The Liz Merryman bred Caravel will also be running in the Grade 1 Jaipur Stakes that day so good luck to all the connections and maybe Pennsylvania will add two more Grade 1's to the list.

The PA-Bred PA-Sired 2yo Stallion Series will be running its first two stakes in the \$1,000,000 stakes series on August 21, PA Day at the Races. Don't forget about the \$50,000 trainer bonus for the top three point-earning horses. Nominations for the 2023 series for 2yos, if not already nomi-



nated, are \$1,000 for those purchased at a public or private sale by June 30th. After that the fee will be \$5,000. You can go to pabred.com under 'Horses Nominated' to see if your horse is on the list. If not, go to 'Forms' and print the nomination form. Don't have a PA-Sired PA-Bred? Contact a Pa Breeder by looking at our 2023 Stallion Directory. Please remember that if your horse is already nominated, you still MUST CALL the PARX racing office to enter your nomination by July 10th.

Broodmares that were not in the state by Dec. 1, 2022, or within 14 days of a public sale (within 60 days of a sale outside the U.S.) must be bred back to a PA-Sire. We ask that you submit all broodmare domicile forms online. As usual, please contact our office with any questions you may have. Pennsylvania is the only place to Breed & Race! Have a great second half of 2023 and Go PA!

The Champions & Leading Breeders were celebrated May 12 at The Inn at Mendenhall



HORSE OF THE YEAR

OLDER FEMALE, FEMALE SPRINTER & TURF FEMALE

CARAVFI

Bred by Elizabeth M. Merryman

The Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint-G1 over males was the biggest of five wins from eight starts for Caravel, Pennsylvania's richest state-bred of 2022. Racing exclusively in stakes, she started the year at Turfway with a win in, fittingly, the Queen Stakes, added Belmont's Intercontinental Stakes-G3 and Saratoga's Smart N Fancy, and finished her year with back-to-back scores at Keeneland in the Grade 3 Franklin and Breeders' Cup. She earned \$930,983.

2-Year-Old Female, PA-Preferred Female & Leading Breeding Fund Recipient (Horse)

FLOR DE SOMBRA Bred by Joseph Imbesi

Flor de Sombra was a winner of four of five starts at 2, with stakes wins at Parx (Miss Blue Tye Dye), Presque Isle (Finest City) and Penn National (Shamrock Rose), all by daylight margins, and a third in the Imply Stakes in her other outing. She ranked as the richest PA-Bred juvenile of the year with \$320,000. A daughter of former PA sire Social Inclusion, she was the leading PA Breeding Fund Recipient with a total of \$424,990 in purses and awards.



3-Year-Old Female

MORNING MATCHA

Bred by Crane Thoroughbred Services LLC

The richest PA-Bred 3-year-old of 2022 with earnings of \$406,000, Morning Matcha was a stakes winner at Parx in March, was second in the Grade 1 Cotillion and Aqueduct's Busanda, and finished third in the Grade 3 Delaware Oaks. Grade 3 Comely Stakes and Cathryn Sophia Stakes in her 10 starts.



2-Year-Old Male & PA-Preferred Male **GORDIAN KNOT**

Bred by Mr. and Mrs. Joe Imbesi

Never off the board in four starts at 2, three of them wins, including Parx Racing's Prince Lucky Stakes by 2 lengths and Presque Isle's Mark McDermott Stakes by 4 1/4 lengths. By former PA sire Social Inclusion, Gordian Knot concluded his season with a third in the Pennsylvania Nursery and ranked as the leading PA-Bred 2-year-old male with earnings of \$245,800.



3-Year-Old Male

NIMITZ CLASS Bred by Arrowwood Farm

A winner in 2022 of six of 11 outings, Nimitz Class earned \$232,854 to top all PA-Breds in the 3-year-old male division. A winner first time out at Penn National in January, he captured the Danzig in his stakes debut in June, and concluded his season with a win in Laurel's Robert T. Manfuso Stakes in December.

FORTHELUVOFBOURBON

Bred by Hidden Acres 4-D Farm

A seven-time winner in nine 2022 starts. Fortheluvofbourbon was the richest older PA-Bred male while amassing \$361,680. During a six-race win streak he won four stakes - the Page McKenney Handicap, Banjo Picker Sprint and Liberty Bell, all at Parx, and the Maryland Million Sprint at Laurel.



