PA FILLY IS *Simply Divine*

CAR DEALER ED BUSSINGER GAINS
FIRST STAKES SCORE WITH HOMEBRED
DIVINE INTENTIONS

A decade after purchasing his first Thoroughbreds, Ed Bussinger became a stakes-winning owner and breeder when Divine Intentions cruised to a 3-length victory in the Shamrock Rose Stakes at Parx Racing on Nov. 26. Named for the Pennsylvania-bred Eclipse Award Champion Female Sprinter of 2018, the Shamrock Rose is a 6-furlong test for 2-year-old fillies bred in the Keystone Stakes. Jockey Frankie Pennington wore Bussinger's Carguys Racing red and white silks for trainer J. Tyler Servis.

As is his custom, Bussinger was in attendance for the milestone victory. Relatively new to the Thoroughbred industry, Bussinger is now an active participant with a four-member broodmare band and about 10 racers divided between Tyler and his father John, best known as trainer of Pennsylvania-bred Eclipse Award champion and near-Triple Crown winner Smarty Jones. He vividly recalls making the leap into racing.

Bussinger was having a meeting with an employee who mentioned he had horses with John Servis. He was intrigued.

"After the meeting I told him I wanted to get involved in racing – today," he said. "That was on a Friday June something and the next day we went to the backside at Parx to meet John Servis. It was Belmont Day in 2015."

A 2-year-olds in training sale was happening in Ocala, so John called an associate to find a prospect for Bussinger.

"I ended up buying three," he said. "My wife Karen had said I needed a hobby so I got into horse racing. At that point, I had never even been to a frontside (to watch racing). I just loved the horses (at the barn)."

Bussinger had enough early success to stay in the game and eventually expand into breeding. He had privately purchased the unraced prospect Shyza, who went on to win four of 13 starts for a \$115,295 bankroll in 2019-21. Retained for breeding, she has delivered a steady stream of Pennsylvania-breds. Her first mate was Divining Rod—a Grade 3-winning son of Tapit—and the result was Divine Intentions. In 2024, Shyza gave Bussinger a colt by Grade 1 winner Cupid, also a son of Tapit. In keeping with the theme, Shyza was sent to Grade 2-winning Tapit son Greatest Honour and produced a filly in 2025. Shyza is scheduled to deliver an offspring of stakes winner Honest Mischief (by Into Mischief) in March.

"Now it has become more of a business slash hobby but it is still a hobby," Bussinger said. "This (2025) has been my best year yet."

The hobby portion includes visiting his mares and their state-bred foals at Shirley Lojeski's farm not far from his Quakertown car dealership. (His other dealerships are in Warrington and across the border in New Jersey.)

"Obviously Shirley is a big part of our team," he said. Another recreational portion of his Thoroughbred business happens on both sides of Parx.

"I try to never miss a race," Bussinger said. "My work is only 20 minutes away so I can just jump in the car. That's a nice thing about racing – you know when it is going to start and when it's going to end. Then I hang around a little bit and go right back to work. I used to go to the barn three or four times a week but I haven't been in months. I should get back into going."

Expectations Fulfilled

Tyler Servis was optimistic about Divine Intentions after receiving consistent glowing reviews from Randy Rentz, who handled her early lessons in South Carolina. Servis was not disappointed when the filly arrived at his Parx barn in May.

"Randy was always high on her, so we were excited to have her come up here," Servis said. "My first thoughts when she came was that she is a beautiful filly and well put together. Not the biggest filly but not a pony either. She has some decent size but not a huge strapping filly."

As her training progressed, Divine Intentions continued to show promise as she prepared for her career debut.

"There were high hopes based on what Randy saw in the early stages," Servis said. "And she showed that talent from her first work all the way to her first race."

On Aug. 7, Divine Intentions lived up to expectations and her role as the 7-10 favorite in a maiden special weight at Penn National. First from the gate, she increased her advantage throughout the 5-furlong event and came home 3 3/4 lengths in front in a final time of :59.08.

She returned to action on Oct. 22 in a Parx allowance. Jostled and steadied when the starting gate opened, Divine Intentions settled near the back of the field before checking in fourth. A month later, she showed her grit and capitalized on her Pennsylvania-bred status in the restricted Shamrock Rose.

Trying an off track for the first time, Divine Intentions was outfooted for the early lead but quickly scampered to the front. As the fourth betting choice in the field of seven, the filly cruised on a clear lead before reaching the finish 3 lengths in front in a time of 1:11.60 for 6 furlongs.

She returned on Dec. 30 in the Parx Future Stars Filly Division Stakes against open company and finished second in the seven-horse field while carrying top weight.

Servis believes Divine Intentions displays the signs that indicate superiority.

"The way she goes about her work in the mornings, she does everything with a lot of class and very easy," he said. "In her works she is in the bridle with her ears pricked and she is having fun."

