The PA-Bred PA-Sired 2yo Stallion Series is expanding this year and will be run in three legs, SIX STAKES, at 5 1/2 furlongs for \$100,000, 6 1/2 furlongs for \$150,000, and a flat mile for \$200,000. Each leg will consist of a 2yo race and a 2yo filly race. Don't forget about the \$50,000 trainer bonus for the top three point-earning horses. Nominations for the 2023 series are \$500 for 2yos if paid by March 31. You can go to pabred.com under 'Forms' or 'Featured' and print the nomination form.



Broodmares that were not in the state by Dec. 1, 2022, or within 14 days of a public sale (within 60 days of a sale outside the U.S.) must be bred back to a PA-Sire. We ask that you submit all broodmare domicile forms online. The new form is available for use by going to pabred.com under 'Forms' and is now mandatory for registration.

WEIGELIA TOPS PA STALLION AWARD SIRES IN 2022

The last time Jump Start was not the leading sire in Pennsylvania by total stallion awards for a year was 2014. By 2015, with his oldest Pennsylvania-sired runners 4-year-olds, he leaped over Fairbanks on his way to becoming a Pennsylvania legend.

After seven years of Jump Start domination, 2022 marked a major change as Weigelia upended the famed son of A.P. Indy for the top spot. Weigelia's offspring garnered \$186,200.56 in 319 races. Jump Start was less than \$10,000 behind, with his runners making 123 more starts.

Weigelia is an intriguing stallion, especially for breeders looking to race their own foals. He raced until the age of 7 and, while his pedigree is excellent, it took the full support of owners Chip and Barbara Wheeler for his offspring to be born and raced. They were looking for a stallion to stand and breed to their own mares at their WynOaks Farm in Delta, Pa., and Weigelia fit their needs perfectly.

As a racehorse, Weigelia earned \$1,007,708 while capturing eightstakes, wonraces on both turf and dirt, and competed from 51/2 furlongs to one mile. He set two turf course records, 6 furlongs in 1:07 at Belmont Park and 5 furlongs in :55 at Monmouth Park. But his finest win was in the six-furlong Grade 3 Carry Back Stakes at Calder Race Course at 3 when he earned a 108 Beyer Speed Figure. A solid citizen who won races every year from ages 2 to 6, the son of Safely's Mark is a grandson of Eclipse Champion Safely Kept as well as from the female family of the legendary champion and Hall of Famer Davona Dale.

Weigelia's offspring finally hit the track in 2012, but it was the following year when horsemen began to take notice. Isabella **continued on page 6**

Swift (who ultimately raced 81 times with over \$450,000 in earnings) topped his progeny earners that year at \$96,153. His 2-year-old son Barracuda Wayne became his first stakes winner with a victory in Delaware Park's Strike Your Colors Stakes; Chippewawhitechief was his second when taking the Mark McDermott Stakes at Presque Isle Downs. Hitting the board in nine of 13 starts that year was Pink Princess, who eventually retired as a stakes-placed runner of 66 starts, 16 wins and earnings of \$572,135. Interestingly, the latter two horses and Isabella Swift now reside in retirement at WynOaks Farm, where the two fillies are current members of the farm's broodmare band.

"It is rewarding to see recognition for Weigelia," said Barbara Wheeler."He is consistent, for the most part, with putting runners on the ground. His best value is his consistency - good conformation, durable, useful on any surface/distance.

"Due to his own long racing career, he got a late start at stud. Even with his small crops each year he continues to play in the top rankings when you really look at his progeny performance, continued APEX ratings and the like. Everyone wants a racehorse that can run - that's great fun but it's an investment when it comes down to it - and we could all use the return on our investments like this one!"

One of the farm's star broodmares is the dam of Pink Princess, Katarica Disco (by Disco Rico). The match with Weigelia has yielded nine winners from as many starters, and also produced multiple stakes winner Disco Ebo (\$374,164), stakes winner Fat Kat (\$423,318), graded stakes-placed Disco Rose (\$449,280), multiple allowance winner Fore Harp (\$206,392) and allowance winner Disco Deja Vu (\$135,114). But by far their best offspring is multiple stakes winner Smooth B, who has 10 wins from 50 starts. Now 8, he finished a strong second behind Beren in a Parx Racing allowance on Jan. 31, bringing his lifetime earnings to \$732,398.

