# LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY

The 2022 Breeders' Cup could not have gone better for Pennsylvania. Not only did the Elizabeth Merryman-bred Caravel win the Turf Sprint against boys but she was the only non-Kentucky and non-European-bred horse to win any Breeders' Cup race. Caravel joined the ranks of other recent PA-Bred greats like Shamrock Rose and Finest City. Congrats to all her connections!!

Our premier 2yo races of 2022 were run in November. The \$200,000 Shamrock Rose for fillies was won by the Joe Imbesi-bred Flor de Sombra. Her five races in 2022 earned her \$320,000. The \$200,000 Nursery for 2yos was won by the Pewter Stable-bred Winning Time. His two race season saw him earn \$162,000. Wow!! I can't think of any other state in which a breeder and/or owner can recoup their investment more quickly. With ten 2yo Stakes scheduled for 2023 along with the increase in the owner bonus at Penn to 30% and the Maiden Special Weight purse increase at PARX for PA-Breds to \$50,000, you can't breed and race anywhere else!

In 2023 the PA-Bred PA-Sired 2yo Series will be expanded and run in three legs, SIX STAKES, at 5 1/2 furlongs for \$100,000, 6 1/2 furlongs for \$150,000, and a flat mile for \$200,000. Each leg will consist of a 2yo race and a 2yo filly race. Don't forget about the \$50,000 trainer bonus for the top three point-earning horses. Nomination forms for the 2023 series are only \$200 if paid by Dec. 31 of the participants yearling year. You can go to [pabred.com](http://pabred.com) under 'Featured' and print the nomination form.

Broodmares that were not in the state by Dec. 1, 2022, or within 14 days of a public sale (within 60 days of a sale outside the U.S.) must be bred back to a PA-Sire. The new 2023 Stallion & Boarding Farm Directory is now available online at [pabred.com](http://pabred.com). We ask that you submit all broodmare domicile forms online. The new form is available for use by going to [pabred.com](http://pabred.com) under forms. As usual, please contact our office with any questions you may have. Pennsylvania is the only place to Breed & Race and remember, you ain't seen nothing yet! Go PA!!

# Caravel: From Coatesville to Keeneland

Go for Wand. Tikkanen. Alphabet Soup. Finest City. Shamrock Rose. Caravel.

The elusive club grew by one in a rather improbable way on the first Saturday of November as a little gray mare streaked down the Keeneland lawn in front of 50,000 roaring voices.

In a division so devoid with Grade 1 opportunities, the title of Grade 1-winning turf sprinter does not come easy. Now Caravel is exactly that, and it's still not her greatest title.

Born on an unusually warm winter day on March 1, 2017, in Oxford, Pa., Caravel was subsequently raised on breeder Elizabeth Merryman's farm in Coatesville. She's the first foal out

of her dam Zeezee Zoomzoom, a daughter of Congrats out of the two-time stakes-winning Zee Zee. Merryman had opted to breed Zeezee Zoomzoom to Juddmonte Farm's Mizzen Mast, who had established a reputation for producing fantastic turf fillies such as Breeders' Cup victresses Flotilla (Fr) and Mizdirection. Zeezee Zoomzoom produced a filly, the only foal Merryman bred that year.

Caravel was raised, broken, and trained by Merryman, debuting in June of her 3-year-old season with her as trainer, owner and breeder. Ignored at 28-1 in the Penn National maiden

event, Caravel broke dead last and spotted the leader 11 lengths down the backstretch before picking them up and mowing them down for a last-to-first 1¼-length debut victory.

The filly proved her winning effort wasn't a fluke with a gate-to-wire allowance score the following month before heading to the western part of the state to pick up her first stakes victory in the Lady Erie Stakes at Presque Isle. A two-turn experiment on the October Preakness undercard resulted in her first loss, a third-place finish, but Caravel quickly rebounded with another Presque Isle victory in the Malvern Rose Stakes for Pennsylvania-breds at month's end.

After failing to meet reserve in that month's Wanamaker's digital sale, an online auction company created by Merryman's daughter Liza Hendriks, the gray filly stayed put for the winter before beginning to embark on her 4-year-old season.