Whatever the future holds on track, the Servis and Bussinger families relish their camaraderie that gets better with every victory.

"Ed is a great owner and we communicate a lot," Servis said. "(Our relationship) is really more like a friendship than a business."

When Bussinger inadvertently delved in the Thoroughbred world, he could not have foreseen the special people he would encounter.

"I don't know if I would love racing so much if it wasn't for John and Tyler," he said.

Shamrock Rose Namesake

The Shamrock Rose Stakes for 2-year-old state-bred fillies at Parx Racing is named for the 2018 Pennsylvania-bred Eclipse Award Champion Female Sprinter. Bred by Best A Luck Farm LLC and sold as a 2-year-old to Conrad Farms for \$120,000 at the 2017 Ocala April sale, she was a stakes winner in her 2-year-old debut in Woodbine's Ontario Debutante five months later. In her lone start in her home state, Shamrock Rose won the Malvern Rose Stakes for state-breds at Presque Isle Downs during her championship season. Later that year she became the fifth of six Breeders' Cup winners born in the Keystone Stake when she captured the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint-G at Churchill Downs. The other Breeders' Cup winners are Hall of Famer Go for Wand, champion Finest City, Alphabet Soup, Caravel and Tikkane.

Trained throughout by Mark Casse, Shamrock Rose closed her career with a 13-5-2-2 record and \$968,962 in earnings. In 2019, she brought \$2.5-million at Fasig-Tipton's November sale as a broodmare prospect. The daughter of First Dude sold again, for \$3 million in foal to Curlin, at the 2022 Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. Her first foal (born in 2021) is \$119,887-earner Frontline Warrior. Her 2023 Curlin foal is an unraced colt named We Move. She delivered a Flightline colt in 2024 in Japan and was bred back to Japanese superstar Equinox. ■

WHY BREEDING IN PENNSYLVANIA IS AN EASY DECISION

For more than 75 years, the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association (PHBA) has worked to strengthen the state's Thoroughbred industry. Founded in 1948 as a not-for-profit organization, the PHBA was built on the idea that a strong breeding program creates opportunity across every level of the sport. Today, that philosophy is reflected in one of the most robust and rewarding state-bred incentive programs in the country, one rooted in fertile ground that has long produced elite runners on racing's biggest stages.

Pennsylvania's breeding legacy includes Kentucky Derby winners Smarty Jones and Lil E. Tee, Breeders' Cup champions Go for Wand, Tikkannen, Alphabet Soup, Finest City, Shamrock Rose and Caravel, legendary sires Storm Cat, Danzig and Hard Spun, and Kentucky Oaks heroines Princess of Sylmar and Plum Pretty. That success has not been limited to national spotlights alone. Several PA-Breds have reached millionaire status competing largely, or even entirely, at home, thanks in large part to the strength of the state-bred stakes program. Just a few of those runners include Smooth B, Morning Matcha and Page McKenney.

Since the introduction of slots revenue in 2006, distributions from the Pennsylvania Breeding Fund have more than quadrupled. Over the past 13 years, the fund has paid out an average of more than \$27.5 million annually, fueling an environment where breeders, owners and stallion farms are all positioned to succeed. That funding supports an average of more than 350 restricted races for state-breds each year, where PA-Breds can compete at Parx Racing, Penn National and Presque Isle Downs across approximately 340 days of racing annually.

At the heart of the program is a breeder awards structure designed to reward long-term participation, not just one-time success. Breeders earn awards on all Pennsylvania races through third place, even when they no longer own the horse. A PA-Bred sired by a registered Pennsylvania stallion earns its breeder 40 percent of the purse, while non-PA-sired PA-Breds still generate a meaningful 20 percent. That ongoing earning power has real impact, seven breeders are currently on pace to earn more than \$200,000 in awards this year, with the top two tracking toward totals between \$500,000 and \$1 million.

Owners benefit as well, with bonus money paid directly by the racetracks on top of the purse in non-restricted races. Parx Racing offers owner bonuses of 40 percent, Presque Isle Downs pays 30 percent, and Penn National awards 25 percent, all through third place. In 2025 alone, total owner bonuses are expected to exceed \$5.2 million, further incentivizing owners to race Pennsylvania-Breds locally.

PA-Bred bonuses have the potential to boost a horse's earnings by six figures. In 2024, 2-year-old The Boy's Warrior earned a combined \$225,300 in just four races, thanks to \$64,880 in breeders' awards, \$16,220 in stallion awards and a \$5,400 owner bonus. Meanwhile, this year's current leader is Pachelbel,

a daughter from the 2020 crop of Hoppertunity with more than \$500,000 in career earnings. She has competed solely in Pennsylvania, from claimers and starters to multiple stakes races, over 43 career starts with 11 victories (through Dec. 23, 2025).

