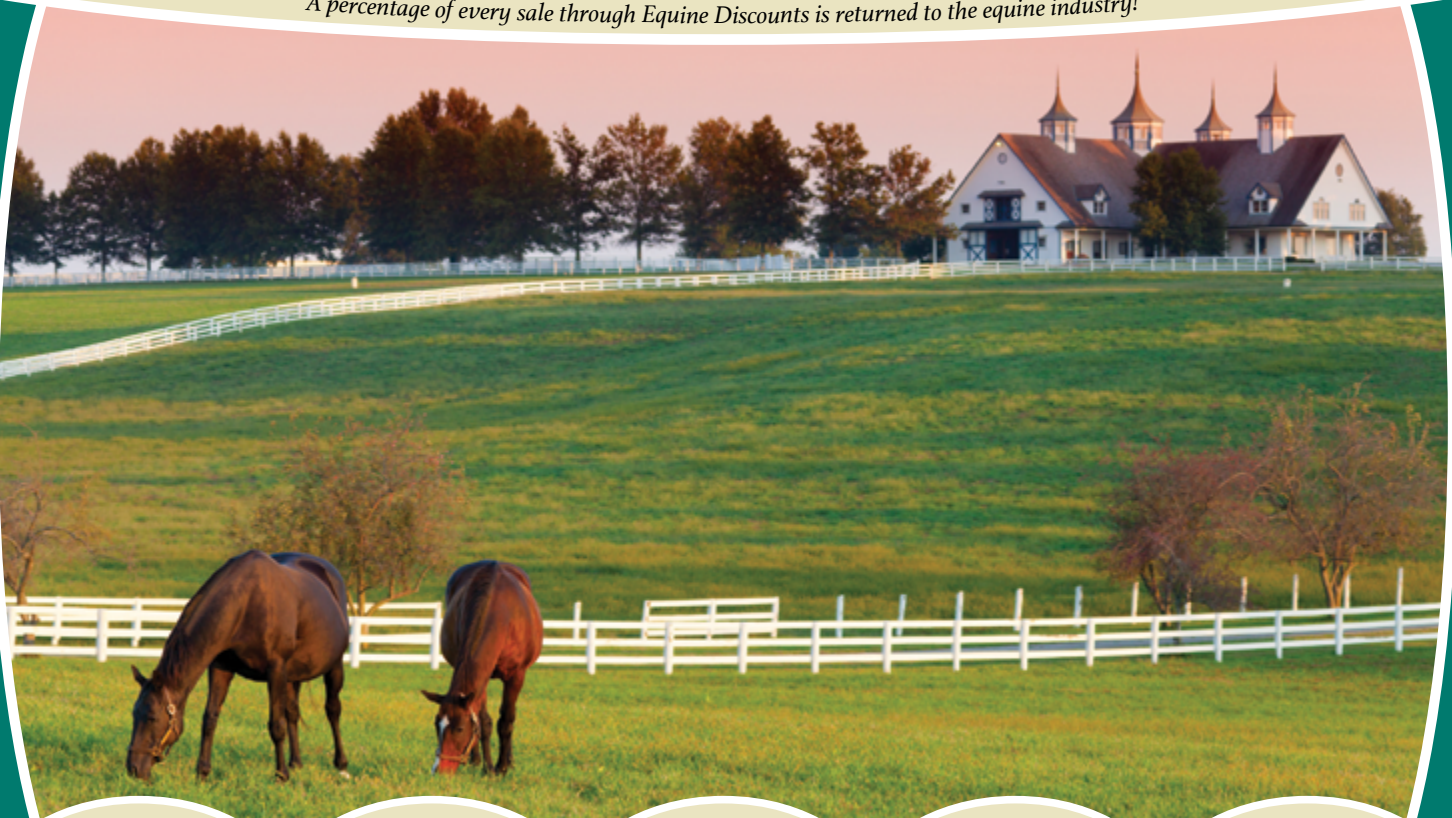

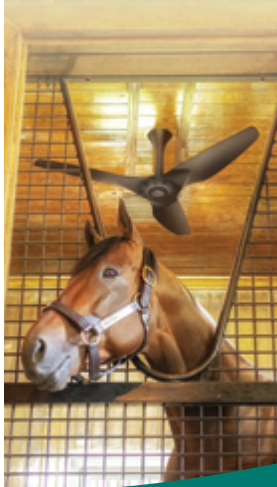

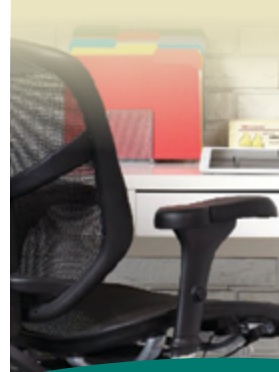

As her 5-year-old campaign winds down, Caravel is on a whirlwind schedule. In October, trainer Brad Cox set her up at Keeneland, site for this year's Breeders' Cup. After two works over the Keeneland main track, she made her seventh start of the year on Oct. 16 on the track's turf course. Going five and a half furlongs in the Grade 3 Franklin Stakes, with a \$143,375 winner's share of the \$250,000 purse, she had the perfect trip, stalking in third-place in the 11-horse field before making her bid in the final furlong and bursting clear to win by nearly two lengths. Her final time was 1:02.59.

"Right from the start, she took me everywhere we needed to go," rider Tyler Gaffalione said after the victory. "The mare ran a great race."

Owned by Qatar Racing, Marc Detampel and Madaket Stables, the gray daughter of Mizzen Mast pushed her earnings to \$811,152 from 19 starts after getting her 11th career win.

The Pennsylvania-bred Horse of the Year of 2020 when campaigned by her breeder Lizzie Merryman, Caravel is the first foal out of Merryman's 2021 Pennsylvania Broodmare of the Year Zeezee Zoomzoom (by Congrats). The mare is also dam of 2022 stakes winner Witty and one other winner from four foals to race.

Caravel's first week of November is going to be extremely hectic as she's been entered in the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint-G1 against males on Nov. 5, and two days later heads to the Keeneland sales ring as a racing or broodmare prospect. She sold at last year's Fasig-Tipton November sale for \$500,000. This year alone she's earned \$410,983 in seven starts. ■

Fortheluvofbourbon shines on special days. After taking the Banjo Picker Sprint Stakes on the PA Day at the Races card in August for Daniel Ryan's Smart Angle LLP, trainer Michael V. Pino sent him out six weeks later in the final sprint race of the 2022 MATCH Series, the Liberty Bell Stakes at Parx, against open company. It was his