Resurfacing the following April at Belmont Park, Caravel ran a respectful third off the long layoff in the License Fee Stakes. She proceeded to fire off three consecutive stakes victories: overcoming trouble to burst between horses and get her nose on the line first in a three-horse photo in The Very One Stakes at Pimlico, blitzing five furlongs in a staggering 54.97 seconds over the Monmouth lawn in the Goldwood, and finally culminating with both her and Merryman's first graded stakes victory in the Grade 3 Caress Stakes at Saratoga Racecourse.

By this point, people had started to pay attention to the little gray filly from PA, and celebrity chef Bobby Flay bought in for 75%. While Merryman still retained the remaining 25%, Caravel was moved to the barn of trainer Graham Motion, Merryman's barn neighbor at Fair Hill.

Facing tougher company against males the rest of the year, the filly didn't quite return to where she had been, finishing third as the odds-on favorite in the Grade 1 Highlander at Woodbine before posting her first off-the-board finish over an off track in the Grade 3 Turf Monster at Parx. Despite the off form, connections still took a crack at that year's Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint, shipping the filly out west to Del Mar in Southern California. Unfortunately, it was not to be as Caravel trailed in 12th and last, 9½ lengths behind the victorious Golden Pal.

Entered in the Fasig-Tipton November Sale only days later, Caravel went under the hammer for \$500,000 to bloodstock

agent Fergus Galvin. Galvin had purchased the filly on behalf of the ownership group of Qatar Racing, Madaket Stables and Marc Detampel, and she was transferred to the barn of two-time Eclipse Award-winning trainer Brad Cox.

Rested and refreshed over the winter in Kentucky, Caravel made her first start for her new connections in the Queen Stakes at Turfway Park a winning one with an easy 3½-length score. She took another crack at running with the boys in the Grade 2 Twin Spires Turf Sprint on the Kentucky Oaks undercard and checked in a respectable sixth while beaten only 3¼ lengths.

Returning to company against fillies and mares, Caravel collected her second graded score in the Grade 3 Intercontinental at Belmont Park before attempting to defend her Caress Stakes title. Breaking from the rail as the favorite in the Caress, Caravel was in tight down inside and eventually backed up to check in last. She quickly rebounded in the following month's Smart N Fancy Stakes, turning back all late challengers despite sitting

just off the wicked early pace.

After a disappointing Pennsylvania homecoming in the Grade 2 Presque Isle Downs Master Stakes, checking in fourth over a track that had been unkind to speed, Caravel settled into Keeneland for the fall meet and another potential crack at the Breeders' Cup. She made her audition for the World Championships in the Grade 3 Franklin Stakes over the same course and distance as that year's Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint. Caravel made short work of the field, waltzing home a  $1\frac{3}{4}$ -length winner with her ears pricked.

With that year's Breeders' Cup only 20 days following the Franklin, Caravel would be asked to complete a rather swift turnaround into the World Championships, but her connections felt that she had earned herself another shot at the Turf Sprint.

Selected into the body of the field during the pre-entry stage, the mare drew beautifully with post position 10 in the full field of 14.

Installed at 20-1 on the morning line, the 2022 rendition of the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint was no easy billing. Chief amongst her competitors was defending champion Golden Pal. Keeneland was home base for the two-time Breeders' Cup champion, and he had never lost on American turf. A frontrunning speedball, he had been the undisputed king of North American turf sprints for the past two seasons, largely doing so uncontested.

Golden Pal aside, the Europeans had brought over arguably their deepest contingent in the history of the race. Leading the charge was Highfield Princess (Fr), the soon-to-be crowned European champion sprinter who had reeled off three consecutive Group 1 victories in France, England, and Ireland. Also making the trip was the Charlie Appleby-trained pair of Creative Force (Ire) and Naval Crown (GB), the 1-2 finishers in this year's Group 1 Platinum Jubilee at Royal Ascot, as well as Group 1 winner Emaraty Ana (GB).

All throughout the week leading up to the Breeders' Cup, on track commentary made note of how fantastic Caravel looked during morning training. On the muscle and kicking her heels up, the mare seemingly looked the best she ever had despite her recent run in the Franklin.