Turf Male

BUY LAND AND SEE

Bred by Joseph Imbesi

Buy Land and See returned to stakes competition midway through the 2022 season and scored a dominating, nearly 7-length victory in the With Anticipation Stakes on the turf at Penn National. He concluded his seven-start season with back-to-back stakes wins at Parx in the Alphabet Soup Handicap on the grass course and M.P. Ballezzi Appreciation Mile on the main track.



Broodmare of the Year

ZEEZEE ZOOMZOOM

Owned by Elizabeth M. Merryman Dam of Caravel & Witty

Two of the first three foals out Lizzie Merryman's winning daughter of Congrats are 2022 PA-Bred stakes winners and finalists for Iroquois awards. Daughter Caravel became a millionaire and Grade 1 winner after a thrilling victory in the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint-G1 over males, one of her five stakes wins during the year. Witty scored in Laurel's Spectacular Bid Stakes in January, by nearly 8 lengths, and added a victory in Delaware Park's Stanton Stakes that summer.

2-YEAR-OLD

\$1 MILLION PA-SIRED PA-BRED STALLION SERIES

The Series is being expanded in 2023 and will be run in three legs, six stakes, 5 1/2 f for \$100,000, 6 1/2 f for \$150,000 and 1 mile 70 yards for \$200,000. Each leg will consist of a 2YO race and a 2YO filly race.

2022 LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD MARK McDERMOTT



Brian Sanfratello, Russell Jones and Mark McDermott

I was born and raised in Uncasville, CT, a non-descript borough famous mostly at the time for being the final resting place of Chief Uncas, he, the last of the Mohegans. Today, it is home to the Mohegan Sun, which opened in 1996 as the country's largest casino, transforming the local landscape to where it now boasts a 70-story hotel.

While a teenager in the early sixties, not much was known regarding attention deficit disorder and Oppositional Defiance. If there had been an awareness of either of these conditions, my obvious position well outside the perimeter of the template of potential United States Coast Guard Academy cadets would have derailed any possibility of an appointment. But there was not, and alas, I was admitted as an original member of the illustrious Class of '67.

After four drawn out years of unsuccessful conformity to regulations and procedures, I graduated near the bottom of my class, and much to the chagrin of many of my Academy superiors, received my commission. Two years on the Boston-based cutter Duane, we were assigned to the Navy in the South China Sea, keeping the Viet Nam

coastline safe, and then to climb the hills of the wintry north Atlantic.

My final two years of active duty took place in New Orleans in the Eighth District rescue center. The oddity of a 24-hour RCC work schedule allowed me ample time to prepare for my exit - journalism courses at Loyola University, a part-time job at Fair Grounds Racetrack, and writing for Daily Racing Form, all laying my foundation once real life began after resigning my commission having reached the rank of full Lieutenant.

In retrospect, my eight years in uniform provided me with a crystal-clear look at what I did not want – forced to exist in an environment where I was too closely supervised, while tending to subjects of near-total disinterest. Instead, I opted for variety, appeal, satisfaction, and independence, all in order to attain inner peace and achieve success in line with my interest - something in the field of Thoroughbred horse racing and breeding.

First stop was Hightstown, New Jersey, with The Morn-

ing Telegraph/Daily Racing Form, Thoroughbred racing's provider of past performances. The paper was pioneering cold-type printing, and in the process of relocating its offices from mid-town Manhattan to avoid the financial liabilities imposed through its labor contract with the Newspaper Guild of New York. After a first-hand view of the many benefits the Guild won for its New York members from a seemingly uncaring management, I signed

on to help organize the local workforce to formally gain Guild representation. Two months later under the supervision of the National Labor Relations Board, we won the election for representation, and I lost my job for ungratefully flying in the face of my shocked employer.

By then, my family had grown to four, so back to the familiarity of New Orleans in search of the good life, but neither selling advertising nor dabbing in graphic arts filled my cup with food or money. Eventually, I was fortunate to land a gig with the Louisiana Breeders Sales Company, did some work for local Thoroughbred breeders, and was subsequently hired to edit The Lou-

isiana Horse, a monthly magazine which was the mouthpiece of the state's breeders. Three more years in Louisiana, however, was enough to make me realize that, as enjoyable as it was, it was very unfair to my older son and his younger brother to have them matriculate in a school system with values that I did not share.