only start in the series, thus he wasn't eligible for a series bonus (horses must participate in at least three races), but he dominated the \$100,000 stakes as the even-money favorite, leading throughout the six and a half furlongs (in 1:16.88) and taking home \$56,400 for the win. Among those he beat was the 2022 MATCH sprint division champion, Beren, who finished nearly nine lengths back in fourth.

It was another festive day when the 5-year-old son of Bourbon Courage reappeared less than three weeks later

on Oct. 22 in the Maryland Million Sprint at Laurel. Facing nine others, he went off the overwhelming 1-2 choice while carrying 126 pounds, six more than the majority of the field.

Tracking in third off quick fractions of :22.57, :45.87 and :58.18, he was all business in the stretch as he kicked clear to win by a length and a half in a final time of 1:10.96, scoring a \$55,000 paycheck. The Maryland Million victory extended his win streak to six, which started in April in the Page McKenney Handicap at Parx.

Since being claimed for \$50,000 at Churchill Downs in May 2020 by Ryan and Pino in his fifth career start, the bay gelding has started 18 times, finishing third or better in 15. He rarely leaves Parx – the Laurel start was his first outside Pennsylvania since last year's Maryland Million effort (in which he was sixth) – 10 of his 11 wins since the claim have been at his home base and include last year's Banjo Picker Sprint. With his most recent wins, he pushed his career mark to 23-12-1-3, for earnings of \$573,120.

Bred by Hidden Acres 4-D Farm, Fortheluvofbourbon is the first of two foals of racing age for Nosubstituteforluv (by Not For Love), from the family of stakes winner Love Who (by Not For Love). His Pennsylvania-bred half-sister Gateway Love (by Uncle Lino) placed in both her starts at 3 in 2021. ■

The filly who hit a milestone when she recorded the 100th win for her sire Uptowncharlybrown in June, added another highlight to his resume by getting her first stakes win in the Roamin Rachel Stakes at Parx on Oct. 3.