Race day arrived with brutal winds whipping through Keeneland. On the first day of the World Championships the day prior, Europeans had put on a masterclass to sweep all four turf events on the card. The Turf Sprint was the first grass race on the docket for the Saturday championship slate, and the betting public made clear they expected Golden Pal to put an end to the European demolition.

The defending champ was holding steady as a near even-money favorite, with Highfield Princess and Creative Force in pursuit at 3-1 and 7-1 respectively. Not many people noticed Caravel, whose odds were flirting with the 50-1 threshold. Despite this, the gray mare was raring to go, keeping her handlers on their toes as she bullied her way around the windy Keeneland paddock. As the field of 14 paraded out to the track and headed towards the starting gate on the Keeneland backstretch, Caravel's odds had settled in at a hefty 42-1.

When the gates sprung, it was almost as though a collective gasp could be heard from the crowd. Golden Pal had broken last.

With jockey Tyler Gaffalione aboard, Caravel was hustled to the front of the pack in the absence of the heavy favorite. Her rivals allowed the mare to post a length advantage as she ticked them through a :21.91 opening quarter. Too easy.

As the field banked into the turn, Caravel's advantage was cut in half by fellow longshots Arrest Me Red and Artemus Citylimits. Golden Pal had tried to catch up in vain, never reaching any closer than 2 lengths behind the frontrunner and seemed to be running in place when crunch time began. Gaffalione and the gray mare had brushed off her first batch of challengers through a :44.25 half mile as the Europeans began to rev their engines turning into the stretch. But Caravel was still humming along.

Straightening out, Caravel kicked on again as the pack closed in. Highfield Princess was laying it down to her outside as Creative Force began to uncork a massive rally down the center of the track. Emaraty Ana dove down into the narrow opening left between the rail and the mare, and the newfound challenge seemed to spark another gear within Caravel. Creative Force was still flying with a full head of steam down the outside as Emaraty Ana slowly inched closer with each passing stride along the rail, but they were all too late. Caravel streaked past the finish line to post the biggest upset in the history of the race.

The \$87.78 win payoff was by far the highest of this year's Breeders' Cup, the highest ever seen in the Turf Sprint, and one of the highest in the 39-year history of the World Championships. Finishing dead last the year before, Caravel had completed the ultimate comeback by fully reversing her result in 2022.

Caravel had held Emaraty Ana off by a half-length, with Creative Force a neck back in third and Highfield Princess another length back in fourth. Golden Pal had faded to 10th.

Caravel became the sixth Pennsylvania-bred to win a Breeders' Cup World Championship race. Over the remainder of the day, European horses swept the final three turf contests. Not only was she the only non-European horse to win a grass race, but she was also the only American-based winner not bred in Kentucky.

The mare had been set to sell in the Keeneland November Sale two days later, but Sheikh Hamdan of Qatar Racing couldn't

bear to see her go through the ring and pulled her the morning of. The ownership group decided that Caravel will return in 2023 for her 6-year-old campaign. With her sights set on an overseas foray to Royal Ascot, her main goal is to hopefully emulate Mizdirection, another gray daughter of Mizzen Mast who posted back-to-back victories in the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint.

The victory pushed Caravel's earnings far past the million-dollar mark, currently standing at \$1,331,152. It was her 12th win and 10th stakes score in 20 career starts.

As the little gray mare returned to the winner's circle that day, applause rained down from the oversized crowd and mingled with the howling wind. Here in the heart of horse country, she was a long way from her first home in Coatesville, where she was once the lone foal from Lizzie Merryman's crop. Draped in a blanket of gold and purple petals that signifies one of horse racing's greatest achievements, Caravel's name will forever be etched in racing lore as Breeders' Cup champion. ■

# Keithsendshelloooo

## handsomely rewards with Pennsylvania-Bred and Sire incentives before winning a race

It really does pay to have a Pennsylvania-Bred.

Uptowncharlybrown Stud LLC founder Bob Hutt said, "There is no other state breeding program that comes close."

The PA-Bred program has so many incentives to repay your investment of breeding a horse in the Commonwealth without even winning a race. This was certainly the case for Keithsendshelloooo, who was named after Parx Racing's distinguished long-time track announcer Keith Jones. Keith stays in close contact on how his namesake is doing with weekly texts to Hutt.