Coincidental with this acknowledgement, I was offered, and accepted, the position as Executive Secretary of the Pennsylvania Horse Breeders Association, a small, struggling group of landed gentries located in beautiful Chester County. PHBA's principals were intent on the Association becoming a major player in the state's burgeoning Thoroughbred industry. For the ensuing 35 years I served eleven separate presidents, over 125 individual Board members, and an annual membership that reached nearly 500, and I was proud to be a part in helping to achieve this lofty objective.

Working with and for many prominent individuals whose

business and sporting reputations supported their roles afforded me opportunities to experience fully the growth and impact of Pennsylvania's Thoroughbred breeding industry. For over 35 years, I had a front row seat with the captains of the state's Thoroughbred industry, championing legislative and regulatory initiatives which elevated Pennsylvania to the top tiers of the sport nationally.

Spearheading a legislative override to a gubernatorial veto of statewide off track betting; shepherding legislation through to enactment to legalize casino gambling in Pennsylvania to become the primary financial basis of its breeding and racing programs, and become the future blueprint for several other states; legislatively expanding and developing the incentives available for breeders to nearly \$30 million annually; total re-writes of the statutes and regulations governing the way racing is conducted; codification of a general sales tax exemption for breeders; garnering major financial support for veterinary ed-

ucation; and accompanying Penn-

sylvania-bred Smarty Jones through

his quest for the Triple Crown are just a few goals we reached and experienced.

Reminiscing, I have been blessed with good health, family, friends, and fortune. My legacy rests with my three wonderful children, two sons and a daughter, all of whom are making positive contributions in their respective fields. And their six children will hopefully continue their parents' example of making life better for those around them.

I have reached the stage of life now where I am content to sit back and smell the roses, no longer intent on making too much of a difference. I try to exist within a pleasant bubble that has a limited entry, isolating myself as much as I can from the daily stresses and incivilities outside of it. The golf bug bit me about thirty years ago and has yet to let go. My lovely wife and I have relocated to North Carolina to fully indulge its lifestyle, and I look forward to what the future may hold with a smile not just on my face, but also in my heart.

Churchill Downs the first weekend of May was an exciting time. And it wasn't only because of Angel of Empire's thrilling third-place finish in the Derby. On the May 5 Friday Oaks card, Qatar Racing, Marc Detampel and Madaket Stables' Caravel returned to face her own division for the first time in more than six months, and looked super doing it.

Recording her fourth stakes win in a row, and seventh stakes win in her last 10 starts, Caravel shot to the lead and was never seriously challenged in the \$300,000 Unbridled Sidney Stakes for fillies and mares going five and a half furlongs on the turf. The 3-4 favorite in the field of 10, she cruised home a length and a half winner in stakes-record time of 1:02.47, after posting fractions of :21.97, :44.62 and :56.27. Her 14th win in 22 starts pushed her career earnings to \$1,677,577.

Getting his fifth stakes win aboard the lovely gray, Tyler Gaffalione noted: "She's been breaking better the last four or five starts and she's putting herself in good spots. She gets comfortable and it's all easy for her. She's just a very fast filly. The second you ask her, she turns on the jets. She finishes the job well."

"She's become very consistent," said trainer Brad Cox. "You can tell when she's ready to run and she's been on 'go' for a while since the month of March training up at Turfway and continuing on through April."

In late May, an expected trip to Royal Ascot in June was scrapped per Cox. She will instead be pointed to Belmont Park's \$400,000 Jaipur Stakes on the Belmont Stakes undercard (June 10). The six-furlong Grade 1 turf stakes is a Breeders' Cup Challenge Series Win, and You're In for the Turf Sprint, a title Caravel will look to defend.

A 6-year-old daughter of Mizzen Mast out of two-time PA Broodmare of the Year Zeezee Zoomzoom (by Congrats), Caravel added to her laurels a week later, when her breeder, PHBA board member Lizzie Merryman, accepted trophies for a second Pennsylvania-bred Horse of the Year title at the PHBA's awards dinner, as well as division championships for older female, female sprinter and turf female for 2022.