Another remarkable pairing is with the Private Interview mare Amblin Easy, whose first two foals are six-figure earners and stakes performers Ninetypercentbrynn and Ninetyprcentmaddie. Ninetypercentbrynn, now 5, has an allowance win already in her 2023 debut. She is multiple stakes-placed and has career earnings thus far of \$277,496. Fresh 3-year-old Ninetyprcentmaddie looks to have an even brighter future. The colt was undefeated in his first three starts, including a runaway victory in the Whistle Pig Stakes

at Parx Racing. With that win, Ninetyprcentmaddie finished fourth in the first annual PA-Bred, PA-Sired stakes series for 2-year-olds, earning \$138,480 and \$54,696 in breeder awards. In his first start at 3 he ran second in the open Parx Juvenile Stakes at Parx to boost his career earnings total to \$152,880.

Weigelia's leading earner is Beren, who contributed \$233,990 in 2022, including victories in the Frank J. De Francis Memorial Dash Stakes at Laurel Park and Jump Start Stakes at Parx Racing. Beren has total career earnings of \$770,040, with 10 wins in 24 starts, and eight placings. His best season in 2021 at age 3 when winning seven of 12 starts, five in stakes, and topping \$460,000 in earnings. Beren is out of multiple graded stakes-winning millionaire Silmaril.

At WynOaks Farm where he stands for a private fee, Weigelia is beloved by his owners and farm staff who affectionately call him "Wiggy". He may not be a flashy stallion upon first glance, but he has a regal presence about him.

Longtime farm manager Allison Innella has nothing but praise for the stallion. "Weigelia is a boss... THE boss! He is unwavering in attitude and opinions. He is very active, always alert and likes to go, go, go. He is a professional in the breeding shed.

"I believe he really passes on his heart and true grit to his offspring in their racing as well as their second careers. He is one classy guy. I'm lucky to have the opportunity to work with him."

Weigelia was late to the stallion game simply because he raced successfully for so many years. Now at 22 years old, he finally has the chance to shine again through his offspring.

BRODY'S CAUSE

One of Pennsylvania's newest arrivals, this multiple Grade 1 winner and Grade 1 sire is a son of the great racehorse and stallion Giant's Causeway from the female family of Secretariat and Cure the Blues.

The sire of three crops of racing age through 2022, Brody's Cause ranked in the top 10 nationally on the freshman list in 2020, and among the top 20 on the second and third-crop sires lists the past two years. His runners include daughter Kalypso, winner of Santa Anita's La Brea Stakes-G1 and two additional

stakes, and on the board in nine stakes total (six graded). She earned \$607,638 in 15 starts before selling as a broodmare prospect at last fall's Fasig-Tipton Kentucky November select sale for \$2.1 million to Katsumi Yoshida.

Of Brody's Cause's 10 stakes horses, seven won or placed at 2, including Kalypso and additional graded runners Sittin On Go, third in the Iroquois Stakes-G3; Smiley Sobotka, second in the Kentucky Jockey Club Stakes-G2; and Girther, second in the Grade 2 Best Pal Stakes.

Upon his move to Pennsylvania, Brody's Cause ranked fourth in progeny earnings in the state, with \$2,435,148, and has current lifetime earnings of nearly \$5 million, accrued in less than three years.

Winner of Keeneland's Claiborne Breeders' Futurity-G1 at 2 and the Blue Grass Stakes-G1 at 3, Brody's Cause retired with a record of three wins and a third in eight starts, for earnings of \$1,168,138. He is out of stakes-placed Sweet Breanna, by the Mr. Prospector stallion Sahm; his second dam, graded winner Sweet Roberta, was second in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies-G1.

#8 EASTWOOD cracked the PA Sire 2YO Top Ten List with 3 MSW winners from just 6 starters. A son of top sire Speightstown, EASTWOOD, an \$850,000 Graded Stakes-placed 3YO purchase, was bred to 23 mares last year and is already on pace to more than double that number in 2023.