The 2-year-old bay PA-Bred gelding has handsomely profited his owners by banking \$104,000 in earnings and breeder bonuses even before breaking his maiden, but that was just the beginning.

Keithsendshelloooo is by Pennsylvania sire Uptowncharlybrown out of Be Bop a Lula, which makes the 2-year-old eligible to receive the PA-Bred and PA-Sired awards. Trainer Ed Coletti Jr. remarked on his consistent charge, "There was always something about him - his personality really stands out and he is the first of the 'Charlies' that doesn't have a quirk in their running style. He can be placed anywhere and likes to be close in the race. He's just competitive.

"He loves to buck and play in the morning but exercise rider Joanne McDade Flores really gets along with him. She drops her hands and lets him do his thing during morning training."

The big strapping bay gelding made his first start at Parx Racing in late April in the track's first 2-year-old race, going two furlongs. He ran green but very willingly, finishing just two and one quarter lengths behind the winner.

It was easy to see there was plenty of unbridled talent in the young horse and his size indicated stretching out in distance would be to his advantage. The juvenile races generally introduce distance gradually, building a young

horse's stamina and experience. Said Coletti, "Those quarter mile races really helped him get some money in the bank for his partners."

Keithsendshelloooo made a second bid in a two furlong race about a month later, turning in a huge rally after being bothered at the start. Again, he showed his determination to persevere but the distance was more suited for a compact sprinter type, not a big horse who needs time

Hutt broke down how enticing the State Bred program is when winning a Maiden Special Weight at Parx Racing. For example, when a horse runs in a \$50,000 Open Maiden Special Weight, the winner gets 60% of the purse, plus 40% PA Bred bonus equaling \$42,000, plus if you bred the horse there is another 50% rewarded off the top equaling \$63,000.

"It's like winning an overnight stakes race, you are double dipping on the purse," said Hutt. "We have seven million invested in breeding and racing with the main business exclusively here in Pennsylvania."

With a thriving PA Bred program there is also an increase in the Mid-Atlantic sales prices for Pennsylvania Breds, giving trainers a huge incentive to have these horses running at Pennsylvania tracks.

PA-Breds like Keithsendshelloooo show it's possible to share in the state's beneficial PA-Bred and PA-Sired program.

The gelding made his most recent start in the \$200,000 Pennsylvania Nursery Stakes at Parx Racing for PA Breds going 7 furlongs on Nov. 29. He finished fifth of 11, adding \$7,040 to his career earnings for a total of \$111,662 in nine starts. We look forward to much more from this talented PA-Bred. ■

and distance to get rolling.

Keithsendshelloooo hit the board seven consecutive times before getting a victory at Penn National on Oct. 28 under a beautiful fall sky in what Coletti called a "confidence builder" with regular jockey Anthony Nunez in the saddle. They honored his namesake Keith Jones with a beautiful plaque to mark the victory.

In his first eight starts he recorded a win, three seconds and four thirds. Two of those second place finishes came in the \$100,000 Whistle Pig Stakes and \$200,000 Prince Lucky Stakes, both at Parx Racing for PA Bred and PA Sired horses, earning him black type. Keithsendshelloooo would reward his partners Uptowncharlybrown Stud with close to \$182,000 between track earnings and breeder incentives.

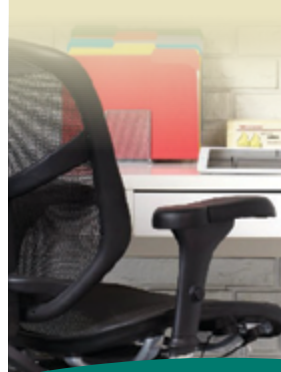

One of the biggest stories to come out of the 2022 Breeders' Cup was the exhilarating 1:01.79 it took Caravel to go from a 43-1 longshot to Breeders' Cup champion after leading gate-to-wire in the \$1 million Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint-G1. In recording her first Grade 1 win, the 5-year-old daughter of Mizzen Mast bred by PHBA board member Lizzie Merryman, joined an exclusive group of PA-Breds, as she also became a millionaire.