Facing a field that included multiple stakes winners Chub Wagon and Fille d'Esprit, Tee N Jay Stable's 4-year-old filly Oxana shot to the front in the six and a half-furlong stakes run over a sloppy track, posted fractions of :22.73, :45.97 and 1:11.35, and held sway in the stretch. She passed the line a half-length better than Dr B as she stopped the clock in 1:17.93. Last year's PA-Bred Horse of the Year Chub Wagon was eased in the race that brought her illustrious career to a close.

Oxana has been a model of consistency since June, finishing in the top three in all six of her starts, five of them stakes. She came tantalizingly close to getting her first stakes score in September when setting the pace in the Skipat at Laurel before being edged at the wire, finishing

second by a neck. She ran third three times this year – in the Regret Stakes at Monmouth Park in July, the Dr. Teresa Garofalo Memorial on PA Day at the Races at Parx in August, and most recently the Pumpkin Pie on Oct. 29 at the Belmont at Aqueduct meet. Trained by Tim Hills, the filly has made 15 starts over two seasons, for a record of five wins, a second and three thirds, while earning \$279,210.

Oxana burst on the scene last year at 3 when in her second career start she drew off to an 18-length maiden win at Parx. Her next start was also visually impressive when taking a Parx allowance by 10 1/4 lengths. Those wins prompted her connections to try stakes company, and she made her first stakes appearance in Saratoga's Grade 2 Prioress. She finished a respectable fourth, only three and a half lengths behind winner Cilla.

Bred by Uptowncharlybrown Stud LLC, the dark bay filly sold as a 2-year-old at the 2020 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic May sale for \$65,000 to Thomas Swales IV. She is the first foal out of Its My Town, a winning daughter of Cowtown Cat who has been bred exclusively to Uptowncharlybrown, producing four foals. The mare has 3-year-old gelding It's Rob's Town, currently in training but having yet to start; a 2-year-old filly, Confirmed Star, second in her only start at Penn National behind eventual stakes winner Midnight Parade; and a colt born in April this year now named Cool Million. ■

### **Won - BUY LAND AND SEE**

Buy Land and See has been perfect in stakes races this year, as he added his third victory from as many efforts when taking the \$100,000 M.P. Ballezzi Appreciation Mile Stakes at Parx on Oct. 18.

The race wasn't the prettiest, as he had to survive a stewards inquiry and jockey objection, but Joseph Imbesi's 5-year-old gray homebred, who crossed the line one and a quarter lengths clear, kept the win.

The trouble began as the field headed into the first turn and Buy Land and See ducked in, causing a bit of crowding. Mychel Sanchez got him straightened out as they raced down the backstretch in third, but they had to steady as they headed into the far turn.

The final part of the race was the easiest. By the time they reached the stretch, Buy Land and See had a clear lead and maintained it as he crossed the wire in 1:38.38 for the one mile over a fast track.

The Guadalupe Preciado trainee came into the race off a win in the \$200,000 Alphabet Soup Handicap on the turf at Parx in September. His only other win of the year in seven starts came in the With Anticipation in June at Penn National over the turf. In four starts in New York earlier this year, he finished second three times.

A stakes winner at 2 when taking Belmont Park's Awad Stakes at a mile on the turf, and stakes-placed at 3, Buy Land and See upped his career earnings to \$444,270.

By Cairo Prince out of Maria's Mon's unraced daughter Twiggles, Buy Land and See is a half-brother to Imbesi's multiple stakes-winning, multiple graded stakes-placed homebred Sweet Bye and Bye (by Sky Mesa), an earner of \$508,560, with eight wins, four seconds and four thirds from 21 starts.

Five of Twiggles' six foals to race are earners of six figures – combined they have amassed over \$1.4 million. Her last reported foal is Damanda, a 3-year-old Pennsylvania-bred daughter of Liam's Map who has raced twice this year, but has yet to hit the board. ■

So Beren's 2022 campaign may not quite compare to 2021, when he won seven times (five stakes) and placed twice in 12 starts, earned nearly \$475,000, and was named PA-Bred champion 3-Year-Old Male and Male Sprinter. But there is plenty to be proud of.

In half the number of starts this year, Beren has been first or second five times while earning \$207,090. Racing exclusively in stakes, the 4-year-old son of WynOaks Farm sire Weigelia recorded his second win of the year in the \$100,000 Jump Start for PA-Breds and PA-Sired runners on Oct. 18, leading throughout and scoring as the lukewarm 1.70-1 favorite in the field of seven. He completed seven furlongs in 1:22.83, earning a 96 Beyer Speed Figure.