Capo Kane entered stud after showing tremendous promise when hitting the board in each of his first four starts, two in stakes, in a span of a little over three months, including a six and a quarter-length score in Aqueduct's Jerome on New Year's Day 2021. He followed that with a third in Aqueduct's Withers Stakes-G3. A suspensory ligament injury forced his retirement that spring and he retired with a record of 5-2-1-1 for earnings of \$147,500.

Capo Kane's pedigree meshes the top-two finishers of the 2007 Kentucky Derby-G1 – winner Street Sense and runner-up Hard Spun, sire of his dam Twirl Me.

He is the first foal for Darley-bred Twirl Me, a granddaughter of millionaire Tuzla (Fr). A Grade 1 winner of Del Mar's Ramona Handicap in 1999, Tuzla just missed winning that year's Breeders' Cup Mile-G1. Capo Kane has a pedigree that doubles up on the immensely successful Northern Dancer/Mr. Prospector cross, as it appears under both his sire and dam in the fourthgeneration.

A son of Eclipse Award and Breeders' Cup Sprint-G1 winner and prominent sire Speightstown, Eastwood had his first crop get to the races last year at 2, with six of his 10 named foals starting, three winning – all in maiden special weight company – and two others hitting the board. He ranked in the top 10 among the state's leading sires of juveniles. And there are larger crops to come. He covered 23 mares last year and is already on pace to more than double that number in 2023.

The chestnut stallion has the looks – he was a six-figure sales weanling and, after winning his first two starts as a 3-yearold, he sold for \$800,000 at the Fasig-Tipton summer horses of racing age sale in 2013, the second highest price of the sale. He would go on to win allowance races at Saratoga and Keeneland and finish second in the Grade 3 Los Angeles Stakes at Santa Anita before retiring with earnings of \$265,545, and a record of four wins, two seconds and two thirds in 12 starts.

The first foal out of the Deputy Minister mare Fifth Avenue Ball, who has had seven offspring sell for six figures and is herself is a six-figure yearling, Eastwood is a half-brother to stakes winner Gotham Gala; his second dam is seven-time stakes winner Our Shopping Spree, and the family includes graded winners Irish Warrior and Profit Option.

Standing at Blackstone Farm, Pine Grove, PA Stud fee: \$1,250 LFSN, second mare free for 2023 or 2024.

PAT ON THE BACK

The first foals of graded stakes-winning millionaire Pat On the Back arrived in 2022 to rave reviews. He covered more than 30 mares his first season at stud and has nearly 20 foals reported.

An eight-time stakes winner, Pat On the Back is the richest son of Congrats, one of the nation's top sires, to enter stud after earning \$1,144,545 and recording nine wins in 30 starts, with four seconds and six thirds (all stakes).

A stakes winner each year from 2 to 5, at distances from 6 furlongs to one and one-eighth miles, his victories included Belmont Park's 1-mile Kelso Handicap-G2 in 1:33.97 and the Commentator Stakes in 1:33.43. He won the \$300,000 Empire Classic Handicap at 4 and the \$250,000 Sleepy Hollow at 2, and was 10-times stakes-placed.

Pat On the Back is one of eight winners from 10 starters

for his dam, the Awesome Again mare Accomplished, who also produced stakes-winning stakes producer Sarah Accomplished. His second dam I'm in Celebration (by Copelan) is a winning halfsister to Group 1 winner Little Baby Bear, Flamingo Stakes-G3 winner First American, and stakes winner Dubai Dust. I'm in Celebration is the dam of 10 winners, including stakes winners and graded stakes-placed Nice to Know and Cheers and Tears, as well as the dams of graded winners Beautiful Bets and Charming Tam and Phoenix Gold Cup inner Wiredfortwotwenty.

Standing at Bonner Hill Farms, Littlestown, PA

Stud fee: \$3,500 LFSN, special consideration to approved mares.

PEACE AND JUSTICE

The speedy miler keeps building his sire reputation as he ranked sixth in the state in 2022 by progeny earnings and got his first \$1 million season with only three crops to race. The son of War Front from the legendary family of champion What a Treat and leading sire Be My Guest has sired 63 percent winners from starters, led by his stakes-winning son Like a Saltshaker from his first crop. His runners have average earnings of \$43,638.