Caravel will most certainly add to her championship total after being named 2020 Pennsylvania-bred Horse of the Year

and champion 3-year-old filly and 2021 champion turf female. And her owners Qatar Racing, Marc Detampel and Madaket Stables are going to keep her in training for 2023, with sights once again set on the Breeders' Cup.

With career earnings of \$1,331,152 from 20 starts, Caravel ranks 17th among all-time PA-Bred earners, just behind two-time Eclipse Award-winning Breeders' Cup winner Go for Wand (with \$1,373,338). A total of 32 PA-Breds have cracked the millionaire club. ■

The 3-year-old filly Miss You Ella had been knocking on the door all year looking for her first stakes win. The daughter of Declaration of War achieved success when hitting the wire in the Cellars Shiraz Stakes at Gulfstream Park on Nov. 4 in her eighth start of the year.

Campaigned her entire 10-race career for owners Wonder Stables, Madaket Stables LLC and Golconda Stable, Miss You Ella went off the 2.30-1 favorite in the field of nine. She stalked the pace early, took aim at the leaders in the stretch and battled to the wire to score by three-quarters of a length. In recording her third victory, the dark bay pushed her career earnings to \$152,555.

Moved to the barn of trainer Saffie A. Joseph Jr. earlier in the summer, Miss You Ella has run exclusively at Gulfstream Park ever since. She launched her career as a 2-year-old in September 2021 with Chad Brown and made two starts at Belmont Park over the turf before being sent to Florida late last year. In her first start at Gulfstream this past January, Brown sent her out to win a maiden special weight over the all-weather surface, and then brought her back a month later for her stakes debut in the Grade 3 Sweetest Chant Stakes, where she dug in and got up for third over the turf course. She faced Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf-G1 winner Pizza Bianca and graded winners Consumer Spending and Sail By next out in the Memories of Silver Stakes at Aqueduct and finished fourth behind those three before heading back south.

Sticking with the Tapeta surface since July, she has two wins and two seconds from four starts, including a second

in the Miss Gracie Stakes.

Out of Newstouse, by Unbridled's Song, Miss You Ella was bred by Equivine Farm and is a half-sister to three-time stakes winner Newstome. Her second dam is the stakes-winning Storm Cat mare Double Cat; her third dam champion 3-year-old filly Hollywood Wildcat, also the dam of Breeders' Cup Mile-G1 winner War Chant, graded winner Ivan Denisovich (Ire) and stakes winner Ministers Wild Cat.

Newstouse has a PA-Bred yearling Yoshida (Jpn) colt, a 2022 Game Winner filly and was bred back to Vekoma.

Less than two weeks after getting her first stakes win, Miss You Ella was sold at the Keeneland November Horses of Racing Age Sale for \$140,000 to Sheamus Mills Bloodstock. ■

Trainer Butch Reid is more than willing to ship Disco Ebo out of town. The Parx-based 3-year-old filly has made most of her dozen starts in Pennsylvania, but launched her career at Monmouth Park at 2, faced graded company at Gulfstream in her first start at 3, and was back at Monmouth for another stakes test over the summer. But it was a trip to Ohio for the Youngstown Oaks at Mahoning Valley Race Course on Nov. 21 that she made it to a winner's circle other than at Penn National or Parx.

Facing eight others in the \$100,000 Youngstown Oaks, she went off as second choice and was always prominent throughout the six furlongs. Pressing the early pace, she made her run under Irad Ortiz as they entered the stretch and pulled clear to score by a length and a half.

It was the second stakes win of her career - she captured the \$200,000 Shamrock Rose at Penn National in late November 2021.

Disco Ebo is one of nine foals of racing age by Pennsylvania sire Weigelia out of the Disco Rico mare Katarica Disco, and fifth stakes performer. The cross has yielded the earners of nearly \$3 million, with seven of the runners having earned six-figures.

Reid has had many of the filly's siblings in his barn, including 2022 stakes winner Smooth B, an earner of \$714,038; stakes winner and \$423,318-earner Fat Kat; graded stakes-placed Disco Rose, with earnings of \$449,280; and \$206,392-earner Fore Harp, whose most recent win was a Laurel allowance on Nov. 6.

A \$52,000 purchase by LC Racing at the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic yearling sale in 2020, Disco Ebo campaigns for Cash is King LLC and LC Racing LLC. She has earnings of \$307,684, with five wins, two seconds and a third.