The program also rewards stallion owners, reinforcing the value of standing stallions in the Keystone State. Owners of registered Pennsylvania stallions earn 10 percent of the purse share when their PA-Bred, PA-sired runners finish first, second or third in Pennsylvania. For leading stallion farms and breeders, total annual payments from the fund can exceed six figures, underscoring the financial strength of the program from top to bottom.

Over the last three years, the top two breeder and stallion owners have taken turns atop the leaderboard, with combined awards each totaling well over \$2 million. Between the three stallions Warrior's Reward, Uptowncharlybrown and Eastwood, stallion awards alone over that same timeframe exceed \$1.1 million.

Beyond the financial incentives, PA-Breds often receive preferred starter status in overnight races at all three Pennsylvania tracks. Stakes opportunities restricted to PA-Breds are offered regularly throughout the year, with additional races available exclusively to PA-Sired PA-Breds.

Eligibility remains clearly defined while allowing flexibility for breeders operating under different models. A Thoroughbred foal born in Pennsylvania and registered with The Jockey Club may qualify as a PA-Bred based on residency requirements for the dam surrounding conception and foaling, with multiple pathways available. Unlike some states, Pennsylvania does not impose a blanket breed-back requirement, though PA-Breds sired by registered Pennsylvania stallions earn significantly higher awards, making in-state stallions a strategic choice for those seeking to maximize returns.

Taken together, the PHBA's incentive structure reflects a program built for longevity, one that rewards breeders beyond the sales ring, encourages owners to keep horses racing locally, and supports stallion operations year after year. From champions who have captured the sport's biggest prizes to hard-knocking runners who have built exceptional careers right here at home, Pennsylvania continues to show the lasting value of investing in its breeding program. ■





Over a two-month stretch, Cash Is King and LC Racing’s homebred Mailata went from maiden winner to two-time stakes winner and leader of his division. The son of Maximus Mischief added a massive score in the Parx Future Stars Stakes on Dec. 30 at Parx to his daylight victory in the Pennsylvania Nursery Stakes the month before. He extended his win streak to three, pushed his career earnings to \$159,500 in five starts, and heads into his 3-year-old season with an air of excitement.

Mailata was cross-entered by trainer Butch Reid in Aqueduct’s Jerome Stakes, a race with twice the purse plus Kentucky Derby points. By staying home, Mailata ended up facing only two rivals – one his stakes-winning stablemate Tough Guy Tony – after six scratches.

Tough Guy Tony and Higher Sense dueled early in the 7-furlong test, through a solid opening split of :23.56, as Mychel Sanchez collected Mailata a few lengths back. It didn’t take much urging for Mailata to gobble up the ground, range up outside the pacesetters, and grab the lead down the backstretch. The margin continued to grow around the far turn and he cantered home to win by 19 lengths. The final time was a pedestrian 1:27.20 in what turned out to be a modest workout for the winner.

Racing exclusively at Parx, Mailata made his debut in August and finished third behind Tough Guy Tony after an adventurous trip to the post when he got loose in the paddock and again in the warm up on the backside. In his next start he made up a ton of ground to finish fourth of 12 in September. He won a 1-mile maiden special weight on Oct. 29 by setting every fraction and coming home on top by 2½ lengths over Higher Sense.

The 7-furlong Pennsylvania Nursery was a virtual repeat of this maiden win. Again leading throughout, he posted quick fractions of :22.58, :45.32 and 1:10.26, and then poured it on to win by 3½ lengths in 1:23.29 over a sloppy track.

Mailata is the second foal bred by Zacney and Bennett out of the Medaglia d’Oro mare Bouquet of Gold. Purchased privately from Dan Ryan’s Smart Angle LLP following the 2020 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic December Mixed sale when she exited the ring unsold at \$45,000, Bouquet of Gold was carrying future stakes winner Jeanne Marie at the time.

Jeanne Marie, by Speightster, has five wins, five seconds and two thirds in 17 starts for earnings of \$263,755. Winner of Parx’s Main Line Stakes for 3-year-old fillies in March 2024 in her third start and stakes debut, she has since had stakes placings when second in the Weber City Miss Stakes at Laurel and Lyphard at Penn National and third in the Princess of Sylmar Stakes. One day after Mailata’s latest win, she contested Parx’s Mrs. Claus Stakes and just missed the win by a neck. ■

Bouquet of Gold is the dam of two additional Maximus Mischief offspring - a colt born exactly one year to the day after Mailata’s delivery (Feb. 20) and a filly born last April. ■

For the second year in a row Maximus Meridius bookended the year with victories. In 2025 he raised the stakes, as he kicked off his 4-year-old campaign with a win in Aqueduct's Toboggan Stakes in February and concluded it with a decisive score in Parx Racing's Blitzen Stakes on Dec. 31.