His daughter Dontlookbackatall sold for \$150,000 at the 2022 Ocala 2-year-old sales and broke her maiden first-time out at Saratoga, out of the barn of Christophe Clement, for owner West Point Thoroughbreds, Scarlet Oak Racing and Titletown Racing Stables. In her second start she was fourth of 11, beaten less than four lengths, in the Grade 1 Matron, and finished fourth

after a poor start in her only other outing, Aqueduct's Stewart Manor Stakes in November, all on the turf.

Peace and Justice blazed over the turf during his career, winning one-mile allowances at Santa Anita in 1:32.36 and 1:33.27. He also won at a mile over Belmont Park's turf.

Peace and Justice is out of the Smart Strike mare Strike the Sky, dam of seven winners from as many foals, including graded stakes-winning \$513,824-earner Hudson Steele. Her stakesplaced daughter Lauren Byrd is the dam of group winner Hakam (by War Front) and Blue Grass Stakes-G1 runnerup My Man Sam.

Standing at Blackstone Farm, Pine Grove, PA Stud fee: \$5,000 LFSN.

SMARTY JONES

The Pennsylvania great enters his 19th stud season as the state's leading active sire lifetime with nearly 80 stakes horses and more than \$43 million in career progeny earnings. His average earnings per starter in North America is in excess of \$91,000. Runners in 2022 included multiple stakes-placed juvenile Dawgmentality, who hit the board in four of his five starts.

An international champion sire, Smarty Jones is represented by 37 stakes winners lifetime, 13 graded/group winners, such as millionaire and four-time Singapore champion Better Life, Japanese millionaires Keiai Gerbera and Noble Jewelry, and Grade 1-winning sprinter Centralinteligence. And his daughters **continued on page 14**

are the producers of champions and Grade/Group 1 winners, including Win Win.

The 2004 Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner is the only classic winner at stud in the region, and he remains the richest, with career earnings of \$7,613,155 (25th all-time in North America).

Standing at Equistar Training & Breeding, Annville, PA Stud fee: \$3,500 LFSN.

UPTOWNCHARLYBROWN

Coming off the best season of his career, Uptowncharlybrown had six stakes performers and progeny earnings of \$1,680,651 in 2022. His daughter Oxana won or placed in six consecutive stakes, and he ranked as Pennsylvania's top sire of 2-year-olds, with four stakes horses and juvenile progeny earnings nearly double that of the second-ranked stallion.

Uptowncharlybrown has been putting up impressive numbers from the start. In his first three small crops to race, 82 percent of his foals started, and three out of four were winners. His stakes winners are led by \$726,593-earner Wait for It, who added to his stakes tally in 2022; graded stakes winner Dixie Serenade; and stakes-winning brothers Midtowncharlybrown and Midnightcharly, out of the Speightstown mare Torchwood, who combined have earned more than \$1 million.

WARRIOR'S REWARD

The first Pennsylvania-sired crop for Warrior's Reward made its debut in 2022 and delivered. He tied for most juvenile winners by a Pennsylvania sire with six, had \$231,224 in progeny earnings, and was represented by stakes-placed filly Warrior's Ransom.

The Grade 1-winning son of Medaglia d'Oro had nine stakes performers overall for the year, including winner Stowe Angel

And as a broodmare sire he is represented by nine stakes winners, six in 2022 including Champagne Stakes-G1 winner Blazing Sevens.

Warrior's Reward was the fastest 3-year-old colt in his year, recording a 113 Beyer and covering 7 furlongs at Churchill Downs in 1:21.60 while defeating Munnings, Reynaldothewizard and Custom for Carlos. At 4 he captured Aqueduct's Grade 1 Carter, getting the 7 furlongs in 1:21.62.

WICKED STRONG

Pennsylvania's leading sire of 2022 with progeny earnings of nearly \$3.6 million, he also topped the list by number of winners (82) from four crops to race. Nine of his offspring were stakes performers in 2022, led by stakes winner/graded stakesplaced Jilted Bride and Peruvian Grade 2 winner Wicked Crane.

The sire of 20 stakes horses lifetime and the earners of