Katarica Disco, now 18, delivered a colt by Weigelia in 2021 who sold to LC Racing for \$100,000 at this year's Midlantic yearling sale. The mare doesn't have a foal reported in 2021 and was bred back to Weigelia in 2021. ■

Flor de Sombra proved up to the task in an ambitious juvenile campaign that saw her start five times since late July, face stakes company in four at three different tracks, and become a multiple stakes winner. The most recent win was a spectacular performance in the \$200,000 Shamrock Rose Stakes at Penn National on Nov. 25 in which she drew

away through the stretch to score by nearly five lengths going six furlongs.

Joseph Imbesi's homebred filly went off the slight second choice at 1.60-1 behind Michael Matz-trained Fair Hill shipper Late Frost (at 3-2). The latter led the field through fractions of :21.69 and :45.25 and was joined by Flor de Sombra in the final furlong but proved no match for the winner. Late Frost held on for second in her stakes debut.

After dominating her debut at Parx Racing in July, Flor de Sombra was the 2-5 favorite in Parx's Miss Blue Tye Dye Stakes in August and cruised home by 2 lengths. The odds-on favorite next out in the Imply Stakes, she set the early pace but weakened in the stretch to finish third.

The gray/roan filly rebounded as a two-length winner in the \$100,000 Finest City Stakes in October, her Presque Isle debut. With the win at Penn, she now has earnings of \$320,000.

A daughter of former Pennsylvania sire Social Inclusion, Flor de Sombra is the second foal out of Imbesi homebred On a Star, a Pennsylvania-bred earner of \$138,414 by Talent Search.

On a Star is the first foal out of Twiggles (by Maria's Mon), and is a half-sister to Imbesi-bred stakes winners Sweet Bye and Bye and Buy Land and See, the latter winner of three stakes in 2022. ■

Pewter Stable's homebred colt Winning Time went from unknown at the beginning of November to undefeated stakes winner by the end. The son of Pewter Stable-managed stallion Winchill, who stands at Timber Ridge Farm in Felton, Winning Time burst onto the scene on Nov. 7 in a Parx maiden special weight, flying home an 11-length winner under wraps. That sensational debut prompted trainer Kate DeMasi to take a good look at the \$200,000 Pennsylvania Nursery Stakes at Parx on Nov. 29.

Standing in the chestnut colt's way were two undefeated stakes winners: Joseph Imbesi's two-time stakes winner Gordian Knot, the Nursery's post time favorite at 2.10-1, and Ninetypercentmaddie, the 2.20-1 second-choice. Winning Time was not overlooked, going off as third choice at 2.90-1 in the 11-horse field.

Winning Time battled for the lead from the start with longshot All Eyes On You, going through a first quarter in :22.36 and the half in :45.55. By the time the Pewter Stable runner hit the top of the stretch he had a clear lead, and was kept to his task to the wire, finishing three-quarters of a length in front of 81-1 Veeson. Gordian Knot, who steadied at the start, made a three-wide bid around the far turn, chased the leader down the stretch and finished third, a neck in front of Ninetypercentmaddie.

With the victory, Winning Time boosted his earnings to \$162,000. He is a full brother to Word On a Wing, an earner of \$203,684. The duo are out of the winning Fusaichi

Pegasus mare Merry's Pegasus, bred in partnership by Pewter Stable, who campaigned her through an unusual four-start career. Out of Pewter Stable's multiple stakes winner Merry Princess (a filly by Polish Numbers bred by Lizzie Merryman), Merry's Pegasus made one start at 2 in 2008, broke her maiden at Atlantic City in her first start at 3, faltered in her next start a month later, then reappeared in a Colonial Downs turf sprint more than two years later. She retired after that off-the-board finish and produced foals by Red Giant, Any Given Saturday and Paddy O'Prado before being bred to Tapit's son Winchill in his first year at stud. The resulting foal is Word On a Wing. Merry's Pegasus was then bred to Midshipman and Bayern, but since Winning Time she's gone to Winchill. All five of the mare's foals to race are winners, the two Winchill offspring the richest. She has a current yearling filly named Merrychill and a weanling filly, both foaled in May. ■