The latest win was his third stakes victory of the year and pushed his lifetime earnings to \$644,430. He came into the final start of 2025 off a victory in the Let's Give Thanks Stakes on the Nov. 26 Thanksgiving eve card at Parx.

Sent off the slight second choice behind familiar foe Buccherino, who most recently got the better of him in the Parx Sprint Stakes in September, Maximus Meridius was caught looking around at the start and bobbed a bit as the gates opened. But Mychel Sanchez collected the bright bay and guided him quickly to the front. The two favorites were side-by-side around the far turn after a half in :46.21 before Maximus Meridius broke the race wide open. He was on top by 4 lengths at the head of the stretch and cruised home from

there – his winning margin was 3 3/4 lengths as he clocked the 7 furlongs in 1:24.43. PA-Bred Dropline ran a solid second, as Buccherino faded to finish fourth of five.

Owned by LC Racing LLC, Cash is King LLC and Wellesley Stable, the latter his breeder, the son of Maximus Mischief upped his lifetime record to 21-8-6-1. Winner of his 2-year-old debut at Parx in November 2023, he recorded seconds in the Bay Shore and Gold Fever Stakes in New York early in his 3-year-old campaign, and that summer ran second to Buccherino in Parx's Salvatore M. DeBunda Sprint, followed by a fourth behind Bentornato, who was second in the 2024 Breeders' Cup Sprint-G1 and the winner in 2025, in the Gallant Bob Stakes-G2. After finishing second in Mahoning Valley's Steel Valley Sprint Stakes, Maximus Meridius got his long-awaited stakes victory in Aqueduct's Gravesend Stakes on Dec. 28, 2024.

Maximus Meridius is the richest of three starters, all winners, for the Quiet American mare Quiet Virtue, a winner at 5 1/2 furlongs who later raced for Westerly Farm over hurdles up to 2 1/4 miles.

Quiet Virtue didn't produce foal in 2024 and delivered a colt by Maximus Mischief last March before being bred back the same stallion. Maximus Mischief was a graded stakes winner trained by Reid for Cash is King and LC Racing who won his first two career starts at Parx at 2 in 2018. He was the third-leading third-crop sire in the nation in 2025. ■

Making her stakes debut in the Miss Behaviour Stakes for PA-Bred and -Sired 2-year-old fillies on Dec. 30, Angie's Reward turned in a professional effort to come home late and draw off to win by three-quarters of a length.

A daughter of Warrior's Reward, Angie's Reward went off the co-second choice in the field of six fillies; Crown Royal Babe, fourth in the Shamrock Rose Stakes in her prior start, was the 4-5 favorite; the only other filly with stakes experience was third-place Blue Mountain Stakes finisher Smart Philly, the 6-1 third choice.

The start of the Miss Behaviour was problematic for two of the runners. Smart Philly stumbled a few strides out of the gate from her inside post and lost her rider. First-time starter Presenceisapresent nearly went to her nose as she came out of the gate. Angie's Reward, breaking from the 2 post, came out clean but wound up stuck along the rail behind Research Triangle, the recovered Presenceisapresent, and Crown Royal Babe as those three set the early pace down the backstretch.

Angel Rodriguez had to wait for room aboard Angie's Reward as Presenceisapresent surged to the lead rounding the far turn and opened up. Finally having clear sailing, Angie's Reward dug in. Although never switching leads, she caught the tiring Presenceisapresent in deep stretch and went on by. Her final time for the 6 furlongs was 1:14.28.

Owned by Warrior's Reward LLC and trained by Brandon Kulp, Angie's Reward has finished on the board in all four of her career starts as she's earned \$85,268. She won her debut in July at Penn National going 5 furlongs and ran a solid second next out while adding an eighth of a mile in a Penn allowance. In her first start at Parx she rallied late to finish third while in for a \$75,000 tag in an optional claimer on Nov. 18.

Angie's Reward is the last reported foal for the Awesome Again mare Awesome Angie. Purchased out of the Keeneland January mixed sale in 2019 while in foal to Unified, Awesome Angie has had four foals since then for the partnership of WynOaks Farm LLC and Warrior's Reward.

WynOaks was home to Warrior's Reward when he stood his last season at stud in 2024; not getting any of the 10 mares he bred in foal that year, including Awesome Angie, he was retired and is now a resident of Old Friends in Kentucky.

Awesome Angie has had seven starters, all winners, from eight foals. Four are six-figure earners. She had three winners in 2025 – in addition to Angie's Reward, the WynOaks Farm LLC and Warrior's Reward partnership campaigns Quasi Warrior (by Weigelia), a winner of three of four starts last year at 3, including an allowance at Parx in December. The Unified mare Cici Unified, sold as a yearling by her breeders in 2000, was a two-time winner at Parx over the summer. ■