Susan Quick and Christopher Feifarek's homebred came

in fresh off a MATCH Series championship in the 3-Year-Old & Up, Sprint – Dirt Division. Beren raced three times in the series, recording a first (in the Frank J. De Francis Memorial Dash at Laurel in July), a second (Penn National's Chocolate Town in June) and the final leg at Parx in the Liberty Bell in October (in which he finished fourth). It gave him enough points, and starts, to earn the title.

He kicked off his campaign with a second, by a neck to nemesis Fortheluvofbourbon, in the Page McKenney Handicap in April, and was second again to Fortheluvofbourbon in the Banjo Picker Sprint in August.

Trained by Robert E. 'Butch' Reid Jr., Beren has made 21 starts from September 2020 through October 2022, won nine times, been second in six others, earning \$691,060. He's raced solely in stakes (15 times) since April 2021.

Representing four generations of homebreds campaigned by Quick and her late husband Steven, Beren is the first stakes winner from seven starters for his dam, millionaire mare Silmaril (by Diamond). A multiple graded stakes winner who won 16 times, including a dozen stakes, Silmaril descends from the Quicks' graded stakes winner Kattegat's Pride (Beren's third dam), who won a total of 10 stakes.

Smooth B, who finished third in the Jump Start, is from the same family – his dam Katarica Disco is out of Legal Kat (by Caveat), a half-sister to Silmaril.

Silmaril, now 21, produced a full brother to Beren in March 2021, and returned to Weigelia this year. ■

Joseph Imbesi's homebred 2-year-old filly Flor de Sombra galloped home a two-length winner in her Presque Isle debut when taking the \$100,000 Finest City Stakes on Oct. 24. It was her third win in four starts.

Sent off the favorite in the seven-horse field, the

Guadalupe Preciado trainee bided her time early, grabbed the lead around the turn and drew clear as she completed six furlongs in 1:10.35.

The filly dominated in her debut at Parx Racing in July, winning by nearly eight lengths, and scored just as easily in the Miss Blue Tye Dye Stakes on the PA Day at the Races card in August. Tested longer, at six and a half furlongs in Parx's Imply Stakes on Sept. 24, she faded late and finished third after posting fast early fractions.

The daughter of former Pennsylvania sire Social Inclusion relished the drop back to six furlongs, and with the win boosted her earnings to \$173,000.

Flor de Sombra is the second foal out of Imbesi homebred On a Star, a Pennsylvania-bred earner of \$138,414 by Talent Search.

The first foal out of Twiggles (by Maria's Mon), On a Star is a half-sister to Imbesi-bred stakes winners Sweet Bye and Bye, and Buy Land and See, the latter winner of the M.P. Ballezzi Appreciation Mile Stakes on Oct. 18. ■

Joe Imbesi 2-year-old homebred Gordian Knot remained undefeated in three starts with a dominating four and a quarter-length score in the \$100,000 Mark McDermott Stakes at Presque Isle Downs on Oct. 25.

A stablemate of Flor de Sombra, winner of the \$100,000 Finest City Stakes at Presque Isle the day before, Gordian Knot went off the 2-5 favorite in the field of 10. Bumped at the start, he was about five lengths off the early lead,

went after the early pacesetter heading into the stretch, and proved it was no contest from there as he completed six furlongs in 1:09.84.

Winner of his debut in August by a dazzling seven lengths on the Pennsylvania Day at the Races undercard, he returned to take the Prince Lucky Stakes in September by two lengths. He's earned \$223,800 to date.

Trained by Guadalupe Preciado, Gordian Knot is the second foal for Mia, a winning daughter of Put It Back. Imbesi has bred Mia solely to Social Inclusion, a stallion he owns and now stands at Briardale Farm in Florida. Social Inclusion stood at Brok's Diamond B Farm in Mohrsville for three seasons, starting in 2019, after standing his first two years in Florida.

Social Inclusion is the sire of three juvenile stakes winners in his first Pennsylvania-sired crop, the others being fillies Flor de Sombra and Titoschangedmyluck, the latter winner of the Keswick Stakes at Colonial Downs in August. ■

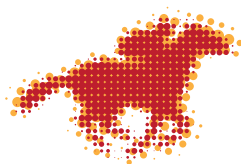
